Completion of Entry Forms

All entries close 20 MARCH 2014

Entry Forms

1. Entries must be made on the official entry forms accompanied by total entry fees payable and be in the hands of the Show Secretary on or before the closing dates advertised in the Schedule. No faxed or email entries will be accepted.

2. Entry forms received that have not been signed, or where entry fees have been calculated incorrectly, will be returned immediately for correction. This requirement will apply to all Exhibitors, including Members of the Association that have not as yet paid their annual subscription but who have calculated entry fees using the discount available to financial Members.

Late Entries

3. Equestrian Section: Entries received after the closing date of 20 MARCH 2014 will incur a 25% penalty. Late entries will be accepted up to 2 APRIL 2014 for inclusion in the catalogue. There will be NO entries accepted after this date.

Membership

4. Exhibitors must be Members of the Auckland A&P Association in their own name if membership discounted entry fees are to be claimed.

5. New Members - discounted membership entry fees are available to current financial Members of the Auckland A&P Association. The Association's membership form may be completed and forwarded with entries with membership discounted entry fees able to be used for the named Member. A membership application is at the back of this Schedule.

Membership Subscriptions 2013/2014

6. Annual Individual Membership of the Auckland A&P Association is \$50 discounted to \$30.00 if paid by 30 September 2013 or upon receipt of your competition entry for the 2014 Coca-Cola Easter Show. The membership year runs from 1 April – 31 March. See application form in the back of this Schedule.

Confirmation of Entries

7. Confirmation of Entries - A receipt showing all details of your entries, subscription etc will be returned to you following data processing. Your entry form will NOT be returned to you.

8. Responsibility - It will be your responsibility, the Exhibitor, to check the details on the confirmation of entries carefully and ensure that all details are correct. Any alterations to Classes must be made to the Secretary by Wednesday 2 APRIL 2014 in writing (by post, fax or email). NO EXCEPTIONS - except Novice upgrading changes - see E8.

Reminder

9. Remember - If your entry form is not signed, or is illegible, or the required certificates are missing, or the correct monies are not attached, your ENTRY FORMS WILL BE RETURNED FOR CORRECTION.

Judging Times

10. All judging times printed in the catalogue are approximate and subject to change without further notice.

General Conditions of the Auckland Agricultural & Pastoral Association

To be read in conjunction with Section Conditions and with the Rules and By-Laws of the Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand.

Privacy Act

The Association holds records of names and addresses of all Members and Exhibitors and may publish these for the purposes of Show media reports or promotional purposes at the Association's discretion. The Association may take photographs and video images of Members, Exhibitors, exhibits (including livestock) and the employees, agents and assistants of any Exhibitor and use this information for reporting or promotional purposes in any media, at the Association's discretion.

Important Health & Safety Information for Exhibitors

All Exhibitors agree to comply with the terms of the Health & Safety Act 1992 and its subsequent amendments. The Auckland A&P Association hereby states that it will accept no responsibility in any claim from any person resulting from non-compliance with the Act. Livestock Exhibitors must follow the instructions of Stewards and Officials. Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring animals are kept in control at all times. The Auckland A&P Association reserves the right to order immediate removal from the Showgrounds of any animal it considers dangerous, unruly or unmanageable.

Livestock and Equestrian Exhibitors must ensure that they keep walkways clear and no dangerous equipment or chemicals are accessible to the public.

First Aid: First aid stations are located in Alexandra Park, The Easter Show Office and Pavilion 1 Office. Please familiarise yourself with the Showgrounds site map. Accidents must be reported to your Section Office or The Easter Show Office.

Smoking

Smoking is prohibited in all pavilions and stables. The Auckland A&P Committee reserves the right to impose a fine of \$500 on any person found smoking within these areas.

Entries

1. Entries must be made on the official entry forms accompanied by total entry fees payable and be in the hands of the Show Secretary on or before the closing dates advertised in the Schedule. No faxed or email entries will be accepted.

2. All entries must be made in the name of the bona-fide owner of the exhibits hereinafter called the Exhibitor, and such exhibits must have been the property of the Exhibitor at the time of entry. Registered lessees of animals are permitted to enter under their own name.

3. In all Classes of Breeding Stock, Exhibitors must state the breeder's name on the entry form. The owner of a dam of an animal at the date of mating shall be considered the breeder. Failure to comply with this rule may result in disqualification.

4. Exhibitors must state as accurately as possible at the time of entry the date of birth of all stock in Classes where the age is required.

5. Times by which exhibits require to be in their allotted places on the Showground ready for judging are detailed at the head of each Section.

