## **Competitor Rules and Conditions of Entry**

- 1. Each competitor acknowledges and agrees as a condition of participating that neither the Christchurch Heavy Horse Show organisers, officials, volunteers, medical personnel, promotors, sponsors, landowners and competitors, **shall not** be under any liability for death or any bodily injury, loss or damage which may be sustained or incurred by them, as a result of their participation in or being present at the event. Competitors acknowledge that equestrian activities are dangerous and that accidents causing death, bodily injury, disability and property damage, can, and do happen. Competitors accept this responsibility on behalf of their horse handlers, employees and servants.
- 2. The appointed stewards and nominated officials shall have the right to bar or remove any horse or competitor from any class or event where a breach of safety is perceived and/or order the removal from the showgrounds of any entry or competitor, and/or any horse considered by the Judge or Ringmaster to be labouring excessively under a load, and/or incapable of work, or a potential danger. They must be removed on request.
- 3. Any shouting, swearing, or whipping will incur disqualification, and may result in being removed from the showgrounds.
- 4. Any competitor removed from competition may also forfeit their prize money.
- 5. No alcohol or drugs on the showgrounds. No smoking in the competition rings or public areas.
- 6. All children 17 years and under must be accompanied by an adult, or under adult supervision.
- 7. No dogs on the showgrounds.
- 8. All signs must be obeyed.
- 9. All instructions from the stewards and nominated officials are to be obeyed at all times.
- 10. Judges' and stewards' decisions are final.
- 11. Junior competitors must be under the age of 18 on the first day of the event.
- 12. All riders must wear an ESNZ approved, yellow tagged helmet at all times when mounted.
- 13. All tack, harness, vehicles, and equipment must be in sound and safe condition.

#### Horses

- 14. All horses must be under control at all times.
- 15. Horse age is calculated from 1<sup>st</sup> August.
- 16. Ridden horses must be four years old or over.
- 17. All entire male horses, over 12 months of age, must have a bit in their mouth whenever they are out of the yards, and must wear 2 red stallion discs on their headgear. They must be handled by someone over the age of 18. They must also have a second capable handler wearing a red S bid on standby.
- 18. No horses are to be left unsupervised unless secured in a yard. Yards are available for hire.
- 19. Draught horses are unregistered purebred Heavy Breeds. They must be true to the breed standard.
- 20. Part-bred Gypsy cobs must be no less than 25% Gypsy Cob.
- 21. Cobs must be medium to heavy boned and no taller than 15.1hh.
- 22. Rare breed class breeds other than those listed may be accepted upon secretary's approval.
- 23. Proof of registration for breed classes are required on entry and must be produced on request.

#### **Horse Accommodation**

- 24. Ground fee \$10. Yard fee \$10 per day. Stallion yards \$20 per day. Camping fee \$20 per night.
- 25. A \$40 yard bond per competitor, to be refunded with prizemoney after the event by electronic funds transfer once yard is cleaned to satisfaction of horse superintendent. If you leave without informing the horse superintendent, and having your yard checked. You may forfeit your bond.
- 26. All manure, and hay must be removed from the parking area and either taken home or dumped into the muck heap beside the yards. Please leave your area as you found it.
- 27. All overnight horses must be yarded for safety.

#### Classes

- 28. Class fee \$5 per class.
- 29. Ribbons will be awarded to 4<sup>th</sup> place.
- 30. Prize money will be awarded to 3<sup>rd</sup> place. 1<sup>st</sup> \$20, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$10, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$5.
- Points will accumulate to each horse and its individual handler over both days. The top High Point winners will receive a prize for – Most Versatile Horse, Best Inhand Horse, Best Ridden Horse, Best Junior Handler and, Best Handler.
- 32. The timetable is subject to change due to entry numbers. Competitors will be notified of any changes, after the closing date of entries.
- 33. Single horses may enter a maximum of twice in obstacle events, but with different drivers or handlers.

#### Long-rein Obstacle Course

- 34. Horses/ponies must be harnessed with long reins. Blinkers, backband and trace chains optional.
- 35. The course must be driven from the ground at a walk.
- 36. The fastest time through the course wins.
- 37. Time penalties are added if the horse/pony or harness touch any part of the course.
- 38. Any break into trot will incur a penalty, a canter or gallop will result in disqualification.
- 39. No whips to be carried for ground driven events.

#### Slide Obstacle Course

- 40. Horses must be harnessed with blinkers, long reins, collar and hames, backband and trace chains. Competitors must supply their own swingle tree. Slide can be provided if required. Cobs and ponies must provide their own slide.
- 41. The course must be driven from on the slide.
- 42. The fastest time through the course wins.
- 43. Time penalties are added if the horse, harness, or slide touch any part of the course.
- 44. Any break into trot will incur a penalty, a canter or gallop will result in disqualification.

#### Log Snigging Course

- 45. Horses must be harnessed with blinkers, long reins, collar and hames, backband and trace chains. No trace chains to be less than 2.25m long. Competitors must supply their own swingle tree. Logs and connecting chains will be provided.
- 46. The course must be driven from on the ground.
- 47. The fastest time through the course wins.
- 48. Time penalties are added if the horse, harness or load touch any part of the course and if any assistance is required.
- 49. Any break into trot will incur a penalty, a canter or gallop will result in disqualification.
- 50. No whips to be carried for ground driven events.

#### Substitutions

51. Substitutions may be permitted in certain circumstances at the discretion, and with prior approval from the show organisers. Requests for substitution must be submitted to the show organisers no less than 1 hour before the commencement of the class, preferably before the start of the event.

#### Refunds

52. Refunds will be made to competitors who withdraw before 7 days prior to the show but a 10% fee will be deducted.

#### **Grievances/Appeals**

53. Competition grievances must be raised with the relevant ring steward. Other grievances should be directed to the event organisers. Please allow 24 hours for event organisers to reach a resolution on the grievance. The Judge's decision is final. However, the Judge may reconsider their decision based on new information forwarded from the event organisers.
