
# SI Premier Championship Show

#### RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. All entries must be on the official entry form.
- 2. Entry Fees and Fees must accompany entries. There will be no refund of entry fees under any circumstances except on presentation of a Doctors/Veterinary Certificate to be produced before or within 7 days of the day of show 75% of entries will be refunded. Substitution can be made by discretion of the committee. No refunds under \$20 will be made except where grading affects the class.
- 3. The Show Committee reserve the right to alter, change or combine classes
- 4. Judging will commence at 8.30am sharp. Exhibitors must be ready to enter the ring when the class is called. No late exhibitors may enter the ring if judging has commenced.
- 5. Classes will not be held up if you have entered more than one section
- 6. Exhibitors must carry an official RAS Life or Horse/Pony annual height and performance card, failure to do so will result in elimination.
- 7. The South Island Premier Show Committee will not be held responsible for any accident, loss or damage that may be caused to, or suffered by any exhibit, person or property and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Committee indemnified against any claim.
- 8. All protests must be in writing, and lodged, with the Secretary either before or after the Judges have proceeded to their duties. Any exhibitor entering a protest must deposit \$100, which will be forfeited if the protest were not sustained. If the protest is lodged before the Judges proceed to their duties, the onus of proof will rest with the exhibitor. If after that the onus of proof will be with the party protesting. No protest will be received later than half an hour after the prize tickets are affixed. The Committee will decide all protests as soon as practicable, and there should be no appeal from their decision
- 9. Stallions when lead should be controlled by a colt bit with a single lead, or a chain over the nose attached to a single lead with the exception of miniatures. Stallions are not to be tied up unattended unless in an appropriate confinement e.g. stable. At the time of entry, all stallion owners must either be in possession of, or must purchase a stallion identification badge, which must be displayed on the horse at all times while at the show.
- 10. Stallions may be ridden in their Breed Ridden Sections on Friday. Saturday & Sunday competitions are for Mares and Geldings only.
- 11. In all Ridden classes, ponies/horses must be three (3) years or over.
- 12. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person/exhibitor showing excessive use of the whip or spurs, jabbing the horse in the mouth or any offensive behaviour. Yellow card rule applies.

13. A riding hat must be worn at all time while riding.
Riders under 17 yrs must wear protective headgear with three point harness.

In Equitation Classes the rider has a choice to wear a three point Harness Safety Helmet.
The Helmet is to be covered in black velvet with flesh coloured harness. Riders opting to

The Helmet is to be covered in black velvet with flesh coloured harness. Riders opting to wear a safety riding helmet (as described) will be judged on 'equal terms' as a rider wearing the traditional bowler hat and lanyard.

- 14. **Number Holders** To be worn by either Horse or Handler. **Compulsory** for all classes / sections, both Led & Ridden. No Back Numbers will be provided.
- 15. The use of tranquillisers, stimulants or any drugs capable of affecting the performance of horses and ponies is forbidden. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show and that testing of all animals is at the owner's risk. Testing for forbidden substances will be carried out under the Royal Agricultural Forbidden Substance Judicial Committee (FSJC) procedures and rules (refer rule 89 RAS Equestrian Judges & Competitors Rulebook and rule 55a of the RAS General Rules & Regulations.)

- 17. Stables must be cleaned out once finished with. There is to be **No Smoking** in or around the vicinity of the Stable blocks. Any person found smoking in and around the vicinity of the horseboxes will be fined \$500. Stables will be allocated on a first in, first served basis.
- 18. **All** horses must have an ID tag on their halters while at the Show (& stabled) with a name and cell phone number.
- 19. First Season Under Saddle is for a Pony / Horse that has **Not** competed at **Any** Show (A&P, Breed, Pony Club Show etc) prior to 1 August 2012.
- 20. A Novice is a Horse or Pony that has not won 6 firsts in conformation classes at any A&P Show as at the date of the Show. (Ladies & Gentlemen's Hack class wins count as a conformation class). Number of wins is as of day of show. If a Novice entry gains 6 wins by the day of the show the competitor is to advise the secretary's office and may change to an another class or a refund will be offered.
- 21. Novice Ponies/Horses are able to enter Open Riding classes & Title classes.
- 22. You must have entered in a Ridden Class before being eligible to enter Title Classes.

