Gang Patches are not permitted on the Wairoa A & P Show Grounds, Ruataniwha Road, Wairoa.

All Prize money is GST inclusive.

ALL COMPETITIONS are run under ESNZ, RAS, and Wairoa A&P Society local show rules.

All entries are subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Society which are deemed to be included herein, as if inserted at length.

HEALTH & SAFETY IN EMPLOYMENT ACT 1992

The Wairoa A&P Society is required to conform to the Health and Safety in Employment Act 1992. However, as a Show Participant at this venue you are also obligated to accept responsibilities in relation to the operation and use of our "Place of Employment" within the focus of this Act which is to eliminate, isolate or minimise risk to Personal Health and Safety. The Wairoa A&P Society is responsible to present a safe venue for use. As user of these facilities you are required to take all practical measures to manage and supervise the health and safety of your event or exhibit representatives, agents, employees and servicing contractors, during the period of this event (including set up and disassembly). The Act embodies a considerable measure of sound common sense, with the key being to identify potential risks in advance by practical management application. Some obvious elements to note as potential hazards include: Leading livestock in public areas. Use of machinery, tools and equipment. Unstable stages, platforms and ramps. Riding Horses in public areas. Overhead Power Lines and the Wairoa River.

Exhibitors must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the showgrounds.

Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the Health and Safety Employment Act 1992.

Home Industry 2013

ALL ENTRIES in the Home Industries are \$1.00 per class.

- 1) Entry Forms along with Entry Fees must be paid at the time of entry
- 2) All entries to be delivered to be at the Home Industries hall no later than 1pm on Thursday, 17 January 2013
- 3) Exhibits which have been entered three times or more in the Wairoa Show are not eligible for competition.
- 4) Must be bonafide work of the exhibitor and exhibit must be a complete piece.
- 5) Exhibits sent by post will be returned immediately after the show. Please include postage and return address with entries.
- 6) Exhibits after judging will be enclosed behind netting gates for security reasons.
- 7) Each entry must have an envelope attached with the class number on the outside, and the name of the exhibitor on the inside.
- 8) Where an exhibit contains more than one article, articles must be sewn together.
- 9) All exhibits must be collected from the Home Industry building by Saturday 19 January 2013 5pm.
- 10) All cup winners will be displayed in the Home Industry room on Friday and Saturday of the show
- 11) Home Industry Catalogue/Entries will be displayed on the wall in the Home Industries Room. Late entries will not be catalogued.

12) No Late entries accepted after 1pm Thursday 17 January 2013 as Judging has commenced.

The Society will not be responsible for loss, damage or mis-delivery of any exhibit.
