Responsibility.

It is the Rider or Persons responsible, obligation to read and understand the conditions for this show. Conditions are published in the programme and this schedule.

Official start time.

The official event start time is 8am Friday 11th January. This is the start time for the period of jurisdiction for all Equestrian Sport New Zealand (ESNZ) General Regulations, Veterinary Regulations and ESNZ Dressage rules. All horses and ponies on the grounds after the official start time of the event must be entered at the event unless special permission is granted by the OC. Please note Dressage NZ rules do not allow the use of prohibited gear from time of arrival on the grounds.

Rider briefing

Friday 11th January 5.30pm in the Indoor Stadium. All riders attendance is strongly recommended.

Event Conditions

- 1. Riders in registered classes may not enter any unregistered class.
- 2. All competitions will be run under ESNZ GR's, VR's & ESNZ Rules for ESNZ Dressage.
- 3. The OC reserves the right to alter the programme/schedule and/or prize money within the ESNZ GR's/ESNZ Dressage rules.
- 4. Horses may only be entered for qualifiers for one Level (Grade) Championship
- 5. Horse/Pony identification numbers must be worn at all times, including warm-up (Article 139).
- 6. All horses/ponies staying on grounds must have an identification tag on them at all times with rider details and contact number.
- 7. Stallions must comply with ESNZ Article 147.
- 8. Objections must be lodged with the secretary in writing within 30 minutes of the completion of the class or the posting of results with a \$30 fee.
- 9. ESNZ Horse Identification Books for graded horse and pony competitors must be available at all times during the event.

Eligibility

- Registered Pony Riders No minimum age restriction and are still eligible if they reach the age of 16 on or after the 1st of August 2012.
- **Registered Young Riders** Eligible from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 12 until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 21.
- Registered Rider 22-25 years Eligible from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 22 until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 25.
- **Unregistered 11 years** No minimum age restriction and eligible until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 12, must be mounted on a Pony.
- Unregistered 13 16 years Eligible the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 13 until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 16. Mounted on Horse or Pony.
- Unregistered 17-21 Years Eligible from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 17 until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 21.

Presentation of Prizes & Prize Money:

- 1. Prize money for registered classes 1st \$25, 2nd \$20, 3rd \$15, 4th \$10. Ribbons to 6th
- 2. No prize money for unregistered classes. Ribbons 1st to 6th.
- 3. The OC reserves the right to substitute prize money with goods to the equal value.
- 4. All prize money will be paid out at the prize giving or from the event administration area.
- 5. Prize giving's, See article 485. Presentation times will be advised in the program.
- 6. The OC reserves the right to withhold prize monies should a rider not attend an advertised prize giving.
- 7. Riders who have conflicting class times must nominate another person to the Prize giving Co-ordinator at the event office to collect their prizes/rosettes at the prize giving.

Changes to the Draw:

If required, a revised draw and/or start times for the following day's competition will be available 6.30 pm each evening on the results board. The OC reserves the right to alter the program to ensure the smooth running of the event. It is the rider's responsibility to check any new times posted.

Equal Placings

In the case of equality in any qualifying class, the higher collective marks will determine the higher placing. If the competitors are still equal then the higher co-efficient marks will determine the placings. If there is still an equality of points, the competitors are given the same placing.

General Competition Information

Code of Conduct

- 1. In all equestrian sports the horse must be considered paramount.
- 2. The well-being of the horse shall be above the demands of breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organisers, sponsors or officials.
- 3. All handling and veterinary treatment must ensure the health and welfare of the horse.
- 4. The highest standards of nutrition, health, sanitation and safety shall be encouraged and maintained at all times.
- 5. Adequate provision must be made for ventilation, feeding, watering and maintaining a healthy environment during transportation.
- 6. Emphasis should be placed on increasing education in training and equestrian practices and on promoting scientific studies in equine health.
- 7. In the interests of the horse, the fitness and competence of the rider shall be regarded as essential.
- 8. All riding and training methods must take account of the horse as a living entity and must not include any technique considered by the FEI to be abusive.
- 9. National Federations should establish adequate controls in order that all persons and bodies under their jurisdiction respect the welfare of the horse.
- 10. The national and international Rules and Regulations in equestrian sport regarding the health and welfare of the horse must be adhered to not only during national and international events, but also in training.
- 11. Competition Rules and Regulations shall be continually reviewed to ensure such welfare.

