




Please note that this is a training day but will be running as a competition so there will not be any prize money only ribbons for each class and sponsored prizes and rosettes for overall series winners. Please wear correct competition gear. The points system will be posted on event page and at the RDA on the day.

- Admin fee \$5 per horse/pony
- Ground Fee \$20 per horse
- Stables \$25 for the day (great for tacking up in if its raining people may be able to share if classes on at different times to help minimize costs)
- Entries via main-events only and close one week prior to event no exceptions (2nd July 2018)



- Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis. Where entries are received after the closing date it is at the discretion of the organizing committee if it will be accepted depending on class numbers.
- The organising committee reserves the right to restrict entries, alter classes, make changes/amendments to the competition or rules.
- All riders must read and agree to the event rules and disclaimer attached for entries to be valid
- The organizing committee is not obliged to accept every entry and where an entry is not accepted the entry fee will be refunded in full.
- Refunds and scratching less \$25 admin and GF up to 9am Friday prior to the show date and classes will not be refunded unless accompanied by a vet/doctors certificate
- Classes will run strictly to schedule to ensure smooth running of the day for everyone
- Prize giving held at the end of each class. Prizes and ribbons to 5th and rosettes for overall series placings.

Event Rules

- 1. Rider's ride at their own risk Organiser of the Canterbury Indoor showjumping series and RDA accept no responsibility for injury, loss or damage to property, horse or pony, rider or spectator
- 2. All headgear must conform to the current NZ Safety Standards or an equivalent standard and must have the RED tag on helmets. Riders must wear protective headgear at all times when mounted.
- 3. There will be random gear checks to ensure safety for horse and rider.
- 4. Riders must wear correct attire for showjumping.
- 5. No dogs in the indoor at any time.
- 6. Refunds 75% of entry fee refunded if requested in writing within seven days of the event and accompanied by a Vet or Doctor's Certificate. No other refunds will be made.
- 7. Prize Giving for individual classes will be held at the conclusion of each class. Overall prizes for cumulative scores over the series will also be presented on Aug 11^{th} at conclusion of the class. Overall prize winners will only receive their prize if they turn up for the prize giving.
- 8. The event will be held, wet or fine as it is indoors. Warm up will be indoor as well and an approximate time schedule will be posted after entries close to ensure people don't have to wait around all day.
- 9. No ambulance will be on site but there will qualified medical personal 10. Committee reserves the right to alter the schedule.

- 11. Committee reserves the right to remove or deny any horse/pony it considers dangerous.
- 12. An additional \$5.00 fee on late entries if they are accepted.
- 13. Please take RUBBISH AND HORSE MANURE with you when you leave the event or utilize the trailers/bins provided.
- 14. Class changes after entry are at the discretion of the organizing committee.
- 15. Eliminated riders may not carry on.
- 16. We encourage everyone to help on the day whether it's picking up rails or helping with pack up at the end of the day. Organizers are also volunteers who work full time and would like to make this a fun event for everyone please help out where you can.
