- 7. All horses entered in classes 800 & 801 must be presented for the arrival inspection prior to beginning the event.
- All relevant information accompanied by the relevant entry fee and must be in the hands of the Secretary, Event-pro, P O Box 7272, Taradale, Napier 4141 by 15 February 2012. All fees listed include GST.
- All scratchings must be notified immediately, as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Article 629. No refunds will be paid for scratchings after the close of entries for classes 800 & 801, class 802 and 803 refunds will be made in accordance with ENZ Article 629 1.2

CODE OF CONDUCT

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FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

- 1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
- 2. Horses and athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
- 3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
- 4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
- 5. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.

"All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They are therefore strongly advised to take out a third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad and to keep the policy up to date".