- 23. Riders on Open Ponies up to 148cm must be under 17 yrs as at 7th December 2012. First Season Under Saddle & Novice Ponies may be ridden by riders of any age.
- 24. The RAS 'Yellow Card' system (as per resolution of 2010 Remits) is in place and will be offered for any inappropriate behaviour towards Show officials, Judges, fellow competitors or any other third party connected with the Show bringing the equestrian discipline into disrepute, or cases which are of a less serious nature to the above in accordance with the Conduct of Members, Owners, Lessees, Competitors and/or Exhibitors as provide in the RAS Equestrian Competitors and Judges Rulebook and rule 13 of the RAS Constitution.
- 25. Correct Back Numbers must be displayed for each entry in the class. Any unruly horse or pony may be asked to leave the ring and/or grounds at the discretion of the Judge or Member in Charge.
- 26. It is an offense for any electronic or audio equipment to be carried on a competitor in the show ring, deemed to be possible of outside assistance to a competitor. Penalties may include forfeiting all prize money, awards and qualifications and elimination from any further classes at that show.
- 27. No temporary fences are to be erected for the confinement of horses.
- 28. Camping Permits must be displayed in the vehicle windscreen at all times. Exhibitors found staying overnight at the showgrounds who have not prepaid their fee and displayed a camping ticket will be charged \$100.
- 29. Entries will be returned if the compulsory fees are not paid.
- 30. In foal broodmares may be asked for service certificate.
- 31. Any rule not stipulated defaults to the RAS rulings.

# **Horse & Pony Section Index**

#### **Lead Rein Pony:**

A Lead Rein Pony must not be over 128cm and be ridden by a Rider 4 years and up to and including 7 years. These children are as yet unable to ride without assistance from a leader or attendant. Riders who have competed in First Ridden, Novice or Open Sections are not eligible to compete in the Lead Rein Section. Pony to be judged on Suitability & Safeness 60%, Conformation & Paces 40%. The lead rein must be affixed to the caveson of a simple snaffle bridle at all times. The leader is to hold the rein in their left hand 4 to 5 feet from the bit leaving the right hand free to assist the rider if necessary. Rider must be seen to be guiding and in control of the pony. No spurs to be worn.

#### First Ridden Pony:

Riders are to 9 years and younger as at the date of Show. No cantering is allowed as a class, however the Judge may ask for a canter in individual workouts. Riders are only eligible to compete in the First Ridden Section for a maximum of 24 months, from the date of the first show in first ridden section. Pony to be judged on Suitability & Safeness 60%, Conformation & Paces 40%. A cane or whip not exceeding 68cm in length may be carried and ponies are to be shown in a bridle with a single rein only.

#### **Sport Pony/Hunter Pony:**

A Sport Pony/Hunter Pony should have substance, be active and well mannered with strong easy paces and be capable of carrying weight for long distances over varied country.

#### **Riding Horse:**

Riding Horse's are saddle horses who do not fit the criteria of Hacks/Park Hacks or Saddle Hunters in type, but somewhere in between. A quality horse, they must possess the conformation, soundness, manners and paces of a show horse and be capable of carrying a Lady or Gentleman rider pleasantly for longer journeys.

#### Saddle Hunter:

Hunters shown under saddle should show substance, be active and well mannered with strong easy paces. The horse must be capable of carrying weight over long distances and varied country. A Saddle Hunter will not be required to jump but must gallop in workout if asked.

#### **Equitation:**

<u>Junior & Intermediate</u>: Junior Costume may be informal or Children's, Intermediate Costume to semi-formal or informal. Well kept older gear should be marked higher than new gear

**Senior:** Costume to be formal. Saddlery will be judged on quality, condition and suitability.




