

# Online Entry Step by Step

No question is too silly or too insignificant – every comment helps us build a better system.



#### How to enter online

1. Login to <a href="www.main-events.com">www.main-events.com</a>. If you are not a registered user then click on **REGISTER** at the top right of the home page and follow directions on the screen. Wait until you have activated your account through the activation email sent to you by the Main-Events team. Once you have activated your account, you can come back to do the online entry.



2. From the Home Page that opens, click on the ONLINE ENTRY tab on the right and then on the show name you are entering.



3. This will take you to the Show Page. Click on the **Online Entry** tab on the far right or on the yellow text box that directs you to the online entry tab.




# **Starting the Online Entry**

4. From the **Online Entry** tab, click on the **Enter Now** button near the lower middle part of your screen.

#### Online Entry Steps

- . Step 1: Add class entries
- Step 2: Add miscellaneous items, e.g. stabling, schedules, etc
- Step 3: Event entry summary and confirmation
- . Step 4: Contact details and customer info
- Step 5: Payment

#### Adding Horses/Ponies and Riders as you go

- 6. With Main-Events, you select a horse/pony and a rider combination and then enter all classes for this combination. You then come back and select another combination and enter all classes for that combination. Each section of the show (eg category) will ask for different horse and rider information but if it has already been entered at another show or category, it will appear automatically.
- 7. If this is your first time through the Online Entry, the drop boxes will be blank. You will have to ADD your horse/pony into the Main-Events system (once) and then ADD your rider/s (once). Otherwise select the horse and rider from the drop list as appropriate.

#### Part 2: Select Competitors

The table below shows the different competitors that are required to enter classes for in the SJ Horses category.

Use the drop down lists to select which competitors you want to enter.



8. When you click on the button, a small form pops up where you type in the horse/pony or rider name as appropriate. Capitalise the information correctly, as this is what will appear in the show program! You then need to click on SEARCH where Main-Events.com then looks to see if there is a possible match on the database – eg a similar name or combination of letters. In the Main-



Events system, a horse could be recorded several times – eg with a breeder, rider or owner all of whom are able to enter the horse and pay online entries on your behalf. This matching stage sets a link between the various people although each will be recording their own information about the horse.


- 9. Look through the list of possible matches to see if you recognise one that fits and if yes, then click on <u>Yes</u>. Otherwise go down to the bottom of the list and click on <u>None of the above are a match</u> and follow directions on the screen to specify your relationship and where the horse, pony or rider is based (country and province).
- 10. Pick the closest match describing your relationship to the horse/pony or rider from the drop list.
- 11. Select the country from the next drop list WARNING **New Zealand** is actually at the top of the list if you can't find it in the full list.
- 12. Repeat similar steps to add a new Rider.

#### Part 3 – Competitor Information

13. Each show will ask you different information in terms of your horses and yourself. In the next step, you must fill in the gaps as either required (see green tick) or as appropriate. Some information may not be required – for example the EA Membership Number

with expiry date and the Area/State which is also highlighted in red to make sure you fill it in. All information you enter here will popup automatically the next show you go to using Main-Events.

14. To enter the information, click on the small pencil edit button to the left of the Information Item. One of the questions you will be asked is if you are

# Part 3: Competitor Information

Below are the various competitors you have selected for online entry. You must enter all the required information before you can continue and select the classes you want to enter.

prepared to make that information public. Some items (such as EA membership) are not of any interest to others, but at times information will be of interest to others – eg Sire of a horse. It is the goal of the Main-Events.com website to share information related to success and performance but it is up to you to tick YES the information can be made public.

At any stage, you can add, edit, delete information from your **MY MAIN-EVENTS** profile or change its status from Private to Public. Click on the Rider or Horse name to edit related information.

15. Once you have entered any information required for



your horse/pony and rider, click on **Continue – Select Classes**. If you don't see this button, it is because you have not entered all the required information as indicated by the red \*\*.

#### Part 4: Select classes to enter

16. The next step is to select the classes you want to ticking on the left. Tick ALL classes that you want.

#### Step 1: Add class entries

Adding class entries is an easy 5 part process - select class category, select competitors, enter competitor information, select classes to enter, and confirm the entry.

#### **Part 5: Entry Summary**

17. When finished, go down to the bottom of the list of classes and click on **Continue** button. This will show you a summary of the classes entered so far for that horse and rider combination.





18. At this stage, you can add add the same horse to ANOTHER category; or start with a new horse and/or rider by clicking on **Add another entry** or if finished with ALL your horses and ALL classes, you click on **Continue to the next step (fees).** 

# If you need to go back and make changes

19. DO NOT use the **Step 1 to 5** at the top of the screen- it is not a menu system. Look to the **Online Entry Summary** on the top right of your screen.

**CLASSES:** If you click on the pencil/edit button to the right of **Classes**, the site will take you back to the select classes screen where you can then **change** what you want. The horse and rider stay the same. You will need to tick all classes again.


**COMPETITORS:** If you click on the pencil/edit button to the right of the **Competitors**, you will be taken back to the screen to **change** a horse and/or rider but the classes will stay the same.

