

Te Kauwhata A & P Show is affiliated to the Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand and operates under the Rules and Regulations of the RAS. www.ras.org.nz.

The 'In-Line' Resolution Process has been adopted by Te Kauwhata A&P Association. Full wording of the process can be found on the RAS website www.ras.org.nz. The principle behind the process is to deal with the matter as it comes to hand and in most cases it should be dealt with directly by the show. A Yellow or Red Card will be issued, in cases of offences in respect of abuse of animals or inappropriate behavior as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulations / Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook, the RAS affiliated Show / registered Measuring Stand and their grounds and their duly appointed delegates may deliver to the person responsible a Yellow Warning Card (either immediately or within 10 days of the show) which suspends any penalty until possible new offences. If the matter is in regard to an RAS official, the show is to forward the concern on to the RAS Operations Manager to handle in an appropriate manner.

Clean Sport - The Rules of the Royal Agricultural Society New Zealand in regard to Clean Sport apply. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show/Event and that testing of all animals is at risk of the person responsible.

Forbidden Substance - Any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems.

Arrears -No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or any other Show/Event charge is eligible

to compete at any affiliated Show/Event. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted.

The Association will not be responsible for any accident in competitions or that may occur from machinery or other exhibits or plants belonging to exhibitors, competitors or the Association and it is a condition of entry that such exhibitor, competitor or visitor shall hold the Association blameless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings issuing from any accidents so caused.

Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the showgrounds.

Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate Animal Legislation and the Health & Safety at Work Act 2015 and any amendments.

No person is permitted in any judging ring without express permission from the Head Steward of that ring. Only persons directly responsible for an exhibit are permitted in the marshalling area.

No classes will be held up for competitors competing in other rings, there are no exceptions.

A judicial committee comprising the President, Secretary and Chief Steward of the section concerned will adjudicate any protests. In the event of a conflict of interest an independent alternative will be appointed.

Membership: You can pay for, or renew a membership with your entry fees. Membership is \$12.00/annum.

GROUNDS FEES: \$10 per equestrian competitor (max \$30), \$5 per livestock (cattle, goat) competitor (max \$20).

LATE ENTRIES: THERE WILL BE NO LATE ENTRIES IN ANY SECTION FOR THIS SHOW

MEDIC FEE: \$2.00 per entry will be applied

General rules and regulations as issued by the Royal Agricultural Society of NZ (Inc) apply.

RAS DAIRY GOAT BYLAWS

98. DAIRY GOATS

c) All goats entered must be registered or recorded with the New Zealand Dairy Goat Breeders Association (Inc), Premier Dairy Goats NZ or Anglo-Nubian Breed Society of NZ unless a class specifically states otherwise.

The New Zealand Dairy Goat Breeders Assn. Regulation 26 26. RECOGNITION OF SHOWS

(e) At the time of entry to a show, all exhibits must be registered with an Association affiliated to the Royal Agricultural Society in the bona fide ownership of the exhibitor, the registered name and number and permanent identification being quoted on the entry form.

All exhibits must be led and tied up. Does in milk must not be milked out before they are judged (except in the second part of the Best Udder Class). Does will not be penalised if it is found necessary to ease their udders before judging owing to their udders becoming overstocked.

- Senior Progeny. Two daughters in milk of the same sire but different dams Names of sire and dams to be given on the entry form.
- 424 HR Best Udder. Open to all does who have borne a kid

To be judged when full and again when stripped out. Points awarded for both full and empty udder to be totalled to determine the prize winners. (Does must be finally stripped prior to entering the ring for the second part).

425 AR Best Udder.

To be judged when full and again when stripped out. Points awarded for both full and empty udder to be totalled to determine the prize winners. (Does must be finally stripped prior to entering the ring for the second part).

Junior Showmanship for young persons 15 years and under

To be judged on exhibitor's ability to lead, place, turn, stop and start their goat. Show preparation and appearance of exhibitor and goat taken into account. Exhibitors age to be included on entry form.

430 Junior Herd Person – Advanced Gold

Junior Herd Person is open to all Junior show people who have gained their gold bar as a Junior Show Person or to new young people who are 15 years and under 18 years of age

Junior herdsperson 15 years up to 25 years showing an adult goat

To be judged on presentation and knowledge of the anatomy of the animal also the handling and health of the adult goat. Does not have to belong to the exhibitor.

- 432 Maiden doe or goatling over 12 months and under 30 months that has not borne a kid including maiden milkers and springing does.
- 433 Doe Kid born before 31st August
- 434 Doe Kid born after 31st August
