3.2 Height range for the series will be 1.25m – 1.30m.

3.3 The organising committee have the right to change the classes that will be part of the series.

4. Points:

4.1. The first six places to count, points will be awarded as follows $1^{st} = 15$ points, $2^{nd} = 12$ points, $3^{rd} = 10$ points, $4^{th} = 8$ Points, $5^{th} = 6$ Points, $6^{th} = 4$ Points.

4.2. The first 15 placegetters in the 1.25m-1.30m series will gain entry into an overall draw of all series to win a brand new Thoroughbred horse float valued at \$16,000, and other prizes to be drawn on the final day of competition. (See conditions to win below)

3.2 Height range will be 1.15m – 1.20m.

3.3 The organising committee have the right to change the classes that will be part of the series.

3.3 The organising committee have the right to change the classes that will be part of the series.

4.1. The first six places to count, points will be awarded as follows $1^{st} = 15$ points, $2^{nd} = 12$ points, $3^{rd} = 10$ points, $4^{th} = 8$ Points, $5^{th} = 6$ Points, $6^{th} = 4$ Points.

4.1. The first six places to count, points will be awarded as follows $1^{st} = 15$ points, $2^{nd} = 12$ points, $3^{rd} = 10$ points, $4^{th} = 8$ Points, $5^{th} = 6$ Points, $6^{th} = 4$ Points.