**CATEGORY:** If you click on the pencil/edit button to the right of **Category**, this is effectively a <u>start again</u> option for the current horse and rider you were working on. You will be taken right back to the beginning where you start by selecting SJ Ponies or SJ Horses. In effect, you are starting again with this horse and rider combination.

# **Step 2: Miscellaneous Items (Fees)**

20. This step should be after you have entered all your horses, ponies and riders into classes. This part of the system then specifies what else the show expects you to pay for. Refer to the show schedule on the Downloads tab of Main-Events.com to clarify fees to be paid.

Please note, some **Other Fees** are required which shows as a green tick as required on the left. You cannot leave these blank or zero. It must be 1 or more.



21. Even at this stage, if you suddenly realise you forgot to enter a horse or need to add more classes you can from the **Online Entry Summary** on the top right of the screen. Click on the **pencil/edit** to add/change entries for the same horse or click on the **#** button to add another horse or pony.



# **Step 3: Customer Info**



below if you leave it blank. Required fields are highlighted with an asterisk to the left of the info item – eg Emergency contact, BSB, Bank Account Name & Number.

This information is required for admin purposes and most can be left blank. Notice the blue ? – you can click on these for further information on what you should put in each text box. Remember you can add or edit horse/rider/class/fee information from the **Online Entry Summary** screen on the right.

When finished entering information, click on **CONTINUE** on the lower part of the screen.

#### **Step 4: Contact Info**



22. Click on add address button to add and then be sure to TICK the Postal.



23. Click on **Continue** and fill in the other information needed by the show secretary.

# **Step 5: Payment Option**




- 24. It is up to the show as to what they will accept as payment method. In this case, the show has enabled you direct credit or mail a cheque. There is a credit card option within Main-Events but that is not available for this show.
- **25.** Select your preferred method of payment at which the screen will change to show you the details needed for your payment either the bank details (above) or a postal address.

PLEASE NOTE – your entry is not considered accepted until payment has been made which we suggest you do immediately!

# **Step 6: Summary and entry Confirmation**

26. This is the final step before SUBMITTING your entry. Check all details in front of you and if you need to make changes to your entries, use the ONLINE ENTRY SUMMARY at the top right.



27. Edit by clicking on the pencil/edit buttons from the **Online Entry Summary** on the top right of your screen.



28. If all is correct, then click on **Confirm and continue to next step**. Make sure you have read the terms and conditions as highlighted in screen pic. If you are not over 18, you should have a parent or guardian complete this final step and may payment.

**DON'T FORGET** to tick this and to click on the **Confirm and submit entry** as your entry is NOT sent to the secretary until you have done this.

# Add more entries after submitting?

Yes you can at any stage by starting another online entry to add in NEW classes and/or NEW horses.

# **IMPORTANT** – Confirm and submit entry

29. IMPORTANT – you must click on SUBMIT ENTRY to finalise your entry. Until that point, you can change your entries using the **Online Entry Summary** at the top right of your screen.

If everything has gone according to plan, you will now see a full list of classes, fees and customer information in view. **To PRINT**, click with your right mouse button on the form and choose PRINT ... from the short cut menu that pops up. You don't *need* to print it however, as Main-Events.com will send you an email with a link to your entry which can be viewed at any time from your MY MAIN-EVENTS at the top right of the home page just under the LOGIN area.

30. Once submitted, the full summary will be sent as an email to the show secretary. You will receive an email with instructions and a link to view your entries on Main-Events.com.

# Making a Direct Credit payment (if allowed by the show)

Using the information provided, go through to your bank to do the direct credit as with any other payment. Each bank had a different process that you are probably aware of – but all banks have the following. Please enter information as follows:

**PARTICULARS** Your last name, and then first name as many characters as allowed for the space provided.


You can track when your payment has been received by checking its STATUS under your MY MAIN-EVENTS (see below).

## **Reviewing your entries under MY MAIN-EVENTS**

Once you have submitted your online entry, you can come back at any stage and review what you entered through your MY MAIN-EVENTS under the login area.



From the list of shows entered, click on the magnifying glass button to the left of your name.



This will take you directly to the show where you can see what you entered. This is the same information that is submitted to the show secretary. They view a list of all entries to their show (similar to your list above). Your entry is flagged as PENDING only until payment has been received and accepted by the show.


# Check who else is coming to the show!

As you and others enter the show using the Main-Events online entry system, horses and riders will appear automatically in their class lists which you can see from the CLASSES tab.

Or you can search for a specific horse or rider from the COMPETITORS tab.

This way you and others can see how the classes are shaping!

# Update your COMPETITORS under MY MAIN-EVENTS



You can also add and edit information under your COMPETITOR profiles for horses and riders so that it is up to date for each show you enter.

You will notice that any information entered under a show for your horse or rider will appear here automatically as updated. Each entry into a show is a snapshot of your competitor information at that point in time so if you update registration etc AFTER the entry online, you will still need to contact the show secretary with updated information .

#### Your CUSTOMER information

As person responsible for entering online, the shows will also ask for certain information they need in terms of administration (**Step 3**). This is also saved to your **MY MAIN-EVENTS** profile under **Details** then **Other Information** from the right hand side. You can add, edit or delete this information as you want.
