## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

(Please read <u>CAREFULLY</u>)

- 1. All entries to be printed on entry form enclosed.
- 2. Entry fees must accompany the entry form otherwise the entry will not be accepted.
- 3. Entry forms must be completed and signed personally by the exhibitor, who will agree to comply with and submit to the Rules of the Show.
- 4. Applications for Refunds must be in writing, accompanied by Doctors/Veterinary Certificate and will be made after the Show at the Committees discretion. Maximum refund to be 80% of Entry Fee. Refunds apply only to horse/person for which Doctors/Veterinary Certificate supplied.
- 5. All entries to be registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of New Zealand Inc. and, in the case of foals, to be eligible for registration.
- 6. In all classes where applicable, the name of the pony, date of birth, sire, dam and stud book number shall be given on the entry form. Those stallions and geldings three years and over with temporary registration numbers will not be eligible for entry. Ponies registered as geldings must be gelded. Stallions must be fully registered and not on temporary colt papers.
- 7. Foals under three (3) weeks of age must not be exhibited.
- 8. Foals to be led at all times by a separate handler.
- 9. When an animal has been entered and catalogued in any class the substitution of another animal will not be permitted.
- 10. Judging commences at 9.00am. Entrants not present at commencement of the class will not be admitted for judging.
- 11. The judge's decision will be final.
- 12. All stallions and colts two years and over must wear a bit.
- 13. ALL COLTS/STALLIONS ONE YEAR AND OVER MUST BE STABLED OR UNDER STRICT CONTROL AT ALL TIMES (HANDLER TO BE 18 YEARS AND OVER) OR YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE GROUNDS.
- 14. It is compulsory for all Stallions, regardless of age, to wear an identification badge, "S", at all times
- 15. The responsibility for accuracy of the description or pedigree and for the eligibility of animals to compete, rests with the exhibitor.
- 16. The committee, at its absolute discretion, may refuse an entry, or cancel any entry already accepted, or decline to admit to the show grounds, or remove any animal, exhibitor or person from the said grounds.
- 17. The committee will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage that may be caused to, or suffered by, any animal, person or property.
- 18. The committee reserves the right to make any alterations to the programme or postpone or cancel the show as it sees fit.
- 19. The committee reserves the right to amalgamate or divide any class where necessary.
- 20. All stables must be left clean and tidy after use. Please place all soiled bedding at end of stable block where sign posted.
- 21. NO PLAITING FOR ALL CLASSES.
- 22. ALL JUNIOR HANDLERS 10 YEARS AND UNDER MUST, AT ALL TIMES, HAVE AN ADULT SUPERVISOR WHO IS NOT EXHIBITING IN THE SAME CLASS.
- 23. DOGS ALLOWED, BUT MUST BE ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES.
- 24. **PROTESTS:** All protests must be in writing and be lodged with the Secretary within 10 minutes and must be accompanied by a deposit of \$50, which shall be refunded only if the protest is upheld.
