CONDITIONS

CLAUSE 1 - CLASS 38 - PONY OF THE YEAR

The following ponies will qualify for the Class 38 & Pony of the Year.

- The top 22 Ponies in the ESNZ J Pony Grand Prix Series as at 4th March 2013.
- The North Island Champion if not already qualified
- The South Island Champion if not already qualified
- The National Champion if not already qualified
- The top 6 finishes in Class 26, the 1.25m Pony Championship Stakes, not already qualified.

CLAUSE 2 & CLASS 51 & OLYMPIC CUP

The following conditions apply to Class 51 & Olympic Cup

- A nomination fee of \$950 must be paid with entries by the 15th February 2012 (Closing Date)
- This nomination fee becomes non-refundable as at the 6th March unless a vet certificate is produced.
- Acceptance fee is to be paid to the New Zealand Horse of the Year Office by 4pm on Saturday 17th March 2012.
- A cheque will be available, to each competitor starting in Class 51, from the Horse of the Year Office 30 minutes after the completion of this class. Please note that, where applicable, the cheque is part payment of the prize money and will thus be deducted from the rider's total prize money. The remaining prize money will be paid out after the show.
- Due to Quarantine conditions, the committee reserves the right to change the prize money and entry restrictions, should they deem this necessary. If less than 30 horses start, the prize money will be paid out as stated on the Horse of the Year Website, which is the official schedule, down to the number of horses that start.

CLAUSE 3 & CLASS 52 & INTERMEDIATE RIDER OF THE YEAR

- This class has the same age restrictions as the Young Rider Series
- Riders who are entering Classes 28 & 52 must **not** ride the same horse in both classes. However the same rider may enter both classes on different horses.
- Junior Riders may enter this Class as well as Class 21 and 28

CLAUSE 4 && CLASS 32 - NZ PONY CLUB AREA TEAM OF THE YEAR

- Teams are to consist of 2 ponies and 2 horses.
- Teams are to be selected by New Zealand Pony Club Areas
- Team members must be certified Pony Club Members and the 5 rally rule applies.
- Individual entries for this class are **not** to be made to the Horse of the Year Office
- Areas are to submit entries to the NZPC Assn Executive Officer, PO Box 8626, Havelock North by 15th February 2012. No individual entries, for this class, will be accepted.
- If team members wish to enter other classes at the show, they must enter these other classes as normal through the Horse of the Year Office.
- There will be no stabling on the grounds unless full stabling fees are paid to the Horse of the Year office, as per stabling conditions.
- There will be no ground levy payable by team members who are not competing in any other class.
- Team members who are competing in other classes, as well as Class 32, must send their ground levy and stabling fees, with their normal entry forms, to the Horse of the Year Office.

CLAUSE 5– CLASS 27 - JUNIOR RIDER OF THE YEAR

The top 17 from the Kiwispan NZ Junior Rider Series as at the 12th March 2012 and the top 5 unqualified riders from Class 21 will qualify for this Class, plus any overseas rider who has been invited through their National Federation.

CLAUSE 6 6 CLASS 38,42,47 and 55 6 PONY CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

- a) Ponies may only enter **one** class from Classes 38,42,47 and 55.
- b) Riders may enter as many of these classes as they wish but each entry must be on a different pony.

CLAUSE 7 6 CLASSES 10,18,21,28,29,38,39,40,41 and 54 - SERIES CLASSES

Please note that although these classes are not series classes they will be run under their respective series conditions. To check on these conditions please see the Showjumping Section of Equestrian Sports New Zealand Website 6 www.nzequestrian.org.nz.

CLAUSE 86 CLASS 12 6 SABA SAM SHIELD Annex 8 Art 74.2

1. There are no individual entries
2. The manager of each team must complete the team entry form available from the office and return it to the office, with the entry fee by 4.00pm on Wednesday 14th March
3. The second round is part of the Pony Championship Stakes, Class 26. A member of any one of the teams that proceeds to the second round, and is not eligible, in their own right, to compete in the Pony Championship Stakes, Class 26, may ride in this competition as a team member only.
4. If a competitor wishes to also enter the Pony Championship Stakes, Class 26, then they must also pay the entry fee for this class

CLAUSE 9 - CLASSES 43 & 46

For classes 43 & 46(only), ages will be taken as at the 17th March 2013, a limit of 1 horse/pony per rider.

CLAUSE 10 6 All classes

- a) All Showjumping horses must have an ESNZ J approved ID tag which must be worn during the whole event at all times. Art 147.1
- b) The qualification committee reserves the right to add a wild card, if, in the committee's opinion, this wild card will add to the competition.

CLAUSE 11 - Qualifying

Classes 21 & 26 will be run as AM5s. However, when it comes to qualifying for Classes 27 & 38, all riders on the least number of equal faults required to make up the number of competitors for Classes 27 & 38 respectively will automatically qualify.

CLAUSE 12– Dress

The Horse of the Show stipulates the following standard of dress, as per Article 256 Paragraph 1.5 Formal Standard of dress: Light Coloured Breeches or Jodhpurs of one colour; Brown or Black Jodhpur Boots, Gaiters (short leggings/chapattis) or riding boots must be worn. Shirts must have a collar and sleeves (short or long) and be predominantly one colour. A choker, stock or tie, and riding jacket must be worn. With the approval of the Showjumping Committee riders may either wear a windbreaker or rain coat in adverse weather conditions, or in very warm weather be allowed to ride without jackets. This dress code will be required in all showjumping rings. Article 246 Paragraphs q1.1, 1.6, 1.7 will also be enforced.
