



Equifest NZPCA Pony Club Teams Event 2023

Incorporating the Pony Club International Jumping Virtual Show

Clubs or Clubs without branches can enter a team of 3 or 4 riders in each division.

Divisions:

- **Junior**, being 13 to 16 years on 1 January of the calendar year of the show
 - Max height: 80cm 1st round, 85cm 2nd round
- **Senior**, being 25 years and under on 1 January of the calendar year of the show.
 - Max height: 105cm 1st round, 110cm 2nd round
- The Competition takes place over two rounds for each level i.e., the Junior team will compete over two rounds in the Junior Competition and the Senior team will compete over two rounds in the Senior Competition.
- Adding the Penalties for Faults at the obstacles gives the Score obtained by each Athlete for each round.
- Only Athletes with a Score of twelve Penalties or less in the first round shall continue to the second round.
- The first round shall not be against the clock. The second round shall be against the clock. There will not be a jump-off.
- Team Scores and Placings shall be decided as follows:
 - The total Penalties of the best three Athletes per Team in the first round are added to the total Penalties of the best three Athletes per Team in the second round to calculate the Team Score. The Placings are determined in the order of decreasing Team Scores i.e., the Team with the lowest score is the winner.
 - Teams with equality of Team Scores will be placed according to the fastest combined time of their best three Athletes in the second round. If the combined times are equal, the placing shall remain equal.
 - If a Team does not have three Athletes that qualify for the second round, they shall be placed in accordance with the total Penalties of the best three Athlete per Team in the first round.
- Riders will ride in Club Pony Club Uniform.
- NZPCA General Regulations apply.
- Each Club will need a named manager who will be responsible for checking rally requirements and gear safety checks.
- **Riders and Horses do not need to be ESNZ registered, but must be current on the NZPCA database**

As this event incorporates the Pony Club International Jumping Virtual Show the course is has been designed by an Australian Course Designer and will be the same courses used in all countries participating.

NZPCA will select athletes to represent them in a junior and senior team for the Pony Club International Jumping Virtual Show. These athletes maybe from different Clubs and will be named before Equifest. The Pony Club International Jumping Virtual Show will also award individual prizes for each division.

A full set of Pony Club International Jumping Virtual Show rules will be sent following closing of entry.
