- Entry cheques payable to "National Equestrian Centre" or "NEC" and not banked before 2nd December.
- 4. All events run under ESNZ rules. Class 27 run under FEI Rules for World Cup Competitions.
- 5. Entries to be on Official entry forms only. Riders, Horses and Ponies must have current registration for the duration of the show.
- Committee reserves the right to alter the programme and prize money, substitute prize money with goods to the same value, and refuse any entry without gualification.
- 7. Prize money All prize money will be paid out electronically, on a ratio of 1:7, by 5th January 2009, to the bank account on the entry cheque, unless a different bank account is nominated by attaching a bank deposit form. Individual prizes payable to individuals in excess of \$500 will have withholding tax deducted from the amount in excess of \$500, at the rate of 20% provided a correctly completed IR330 is received by the Secretary prior to payment, otherwise at the relevant No Declaration Rate.All entry fees and prize money are GST inclusive.A tax invoice can be issued at the end of the show.
- Late entries 50% extra. Scratchings Refunds less 20% if notified to Secretary by 5:00pm Wednesday 16th December, otherwise less 50%. (NOTE: Refunds totaling \$20 or less will not be paid out.) Class 27 – No Refunds unless veterinary or medical certificate produced.
