

### LIVESTOCK RULES, REGULATIONS, ENTRIES & FEES

Saturday 17th February 2018 Solway Showgrounds, Judds Road, Masterton

PLEASE NOTE: Each Exhibitor must supervise their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created, accidents, illness or damage caused by the actions of themselves or their animals at the Solway Showgrounds. Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the Health and Safety in Employment Act 1993.

PROTESTS: Protests must be lodged in writing within 30 minutes of class being completed with a fee of \$50.00 which will be refunded only if protest is upheld.

ABUSE OF SHOW OFFICIALS WILL RESULT IN DISCIPLINARY ACTION, AS WILL PARKING IN NON-DESIGNATED AREAS.

PLEASE CHECK YOUR TROPHIES THOROUGHLY AND RETURN THOSE THAT ARE THE PROPERTY OF MASTERTON A & P SHOW IN CLEAN CONDITION AT, OR BEFORE, SHOWTIME - THANK YOU.

THE ASSOCIATION HAS THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ANY ENTRY MASTERTON A&P ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP FEE: \$35.00

SCRATCHINGS & REFUND OF ENTRY FEES: 50% of Entry Fees will be refunded for scratchings ONLY if notified in writing the day before the class is to be run.

THERE ARE NO REFUNDS FOR ANY SUM UNDER \$20.00.

PLEASE NOTE: If insufficient entries, a class may be cancelled. If the number of entries warrants it, a class may be split. Competitors to keep own list of classes entered.

All entry fees & prize money are GST inclusive. PM and refunds \$5.00 and over will be paid out by direct credit using details on cheque with entry form after the show.

### Cattle

#### Animal Health Board - Requirements for all breeds

All cattle entered for showing which are 1 month of age and over must be tagged with primary and secondary National I D tags and accompanied by a correctly completed TB Declaration card. In special circumstances owners who do not wish to tag their show animals with primary and secondary National I D tags may be issued with an exemption from Agriquality NZ. Conditions do apply.

#### **ALL ANIMALS MUST WEAR OFFICIAL NAIT TAGS**Testing Requirements:

Declared Movement Control Areas: Cattle 3 months of age and over which are farmed within a declared Movement Control Area, must be negative to a TB test within 60 days prior to returning home from the show.

A Movement Control Permit from Agriquality NZ is required for all cattle with an Infected Status. If your herd is infected, Agriquality NZ may require up to 30 days notification to complete the necessary tests and tagging prior to the show.

All other Areas: Cattle 12 months of age and over, farmed or grazed outside of the Declared Movement Control areas, must be negative to a TB test within 12 months prior to returning home from the show.

RULES: Copies of rules available from the Show Secretary.

HEALTH & SAFETY: Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the showgrounds. Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the Health and Safety in the Employment Act 1992.

PROTESTS: Protests must be lodged in writing within 30 minutes of class being completed with a fee of \$50.00 which will be refunded only if protest is upheld.

ENTRY FEES: \$10.00 per class (unless otherwise stated - see calf section).

PRIZE MONEY PAYOUT POLICY: (Beef & Lifestyle full PM will be paid out)

(Prize money may be substituted with product)

1 - 3 Entrants 1st Prize only

4 - 5 Entrants 1st & 2nd prize only

6+ Entrants Full prize money

All entry fees & prize money are GST inclusive. PM and refunds \$5.00 and over will be paid out by direct credit using details on cheque with entry form after the show.


