## **FEES TO BE ADDED TO ENTRY FEES:**

- Ground levy \$25 per horse/pony for the duration of the show or \$15 for 1 day
- Administration Fee \$40 per rider for whole show covers Paramedic (non refundable)
- MEP Yards \$25 per horse/pony for the duration of show or \$15 per night
- Camping per Truck/float/tent at MEP \$20 for the duration of the show
- Jumping/Show Hunter levies see above table
- Catering Fee \$10 per local rider in the Marlborough ESNZ region

## **ALL RIDERS IN THE ESNZ MARLBOROUGH AREA PLEASE NOTE**

- 1. Marlborough ESNZ area riders must supply a helper to assist with running the show otherwise a fee of \$80 applies.**
- 2. When you are entering on Main Events please select a job otherwise your entry will be declined. There will be a sign in and out procedure in the office for all jobs – first in first served. Once you have selected your job it is up to individual riders to find a replacement if you scratch or are unable to complete your job in full**
- 3. If you do not turn up and complete your job in full there is an \$80 replacement fee.**

## **YARDING:**

- 1. If you have a leased yard please request this in the comments section and specify the yard number.**
2. Yarding for the duration of the show is Friday and Saturday nights. If you are arriving early or staying after the show please notify the show secretary
3. Covered yards will be allocated according to the ESNZ recommendations – this may mean if you have a large team you could be allocated a mix of open and covered yards
4. The yarding allocation will be done on close of entries

## **Show Conditions:**

- By entering or attending the show you accept that you may appear within differing media streams that are on location covering the event. Your behaviour at the event and within the competition arena is at your discretion and is your responsibility.
- Run under ESNZ rules and Show Jumping NZ Rules for Series Conditions refer to Annex 11 (SJ Rule Book) – All competitors are expected to be familiar with the rules of entry. Failure to do so may result in a later disqualification.
- Riders must nominate which class is to count for points before the show commences if entering both of the SI Pony Points classes otherwise only points from the higher height will be counted. Points for these series are gained by the pony and must be the same combination for the series.
- For Series Classes this show will pay prize money to 6<sup>th</sup> place regardless of the number of penalties in the first round.
- Riders gaining first round faults of 12 or more in the PMP South Island Series Class do not gain points.
- The organisers reserve the right to alter or delete classes from the programme.
- Competitors and spectators attending this competition do so at their own risk. Marlborough Show Jumping and the organisers disclaim any and all liability in the event of accident to riders, horses, spectators or property
- All injuries and accidents anywhere on the grounds must be reported to the office
- Falls – Any rider that falls must be checked by the medical staff on the grounds before remounting. Any rider deemed to have suspected concussion will be subject to ESNZ Concussion policy. <https://www.nzequestrian.org.nz/wp-content/uploads/ESNZ-Concussion-Policy-V3-2024.pdf>
- Manual entries must be made on the official ESNZ entry forms and include horse & rider registration numbers
- Marlborough Show Jumping reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry
- Marlborough Show Jumping reserves the right to cancel or combine classes if there are insufficient entries
- **All helmets must be **YELLOW** tagged to enter the ring, New boot rules apply (Criteria available on ESNZ website [www.nzequestrian.org.nz](http://www.nzequestrian.org.nz) )**

- **There maybe testing for prohibited substances during the show**
- Riders must wear **yellow** tagged helmets at all times whether competing or training on the grounds. Article 151 (General Regs) will be enforced
- **GST** – all entry fees and prize money are GST inclusive
- Grounds will be irrigated
- **Dogs** – must always be on a leash
- **Class Changes** – **80% of the original class will be refunded and full fee of the new class is payable for ALL changes.** Changes MUST BE DONE BEFORE the jump sheets have left the office.
- Late entries accepted but will be plus 50%. This includes all late payments – 50% of unpaid entries as at closing date will be added to your entry
- No refunds payable for entries received after closing date of entries
- Scratchings are to be notified to the Secretary the day before or by 7.30am prior to the commencement of the day's competition. Refunds less 25% on proof of the horse/pony's inability to compete. No refunds will be considered if not notified prior or during the show.
- All prize money, refunds, bonds will be credited to your account within 3 weeks of event (Please make sure your bank accounts details are given on Main events when entering.)
- For show hunter high points classes ponies may only enter the category appropriate to their height.
- Pony Show Hunter riders may only enter 1 equitation class per day
- For the welfare of the horse/pony riders may not ride the same horse/pony in more than 5 Show Hunter classes per day
- Show Hunter prize money only paid out to qualifying scores over 65
- **Craig's investment partners Itty bitty series will run over our two Marlborough shows, October and February, with 1 class on each day. Special ribbons and a Itty Bitty rug will be presented for the winner. Age 10 years and under which is taken from the 1st of August 2024.**
- Horses/Ponies with an annual start registration will gain HOYQ points in classes designated HOYQ
- **Horses or ponies may only start in ONE championship class or Mini Prix or Grand Prix**
- Dress Code: Formal dress required in Ring 1 & 2 and would be appreciated in Ring 3
- Maximum number of starts per day in Show Jumping for each equine – Ring 1 x 2, Ring 2 x 2, Ring 3 x 3
- **Please remove all muck, hay and rubbish around your parking area and leave yards clean.**
- **Yards will be checked and if they're not left clean you will be sent a fine.**
- **No smoking at Marlborough Equestrian Park and all dogs must be on a leash at all times.**

## **TiES Jumping Futurity Series 2024-2025**

Proudly brought to you by NZTR and ESNZ Jumping

- The TiES Jumping Futurity Series is for registered, eligible TBs, in their first or second consecutive season in ESNZ competition.
- They must be registered with ESNZ for the first time from 1 June 2023 onwards.
- The Series has seven qualifying rounds in each North and South Island (see details below).
- The Series has a FINAL in each North and South Island – at Horse of the Year and the Jumping Nationals.
- The qualifying rounds will be jumped over courses of up to 90cm. The top 5 previously unqualified combinations from each class qualify for the TiES Futurity final in the either (or both) Island.
- The Final rounds will be jumped over courses of up to 1 metre.
- To be eligible your thoroughbred must be registered with the New Zealand Thoroughbred Studbook, registered with ESNZ and have a Jumping discipline start. It must be in its first or second season of registered ESNZ competition.
- There are bonus awards for the best performed thoroughbreds that have been bought directly from one of NZTR's acknowledged re-trainers.

To compete in the series you must enter via Evo Events\*. ESNZ will then verify your eligibility.

\*entries on Evo Events open on 1 September 2024. Make sure your TB is registered with ESNZ before entering.

Futurity Series Prize Money:

There is a \$1200 total prize pool for each TiES Futurity qualifying class. This includes a \$200 bonus for the Highest placed eligible Thoroughbred acquired directly from an NZTR Acknowledged Retainer in each qualifier.

There is a \$9000 total prize pool for each TiES Futurity Final. This includes a \$1000 bonus for the Highest placed eligible Thoroughbred acquired directly from an NZTR Acknowledged Retainer in each final.
