Dear EQUITANA Competitor

The organising company is delighted to welcome you to EQUITANA Auckland. Thank you for being part of this inaugural and exciting event.

To ensure that everyone has an enjoyable and safe experience, there are a few terms and conditions that we ask you to take into consideration during your time at EQUITANA Auckland.

Please note that any participant entering any competition or demonstration agrees to abide by the general terms and conditions of EQUITANA Auckland as well as those that relate to their specific competition or demonstration.

The 'Participant' refers to any rider, horse owner, competitor, contestant, educator or their agents, representatives, employees and officers that will engage in activities in some capacity at the Event. If the party signing this document is not the Participant, or related staff, but is signing in a respective capacity, the party signing warrants the Event Managers that he/she has the authority to act on the Participants behalf that he/she will be jointly liable with the Participant for all the obligations under the Terms and Conditions.

Participants shall indemnify, defend and hold Event Manager, as well as Event Manager's agents, representatives, employees, stable managers, officers and directors harmless from and against any loss, damage, theft of products, death, or expense, including any legal representation fees or costs, incurred or suffered by or threatened against Event Manager or any of the foregoing in connection with or as a result of any claims arising out of the services provided by the contestant under the contracted agreement.

'Under the Health & Safety at Work Act 2015, all participants, owners and others associated with this event are required to abide with all Health & Safety Policies and Procedures for EQUITANA Auckland 2017 and act responsibly. All accidents and incidents must be reported to the organising committee as soon as practicable.

Entries

Those competitors entering Jumping, Dressage and Eventing please do so through Main Events, with entries opening 6th October. All other competitors will receive notification from their respective sections. For more entry information please visit the EQUITANA Auckland Website.

When you enter the competition, we ask that you pay for all entry and stabling fees (where applicable) and that you ensure that you are a current member of your organisation.

Presentations are a special part of EQUITANA Auckland. Could all prize winners make sure that they attend their presentation and for those entering classes with prize money, please send us your bank account details. IRD regulations will apply

Final details and arrangements will be sent out during the first week of November.

Stabling and Camping

Day yards and stables are available – yards are free, stables cost \$35 per day. Please let us know if you need either, at the time of entering. Unfortunately, neither horses nor people are able to stay on the grounds overnight. If you have problems with accommodation please either contact me or your section.

Also, dogs are not permitted on the grounds. Competition parking areas will be through gate 3 for the indoor arena and gate 1 for the outdoor arena. Please note that as room is limited in the competitor car parking areas, only floats and trucks will have access to these parks. So as to have room for these vehicles, all cars, except those attached to floats, will have to park in the ordinary car parking areas.

Safety

For the safety of all concerned, we ask that all participants follow the instructions/requests of staff and uniformed volunteers. Helmets must be worn at all times when mounted, and appropriate footwear when around horses. Stallions do need to be identified. Please do not have alcohol around the stables/yards. If, due to safety concerns, there needs to be changes to the programme, the organising committee reserves the right to make changes as they deem necessary.

Tickets

Each participant will receive two accreditation passes, which will give you access to the GA areas, competition arenas, and back of house. As we appreciate your support, you will also be allocated two GA tickets which can be used as you wish. This accreditation must be worn at all times. Accreditation can be collected from the stabling officials, with one based near the entrance to each competitor parking area. GA tickets and car parking passes will be emailed out to you.

Jumping, Dressage and Eventing Competitors

Entries close 3rd November. If classes are full a wait list policy will be put in place. Late entries will be considered, providing class numbers permit. A late entry fee of \$25 per class will be charged.

Scratchings must be notified in writing to the Event Secretary, through Main Events. After closing date, competitors who withdraw will be eligible for a 70% refund less \$25 administration fee. No refunds will be issued after the 22nd Nov. 2017

Unless registered under a business, all competitors who win prize money over \$500 per class must complete and sign a IR330 form (available on the IRD website – search IR330. The event Secretary must be advised of GST numbers where applicable. All Australian competitors must complete the appropriate forms available in the Competition office irrespective of prize money won. Entry fees and prize money include GST

Competitors must have full current ESNZ membership for both horse and rider. All competitions are ESNZ sanctioned and therefore will run under ESNZ rules and regulations. Dressage classes will be run under ESNZ GR's, VR's and Rules for ESNZ Dressage
