- 1. Helmets to be presented when collecting back numbers
- 2. Paper numbers only, riders must have their own back number holder
- 3. Times are a guide only and riders must be prepared to ride ahead of time, we have a lot of riders to get through so you must be prepared to ride ahead of time.
- 4. Back protectors compulsory for cross country phase
- 5. Only riders with multiple horses may ride out of order. Dressage and xc strictly in back number order some SJ classes will be alternate riders from classes a,b and c. If there is a scheduling problem, cross country takes priority.
- 6. Protest must be submitted to the event secretary within 30 minutes of the incident and accompanied with \$50.00 which will be refunded if the protest is upheld
- 7. Refunds: Entry will be refunded when request is made in writing within 7 days of the ODE and accompanied by either a doctor or vet certificate.
- 8. Riders' to wear correct attire for each phase, Pony Club uniform is acceptable.
- 9. Dogs on a leash
- 10. Eliminated riders may not continue on cross country and must walk home
- 11. Cross country for Saturday open for walking Friday 2pm, Sunday's course at the completion of Saturdays competition
- 12. There will be a manure bin provided in the float park, please use this or take your manure and unwanted hay home with you.
- 13. PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN WATER
- 14. Eyreton Pony Club Committee reserves the right to alter the schedule.
- 15. Gear inspection

Classes 4,5,6,7 (first start, 65cm,80cm) compulsory for all phases
Class 3 (95cm) compulsory cross country gear check, random gear checks for other phases
Classes 1 and 2 (105cm, 110cm) random gear checks. **Gear check for all phases will be located at the**main entrance to Eyreton Pony Club — see on the map
