


## Various Snaffle Bits

1. Ordinary snaffle with single jointed mouthpiece
2. Double jointed snaffles (a, b, c)
3. Racing snaffle (d-ring)
4. Snaffle
  - (a) with checks, with or without keepers
  - (b) without cheeks (eggbutt)
5. Snaffle with upper or lower cheeks
6. Unjointed snaffle (mullen mouth)
7. Snaffle with cheeks (hanging or drop cheek, Baucher) (this may be a D-ring or other ordinary snaffle as pictured in numbers 1-6)
8. Fulmer
9. French snaffle
10. Snaffle with rotating mouthpiece
11. Snaffle with rotating middle piece
12. Happy mouth with roller
13. Bevel snaffle.



## RAS RULE

### CDE 2. LEAD REIN

- d) The lead must be attached to the cavesson of a simple snaffle bridle.

### CDE 3. FIRST RIDDEN COMBINATION

- d) First Ridden Ponies must be ridden in a snaffle bridle with a cavesson noseband, a snaffle bit and a single rein.
