How the Series Works

The 2018 Winter Show Jumping Series at Montana Horse Arena will be run over three days. Points are accumulated from each day's competition. Only one round will count towards the series on the day, so you will need to nominate your round to the judge before you start. No nomination – No points

Start Times & Fees

- Gates open at 7.30am
- Rounds start at 8.30am
- Enter at www.main-events.com
- \$10 ground fee per horse/pony per day
- \$15 First Aid Fee
- \$5 per round

Prizes

The winners of each group category A, B & C are the ones with the highest combined total points over the 3 days. **They will receive a rug and BetaVet products!** There will also be prizes for the winner of each class each day, and spot prizes.

2. 50cm
3. 60cm

Run under A2 conditions

4. 70cm
5. 80cm
6. 90cm

Group C

Run under AM5 conditions

7. 1.0m
8. 1.10m