Riders with more than 2 horses

The OC will make every effort to ensure that riders have at least 60 minutes between rides. However, if this is not possible owing to the scheduling of classes, the maximum time possible between rides will be allocated.

Sponsors

We ask that all competitors spend some time to thank our sponsors that support Dressage in NZ, either in writing (Sponsors contact details will be listed on the event program) or in person during the show. Without the generous sponsorship we receive, the cost to competitors would be considerable.

Competition Arena Use & Familiarisation

All Competition Arenas (Sand & Indoors) are closed at all times except as stated below **Indoor Arena familiarisation** is strictly as follows on Friday 11th January 2013

1.40 - 2.00	Level 2 Ponies
2.00 - 2.40	Level 2 Horses
2.40 - 3.00	Level 3 Ponies & Horses
3.00 - 3.40	Levels 4 & 5 Ponies & Horses
3.40 - 4.00	Advanced and Grand Prix

Outdoor Arena familiarisation 3-5pm on Friday 11th January 2013 for all levels.

- 1. Horses may be hand walked or ridden at walking pace only around the exterior of the arena's
- 2. No horses in these areas outside of these times.
- 3. Lunging not permitted on all weather surfaces

Points Competitions and Event Initiatives

Championships Points

- 1. Young Rider Champion & Reserve Sashes and Rug for Champion, levels 1 though to 5, 6/7 and 8/9.
- 2. Pony Champion & Reserve Sashes and Rug for Champion, Levels 1 through 4.
- 3. Rider 21-25 Years Champion and Reserve Sashes at levels 1 though to 5, 6/7 and 8/9. Overall Champion to be awarded a rug sponsored by Gateshead Equestrian.
- 4. Unregistered Classes Champion & Reserve Sashes in all 3 age groups.
- 5. Classes marked Q in the schedule of classes will qualify for level championship.
- 6. Points will be awarded, 1st, 20, 2nd 18, and so on down to 10th place.
- 7. In the event of a tie the highest percentage wins.

Enter the Draw to win a day with Louisa Hill

Every competitor has the chance to name their School, Pony Club or Dressage Group, you will all go into a draw to win a "Day with Louisa Hill" at your Club, Group or School. Please state on Entry Form.

Mentor Challenge

For riders selected for the mentor programme prior to the event. Scores from both the young rider and the mentor will be combined from classes marked MQ, a prize will be awarded to the best placed combination.

Are you confused about the same test on both days of the show?

Yes the schedule is correct you will ride the same test on consecutive days. On day 1 the test may be called on day 2 the test will be required to be ridden from memory, without a caller.

North/South Island Derby.

For riders selected by ESNZ Dressage Selectors. Application criteria can be found in the ESNZ October Bulletin or from www.nzequestrian.org.nz. Applications close with the Sport Manager 30th October 2012.

Competitors 22 to 25 years

- 1. Horse eligibility as per DNZ grading rules article 460.
- 2. These competitors may enter one level, test ridden will be the same as the Young Rider test for that level.
- 3. 22-25 yeas rider will be awarded separate placing and championship.
- 4. Ribbons 1st to 6th and prize money 1st to 4th will be awarded separately as with the Championship.
- 5. Entry fees are the same as the level entered.