6. Exhibitors must provide sufficient attendants to take charge of each entry of Cattle, Horse, and Sheep entered in Breeder's Groups, and lead them into the Show ring when required. Exhibitors failing to comply with this regulation will be liable to forfeit their prizes at the discretion of the Auckland A&P Committee.

7. The Auckland A&P Association shall not be responsible for any loss or damage caused (inter alia) through disease or infection however arising. Each Exhibitor shall have deemed to have guaranteed to the Auckland A&P Association and have given warranty that each exhibit entered and brought to the Showground is free of any contagious or infectious disease.

Rights of the Auckland A&P Committee

8. The Auckland A&P Committee reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without adducing any reason for so doing and reserves the right to make any alteration to the Show timetable, or withdraw any event as may be deemed desirable. Any unruly or dangerous animal or exhibit may be required to leave the Showground.

Protests

9. All protests must be in writing, and may be lodged with The Easter Show Coordinator ONE HOUR from the completion of the class judged, together with a deposit of \$50.00 which shall be returned should the protest be sustained. Should the protest be lodged before the Judges proceed to their duties, the onus of proof will rest with the Exhibitor; thereafter, the onus of proof will be with the party protesting. No protest will be received later than one hour after the prize tickets/ribbons are affixed.

The Auckland A&P Committee, or not less than five members thereof, will determine the results of all protests as soon as practicable. There shall be no appeal.

Catalogue

10. When an animal has been duly entered and catalogued in any class, the substitution of another animal will not be permitted without the consent of the Auckland A&P Committee. See Substitution Form in the back of this Schedule. The same animal cannot be entered in two Classes except where the contrary is specified. Exhibits competing in the Family and Group Classes are also eligible for other Classes.

11. No animals, excepting those entered in the Catalogue or as part of a Trade Display, will be allowed on the Showgrounds.

Prizes, Prize Money, Sponsorships

12. In the event of there being no competition (i.e. one exhibit) in any Class, no prize will be given unless the Judge certifies to particular merit.

13. Judges of Stock, in arriving at their decision, are requested not to give undue weight to high condition, but to award the prizes to the animals in each Class which they consider best represent the particular breed or description intended to be encouraged. The Judges are requested to pass over all animals whose want of condition betokens weakness of constitution, however great their merit may be in other respects.

14. In each class of Livestock, cash prizes are offered, but Judges are requested not to award them if the exhibits are not up to standard. The ribbons will be awarded as soon as possible after the judging has been completed in each section.

15. All prize money will be paid by cheque after the Show. Shearing prize money only will be paid at the Show upon a receipt of an IRD Number.

16. The Association takes no responsibility for sponsorships which do not eventuate.

Scale of Points

17. With the exception of Dairy and Beef Sections, where there are five entries or more.

In the event of a tie the winner of the largest number of first prizes shall have preference. If it remains a tie then the count back system will apply.

Cups & Trophies

18. Cups and trophies will be awarded at the completion of competition. Photos may be taken at this time. The Auckland A&P Association no longer allows cups and trophies to leave the showgrounds. A medal with the name of the trophy engraved on it will be presented to the recipient.

Parking Stock Trucks & Horse Floats

19. All Horse trucks and floats are to enter Alexandra Park through Gate E off Greenlane West to designated parking areas. Indoor events ie. Miniature Horses, Connemara, Clydesdale Foal, Gypsy Cob and Shetland Ponies may enter through Gate 3. Parking permits will be issued and must be displayed.

All Livestock Exhibitors to enter ASB Showgrounds Gate 3 off Greenlane West.

Parking is entirely at the vehicle owner's risk and an allocated car park pass must be sighted.

20. Any vehicles parked will be on condition that the Auckland A&P Association accepts no responsibility for any loss, theft, injury or damage to persons or vehicles, their contents, fittings or accessories even when such loss, theft, injury or damage is attributed to any negligence on the part of the Auckland A&P Association or any of its employees or stewards.

21. The Auckland A&P Committee reserves the right to remove any motor vehicle, float, caravan or any other form of trailer which is parked in any area or manner other than those prescribed by Auckland A&P Committee without prior notice.

ANY VEHICLE FOUND TO BE PARKED INSIDE THE SHOWGROUNDS WITHOUT AUTHORITY, WILL BE TOWED AWAY AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.

