CONDITIONS

Entry fee \$10.00 per exhibit. Entries close 30 November 2023.

Exhibits must be haltered.

The exhibitor must be the owner of the animals entered, and the animals must be registered with the appropriate Breed Society who must be affiliated to RAS.

The animal must be certified by the exhibitor as eligible for the class in which it is entered.

Three photos of each exhibit are required. One from the front, one from the side, and one from the rear. They need to be square on, taken on a flat, clear surface (short grass if on grass).

Photos must be taken from 1 October 2023 and be in jpg format.

Photographs taken with ribbons/rosettes on are not allowed. Advertising or banners must not be in the background.

Photographs must not have been digitally enhanced.

The owner/parent/guardian signing or authorising the entry must be 18 years or over. By submitting an entry, the exhibitor authorises Te Kauwhata A&P Association to publish any photographs of exhibits in this competition.

Prize money will be paid by internet banking.

Ribbons will be available for collection at the Show on 9 December 2023. If you are unable to collect please add \$4.00 for postage to your entry.
