
Conditions

- All events run under ESNZ rules. Horses & ponies must have a current registration for duration of show. Or if 1. not, horses not registered for Jumping can compete with the ESNZ casual levy BUT riders must be full members of the ESNZ. There are NO introductory level classes at this show. Horses/ponies competing using the ESNZ Casual Levy can't compete over 1.20m for horses and 1.10m for ponies.
- ONLINE ENTRY at www.main-events.com close on Wed 2nd Dec. Payment by direct credit must be 2. received by Friday 4th Dec or entries are considered LATE and will incur 50% penalty. **POSTAL ENTRIES** close a week earlier on Wed 25th Nov with FIBER FRESH Christmas Classic, Main-Events, PO Box 448, Masterton 5840, email_xmasclassicsj@gmail.com and are accepted with a \$5 data processing fee & on official forms. 3. Late entries - 50% extra. Class Swaps: Refund less 25% & pay original EF (not late fee) for new class. Scratchings – Refunds for classes and all other fees including stabling less 25% if notified to the Secretary by email before 5:00pm Fri 12th Dec, otherwise less 50%. No refunds for class scratchings after 8:00am on day of class but swaps/late entries allowed.



- 4. Stabling for the show Open Yards \$30 per horse, Paddocks \$40 per horse, (Minimum 3 horses to paddock), Covered Yards \$60 per horse and Stables \$80 per horse (Restricted to World Cup Horses and Stallions ONLY). NO REFUNDS ON STABLING after Fri 12th Dec.
- 5. Facility Fee is \$15 per horse. Compulsory Catalogue \$5 per customer will be charged. Riders to COLLECT at the office. The Jumping Levy of \$5 per horse must be paid with entries. There are NO introductory classes at this show so all riders must be full members of the ESNZ to compete. Equines that are not registered for show jumping can compete using Casual Jumping Levies at \$20 for the first day and \$10 for each subsequent day. Horses competing on casual starts cannot start in Series Classes and cannot compete above 1.10m for ponies or 1.20 for horses. See the ESNZ website for further details.
- 6. Camping per Truck/Camper (including driver) Powered site \$60 for show; or without power \$40 for the show or \$20 for the weekend (Fri/Sat). Camping per person over 12 years (in addition to driver) \$20 for the show or \$10 for the weekend Fri/Sat .Truck or float registration must be provided for camping passes to be issued and displayed for duration.
- 7. Committee reserves the right to alter the programme and prize money, substitute prize money with goods to the same value, and refuse any entry without qualification.
- 8. Stabling Priority Limited stabling. Allocated on priority.
- **9. Prize money** all entry fees and prize money are GST inclusive. A GST receipt can be requested after the show provided the rider's GST number is supplied with entry form and a GST invoice for prize money won is given in return. All prize money will be paid out electronically, on a ratio of 1:7, by 6th January 2016, to the bank account on the entry cheque or specified through online entry, unless a different bank account is nominated by attaching a bank deposit form or on entering online.
- 10. It is the rider's responsibility to check their entries are shown online before 8th December as confirmation of receipt and to avoid late entry penalties. All entries will receive an email record of entries so if you have not received one, then it is your responsibility to follow up.
- 11. **FEI CLASSES.** Classes 31, 40, 41 & 42 will be run under FEI Rules. They are competitions over two rounds, and are run under Articles 273-4.3, and 273-3.3.2. There will be trot-ups for all four classes, time TBA. Competitors in class 31 must produce their horse's FEI Passport to the Vet at the trot up. Competitors in classes 40, 41 & 42 must produce a copy of their horse's ESNZ Registration ID Papers to the Vet at the trot up. These can be acquired from the ESNZ national office. Each horse competing in classes 31,40,41 & 42 will be issued with a three digit ID number by the secretary, which must be worn at all times when competing, and at the trot up. The first round of class 40 will be followed by the first round of class 41 and then the first round of class 42. The course will then be altered for the second round of class 40, followed by 41 and then 42.
- 12. NZ University Class –See full conditions on ESNZ website. Affiliated universities are Auckland, AUT, Lincoln, Otago, Victoria and Waikato. All other tertiary institutes include Canterbury, Massey, Unitech, polytechs and technical institutes.
- 13. Riders must check their results at the show or online at www.main-events.com after the event and notify secretary of any errors or omissions by **31 Dec 2015.** No changes to placings and/or prize money will be made after **31st December 2015.**
- 14. Refunds totalling \$20 or less will not be paid out. Riders must settle any outstanding balances with the office BEFORE leaving the show. \$25 admin fee will be charged where any money outstanding has to be followed up by the secretary after the show. Anyone who does not pay within an acceptable time will be reported to the ESNZ head office.
- 15. Individual prizes payable to individuals in excess of \$500 will have withholding tax deducted from the amount in excess of \$500, at the rate of 20% provided a correctly completed IR330 is received by the Secretary prior to payment, otherwise at the relevant No Declaration Rate.
- 16. Ponies Ponies cannot compete in classes 29 and 39.
- 17. Objections to be lodged with Secretary, in writing with \$30 deposit, within 30 minutes of announcement of official results.
- 18. Dogs must be RESTRAINED AT ALL TIMES NO LOOSE DOGS AT ANY TIME AND NO DOGS IN MAIN ARENA PADDOCK AT ANY TIME (unless competing in Terrier Races). Owners that do not comply with this condition will be fined \$50 for each offence and persistent offenders will be asked to leave the NEC grounds.
- 19. HARD HATS must be worn by all riders when mounted on horses.
- 20. **MOTORBIKES** To be operated in a responsible manner, hard hats to be worn, not operated by anyone under 15 and not to enter main arena paddock.
- 21. **PHOTOGRAPHERS** must apply to the Trade Space Organiser Lorraine at <u>nec.taupo@gmail.com</u> .and must register with the Secretary on arrival at the show. No photographers allowed on the grounds unless they display the photographer pass,
