Welcome to all our Competitors

The Wanaka Show strives to be a professionally managed, well organized and enjoyable Show. We are committed to maintaining an inclusive, respectful, and productive environment to stage a memorable Show each year. This code of conduct outlines the principles and guidelines that will govern our interactions (i.e. between Show personnel and competitors) and ensure a positive experience for all involved.

1. Respectful Communication

We will communicate with each other in a courteous, professional, and respectful manner. We will actively listen to others' viewpoints, refrain from personal attacks, and avoid offensive language or behaviour.

2. Inclusivity and Diversity

We will foster an inclusive atmosphere that embraces diversity in all its forms, including but not limited to age, race, ethnicity, gender identity, sexual orientation, religion, and abilities. We recognise the strength that diversity brings to our Show.

3. Constructive Criticism

We encourage open and constructive feedback and criticism. However, feedback should be delivered in a constructive manner, focused on issues and solutions rather than targeting individuals.

4. Conflict Resolution

In the event of conflicts or disagreements, we will seek to resolve them through discussion with relevant personnel including the President. In the event a disagreement is unable to be resolved, the decision of the Show President will be final.

5. Compliance with Rules and Regulations

We will adhere to all relevant laws, regulations, and policies prior to, during and after staging the Show.

6. Continuous Improvement

We will actively seek feedback on our Show performance and processes, striving for continuous improvement in how we operate and achieve our objectives.