Rider Equitation Championships

- 1. These classes will be judges based on the riders ability to influence the horses way of going, effectiveness of the aids, accuracy, security of seat, balance and position, it is open to any registered horse and rider age 25 years and under as at 31st December 2013 that has met the qualification criteria set out below.
- 2. To qualify for the Equitation Championships at Junior, Intermediate, or Senior level you must have reached the qualification criteria set out below in a graded competition 1 January 2012.
- 3. Fledgling no qualification required.
- 4. May compete on a Horse or Pony
- Levels 1 2 A score greater than 65%
- Levels 3 5 A score greater than 63%
- Levels 6 9 A Score greater than 60%

Only 20 entries will be taken in each level and in the case of excessive entries balloting may occur.

- Fledgling 11 years and under. Test British Dressage Fledgling Rider test 1 (2005)
- Junior 14 years and under. Test British Dressage C Squad Rider test 1 (2010)
- Intermediate riders 25 years and under who have never competed higher than Level 4. Test British Dressage B Squad Rider test 2 (2011)
- Senior Riders 25 years and under. Test British Dressage A Squad Rider test 1 (2010)

Best Performed Hanoverian Awards

Two awards - levels 1-3 and Level 4 and above, will be presented at the Championships. Award open to horses registered with the NZ Hanoverian Society, proof of registration (copy of pink registration papers stamped with the official H brand) must be supplied with entry to qualify.

Venue Information

Venue Rules

- 1. Competitors and spectators attending this event do so at their own risk
- 2. No dogs are permitted at the event
- 3. No smoking in any buildings or in stable areas
- 4. Neither Manfeild, ESNZ, or ESNZ Dressage nor any representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any loss, damage, injury or illness to horse/pony/rider, spectators, land, vehicles or any personal property whether caused by their negligence or breach of contract in any way whatsoever.
- 5. Manfeild, ESNZ, or ESNZ Dressage shall not be liable for the safety of any goods/equipment or the loss of, or damage to such goods and equipment, brought in/stored at the venue, during the period of use.
- 6. Any damage to Manfeild Centre facilities to be reported immediately to the Manfeild Office or DNZ Event Office.
- 7. Safety hats must be worn at all times when schooling at the Manfeild Centre except as in DNZ Art 480 re safety hats & top hats during competitions.
- 8. All horses and ponies on the grounds must be entered at the event unless the OC gives express permission otherwise.

Horse Identification, Stabling, Accommodation & Wash Down Bays

- 1. Horse/Pony identification numbers must be worn at all times when competing. When not competing, all horses should have identification tags or ESNZ numbers attached. It is requested that during non competition times these ID tags also include horse & person responsible name & contact.
- 2. All yards/pens/stables are to be left properly mucked out. Muck bins will be located near each yard/stable.
- 3. Temporary yarding must comply with ESNZ rules.
- 4. Please keep wash down bays clean at all times.
- 5. No paddocks will be available.
- 6. Moving horses to unallocated yards or stables is prohibited.
- 7. Please use the skips provided for horse waste, no rubbish, wheelie bins are provided for rubbish only not horse waste.

VEHICLES & ACCESS

- 1. Access to venue after 8.30pm will be via Kawakawa Rd. All gates will be locked at 10.30pm daily. For access after that time arrangements will need to be made with on site security.
- 2. There is no vehicle access around the stadium area.
- 3. Speed limit for all vehicles 15 kph. Motorbikes may not be used after 8.30 pm & must be used in accordance with normal road rules. Any competitor contravening these rules will be fined & immediately eliminated from any further participation in the show. Joy riding on any part of the grounds at any time will not be tolerated. Junior drivers (under 16yrs) must only use motorbikes under parental supervision.

Camping & Power Sites

- 1. Parking & camping areas will be defined. Some areas will be restricted to on site camping/parking only. Day competitors must only park in designated day parking areas.
- 2. Trucks and Campervans using the powered sites must have a valid electrical certificate and under no circumstances will allow other vehicles to connect to their vehicle via extension cords. Offenders will be fined. Trucks will be allocated specific powered sites.
- 3. Please be tidy and use green bins for all rubbish NO ANIMAL WASTE IN GREEN BINS.
- 4. Waste Water (Grey water tanks) must only be dumped in the waste water dump in the centre of the oval.
