Reagan has become a shell of who she was, suffering through constant anxiety attacks within her own home, continual self-doubt, she has gone from the "she'll be right" person we all know and love, to the helpless and hopeless shell with no spark left in her eyes. Reagan has done so much for so many people in her life that she thoroughly deserves any help she can get, we just want the Reagan we know and love back, and the public system is not going to get her back for us.

GREEN HORSE RING- *GREEN HORSES/PONIES ONLY* must be in their first season of competition and must not have won a champion in any ribbon day or open show. **RED & BLUE RINGS WALK AND TROT ONLY.** Under 18 riders by arrangement only please. These are green HORSE rings NOT green rider.

CONFIDENCE RIDER RING – Green and/or nervous riders ONLY. This ring is designed to give those who are unable to canter exposure to showing without the pressure. **WALK AND TROT ONLY.** This ring will be a first in first served basis. Due to the nature of this ring we will be cutting entries off at 12 entries. If we receive enough interest for this we will make rings bigger in future.

NOTE: HOY qualifier for show pleasure 16 and under and 17 and over.

SPECIAL AWARDS

KAIMANAWA WILD HORSE PRESERVATION SOCIETY (KWHPS)- Sash and ribbons to 5th to the best led Kai with papers (must have competed inhand prior). Sash for best Etiquette over all rings.

OVER ALL POINTS SASH – To be awarded to the highest points scoring combinations over the two shows for 18 and over, 17 and under and green horses. Champion – 8 points, reserve 7 points, 1st 6 points, 2nd 5 points, 3rd 4 points, 4th 3 points, 5th 2 points and 6th 1 point.

BEST PERFORMED MALE – Points to be collected as above to all males who attend both shows.

RULES

- IF YOU ARE UNSURE OF YOUR HORSES BEHAVIOUR OR HAVE A KICKING HORSE PLEASE PUT A RED RIBBON IN THEIR TAIL.
- CLASSES MAYBE SPLIT OR COMBINED DEPENDING ON NUMBERS. WE WANT EVERYONE TO GO HOME WITH RIBBONS.
- ADULTS ARE MORE THAN WELCOME TO RIDE PONIES AND UNDER 17'S ON HORSES
- SAFETY HELMETS TO BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHILE MOUNTED.
- STALLIONS AND COLTS TO WEAR BITS AT ALL TIMES AND CLEARLY WEAR IDENTIFICATION BADGES. TO BE HANDLED BY 21 YEARS+ ONLY.
- ALL HAY AND MANURE TO BE REMOVED FROM FLOAT PARKING AND YARDS.
- LEAD REIN LEADERS TO BE 16 YEARS AND OVER.
- ALL PERSONS ENTER THE GROUNDS AND/OR COMPETE AT THEIR OWN RISK. WHILE EXERCISING CARE WE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOSS OR DAMAGE TO STOCK PROPERTY OR VEHICLES. EACH COMPETITOR MUST SUPERVISE AND CONTROL THEIR ANIMALS AT ALL TIMES AND SHALL BE LIABLE FOR ANY HAZARD CREATED, OR ACCIDENT, ILLNESS OR DAMAGE CAUSED BY THEIR ACTION OF THEMSELVES OR THEIR ANIMALS AT THE GROUNDS. EXHIBITORS MUST COMPLY WITH THE APPROPRIATE ANIMAL LEGISLATION AND THE HEALTH AND SAFETY IN EMPLOYMENT ACT OF 1992.
- ANY UNRULEY ANIMAL OR PERSONS WILL NOT BE TOLLERATED AND WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE.
- NO HORSES TO USE THE RACE TRACK, INNER OVAL ONLY.

HOY SHOW PLEASURE QUALIFYING RULES

PLEASURE HORSE/PONY SHOWING RULES 1 August 2016 to 31 July 2017.

Pleasure Horse/Pony means those animals who do not fit the mould of a Show Horse/Pony. We welcome any breed (e.g. Appaloosas, Quarter Horses, Standardbreds, Clyde X) and colour. They should be an uncomplicated and genuine pleasure to ride. Whilst they do not possess the show quality conformation of a show horse, they should in their own way be a delight to ride, with impeccable manners.

A “pleasure mount” is NOT an inexperienced mount with show quality conformation who is destined for the open show ring.

1. From 1 August 2015, for a horse/pony to meet the annual title show qualification requirements they must be registered with NZEPS.
2. Horses/ponies must never have been placed first in an open show ring class. However, members may apply for dispensation to NZEPS.
3. Ordinary snaffle bit only, no poll action.
4. Bitless bridles are only permitted in Recreational pleasure classes.
5. Only cavesson nosebands are permitted.
6. Whips may be carried but must not exceed 76cms in length.
7. All riders must wear a 3 point harness helmet conforming to the current NZ Safety Standard or an equivalent standard.
8. Spurs are not to be worn.
9. Riders may be registered with other bodies.
10. Riders may have competed outside the Pleasure Horse/pony section.
11. Riders in Pony classes must be under 17yrs (proof of rider’s age may be requested). Age is taken as at show date.
12. Adults may ride ponies in Horse Classes.
13. Under 16s on horses MUST compete in the 17 & over ring.
