

Stratford A&P Show Grounds 2nd December 2012 Show Rules

- 1. This show is affiliated with the Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand and now runs under the RAS rules of showing.
- 2. This show supports the RAS 'Yellow Card' system, which will be offered for any inappropriate behaviour towards Show Officials, Judges, fellow competitors or any other third party connected with the Show bring the equestrian discipline into disrepute, or cases which are of a less serious nature to the above in accordance with the conduct of Members, Owners, Lessees, Competitors and/or Exhibitors as provided in the RAS Equestrian Competitors and Judges Rulebook and rule 13 of the RAS Constitution.
- 3. The Organizing Committee accepts no liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to Horses, Owners, Handlers, Grooms or Spectators, or to any other personal property whatsoever.
- 4. Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and Health and Safety Employment Act 1992
- 5. All persons attend at their own risk.
- 6. All animals to be registered with their respective Breed societies where sections require this. REGISTRATION NUMBERS ARE TO BE WRITTEN ON ENTRY FORM.
- 7. Registration Certificates and Height Certificates may be asked for where applicable.
- 8. Starting times will be adhered to as closely as possible. ONE CALL ONLY.
- ALL COLTS AND STALLIONS TWO (2) YEARS AND OVER MUST BE BOXED WHEN NOT COMPETING AND CONTROLLED BY A BIT OR BE SHOWN IN HEADGEAR (HALTHER/BRIDLE) AS PRESCRIBED BY THEIR RELEVANT BREED.
- 10. COLTS AND STALLIONS TWO (2) YEARS AND OVER ARE TO DISPLAY AN 'S' TAG ON THEIR HALTER.BRIDLE FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW.
- 11. Colts and Stallions must be handled at all times by persons 16 years and over.
- 12. Foals under 3 weeks of age must not be exhibited. They must be led by separate handler.
- 13. Any horses found in unpaid for stables/yards will be removed.
- 14. Applicants for refunds must be made in writing accompanied by a Doctors/Veterinary certificate and received within 7 days from the date of show. Refunds will be made after the show at the committee's discretion with a maximum refund of 75% of fees paid.
- 15. Unruly, lame or unwell animals will be required to leave the ring.
- 16. **NO DOGS ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS.** This is a venue requirement and will strictly be enforced.
- 17. Stables/Covered Yards/Pens must be left clean.
- 18. Competitors to clean up all manure from around Floats/ Trucks and place it in the bins provided.
- 19. No temporary tape or rope fences to be erected on the show grounds.
- 20. All protests must be in writing and submitted to the Protest Committee within thirty (30) minutes of the incident, together with a \$50 protest fee, this will be refunded if the protest is upheld. The decision of the Protest Committee will be final.
- 21. **Handler Class.** You may enter as many times as you are eligible but you can only QUALIFY ONCE so once you have won one you can't go into any others and there is no refund of entry fee.
- 22. Entry fees are per horse per class
- 23. Three (3) or more entries to enable a breed ring to take place
- 24. Organizing Committee and stewards retain the right to change the order of, alter or delete classes and merge sections.
- 25. Prize Money will be paid out in Cheque four (4) weeks after the show.
- 26. Donated product may be in place of prize money.

DEFINITIONS

- 1. Mares show in Brood Mare classes must have a foal at foot or present a veterinary certificate of pregnancy that includes projected foaling date. 'Dry' mare is a mare not to foal within the current show season (1August to 31 July).
- 2. Mares shown in the summer season without a foal at foot, would be expected (before Christmas) to be late foaling in the summer or winter or (after Christmas) to have weaned an early foal and be back in foal with a spring due date. Mares falling into either of the above categories should prove their eligibility with a veterinary certificate. Anything less will be unacceptable.
