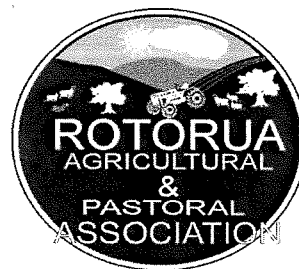

Entries close either by hand or through the mail on Wednesday **8th January 2014**. Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: That the entry is in the Secretary's hands no later than 3 pm Friday 24th January 2014. Entries postmarked later than 5 pm on 8th January 2014 will incur a 50% penalty. Late entries will not be processed unless the penalty is included in the payment. **NOTE: All Horses/Ponies staying overnight MUST be yarded. No grazing in rings or elsewhere on grounds is allowed.**

My signature hereto (on this entry form) and/or participation in the competition/s denotes my acceptance of the RAS Forbidden Substance Rules and Regulations and Conditions.

The use of tranquillisers, stimulants, or any drugs capable of affecting the performance of horses and ponies is forbidden. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the show and that testing of all animals is at the owners risk. Testing for forbidden substances will be carried out under The Royal Agricultural Society Forbidden Substance Judicial Committee (FSJC) procedures and rules (refer Rule 89 RAS Equestrian Judges and Competitors Rule Book and rule 58a of the RAS General Rules and Regulations).

The attention of exhibitors is particularly drawn to the conditions relating to the misuse of drugs, and the intention of the committee to undertake testing for forbidden substances.
