CONDITIONS

1. All riders, spectators, mounts, vehicles and equipment enter the grounds AT THEIR OWN RISK. A hazard risk assessment will be on display at the PC shed.
2. Red or yellow tagged riding helmets must be worn at all times. The NZPCA Helmet tagging policy applies .
3. RDA recommends body protectors for jumping.
4. ALL HORSES/PONIES TO BE YARDED. No tying to floats or trucks. Offenders will be asked to leave.
5. Entries to be made online before the closing date of 9pm Monday 18th November 2024. Entries to be paid in full at the time of entry directly to **RDA Wairarapa 03 0687 03233 74 00 Ref Gymkhana.**
6. NO DOGS ALLOWED. Offenders will be asked to leave. Please do not leave dogs in cars or trucks.
7. **Riders may only enter the Novice Combination class if the rider has NOT WON A 1ST PRIZE IN ANY FLAT CLASS (ON A PONY) WHERE AN ENTRY FEE HAS BEEN PAID (excluding lead rein classes).**
8. Age of rider taken as at the date of the show.
9. Committee may alter the programme and reserves the right to refuse entry without explanation.
10. Genuine protests may be lodged with the President of Wairarapa RDA with a \$50 protest fee within 15 minutes of completion of the class concerned.
11. It is the riders responsibility to enter the correct class. Class changes must be made BEFORE competing. Events will not be delayed to accommodate a rider on more than one mount if events are run at the same time.
12. Ribbons to 4th place for all classes, except where it is noted on the programme (recycled ribbons may be used).
13. Rider/Horse combination limited to one flat section on the day. One mount to count for points cup.
14. Use of showjumping or cross country jumps outside of official classes will result in elimination.
15. Refunds (less non-refundable fees) will be given out if a VET or DOCTOR Certificate is produced within 7 days of the event.
16. The organisers have the right to cancel or combine rings if insufficient entries.
17. All camping enquiries to be directed to the Masterton A&P Showgrounds events@the showgrounds.nz
18. All trophies won must be signed for at the office when collected and returned to Wairarapa RDA before the next gymkhana.
19. Levies applicable are \$25 per horse (covering grounds, rider event levy and first aid).
20. Entry to the grounds will be available from 7am onwards.
21. Any person seen unnecessarily mistreating a horse or pony will be eliminated from the entire show and if appropriate, reported to the SPCA.
22. Please be kind to the volunteers
23. Maximum of three jumping rounds per pony/horse. Enter subsequent classes on Main Events and confirm with the steward on the day which classes you will jump. First round of each height judged for place and trophies.