General

22. All persons admitted into any premises controlled by the Auckland A&P Association shall be subject to the orders of the Auckland A&P Committee, and in the event of misbehaviour on the part of anyone attending the Show, such persons may be removed by order of the President or any two members of the Auckland A&P Committee. Any Exhibitor who interferes with or abuses a Judge or Officer of the Auckland A&P Association whilst acting in his official capacity, will be dealt with as may be deemed fitting by the Judicial Committee, and Stewards are instructed to report such occurrences promptly.

23. Any Exhibitor or attendant who behaves in a manner which, in the opinion of the Judges or the Auckland A&P Committee persons engaged in overseeing the running of the event in which the Exhibitor is entered or enrolled in, embarrasses, is likely to embarrass or is intended to embarrass the Auckland A&P Committee, the Judges or the sponsors of the event, or which is likely to bring the event into discredit, or is behaviour which the Judges or the Auckland A&P Committee (or not less than any two members of the Auckland A&P Committee) consider in their opinion to be rude, bad mannered, disobedient or abusive or designed to or has the effect of harassing or being discourteous to any Steward, Official, or any fellow exhibitors or members of the public, may be censured, expelled, fined or banned by the Judicial Committee constituted under Clause 32.

24. Persons in charge of exhibits will be admitted on production of an A&P Exhibitor Pass, and they will be subject to the orders of the Auckland A&P Committee or its officers.

25. Any Exhibitor or person who in the opinion of the Auckland A&P Committee, infringes any of these Conditions and Regulations, or refuses to comply with the directions of the Auckland A&P Committee, or is guilty of any fraudulent or unfair practice or any deceit or concealment either in entering or exhibiting stock, shall have his or her exhibits disqualified. His or her name shall not appear in the Official Prize List, and the Auckland A&P Committee shall have power to suspend such an Exhibitor from exhibiting at any exhibition during such period as it may think fit.

26. Should any person or firm be disqualified or suspended by a kindred Auckland A&P Association registered under "The Agricultural and Pastoral Societies Act, 1908", the A&P Committee of this Auckland A&P Association shall have power to endorse such disqualification or suspension, and disqualify or suspend such person or firm accordingly.

27. All exhibits shall be at the sole risk of the owner or Exhibitor, and the Auckland A&P Association shall not, under any circumstances, be responsible for loss, damage, mis-delivery, detention or delay of exhibits of any description whatsoever.

28. The decision of the Auckland A&P Committee for the time being in office shall be absolutely final in all cases.

Limiting of Entries

29. The Auckland A&P Committee reserves the right to limit entries in any class or section in the event of excessive numbers of animals requiring accommodation or limited space in the Art Pavilion.

Cancellation of Classes

30. The Auckland A&P Association reserves the right to cancel a section if there are insufficient entries. All Exhibitors will be advised in advance.

Discipline

31. In addition to any other Judicial Committee under these Rules or any other regulations of the Auckland A&P Association, there shall be a Judicial Committee comprising the President or a Vice-President and not less than two other members of the Auckland A&P Committee which may consider all complaints, charges or references relating to the conduct or omissions of all Exhibitors, or any other person involved in any matter associated with any form of misconduct or unruly behaviour.

32. The Judicial Committee shall have the power to investigate all incidents, acts or omissions which are referred to them, and to obtain such evidence as they may require to hear any complaints, charges or references. Any Exhibitor or any other person who is the subject of any complaint, charge or reference to the Judicial Committee shall have the right to be heard by the Judicial Committee in relation to the matter, and such person shall, immediately following advice of the complaint, charge or reference, make him/herself available for examination by the Judicial Committee.

33. The Judicial Committee may, after hearing all evidence which they consider is relevant to any matter referred to them, dismiss the charge, or uphold the charge, and/or censure the Exhibitor, and/or fine the Exhibitor in an amount not exceeding five times the entry fee paid by the Exhibitor to enter the event. The Judicial Committee may also ban the Exhibitor or that person from the event, and/or recommend to the General Committee that such person be banned from any number of future events or indefinitely.

34. On a recommendation of the Judicial Committee, the General Committee may, in addition to the powers available to the Judicial Committee, ban any Exhibitor or person from exhibiting in any number of future events or indefinitely.

35. The decision of the Judicial Committee under Clause 32 shall be communicated in writing to the Exhibitor or person forthwith following their decision. The Exhibitor or person shall have the right to appeal the decision of the Judicial Committee to the General Committee by notice in writing to the President, served within 14 days after the decision of the Judicial Committee. The decision of the General Committee shall be final and binding on the Exhibitor or person. Any ban shall have effect immediately following the decision of the Judicial Committee. Any fine shall be paid within 30 days of the decision of the Judicial Committee or of the General Committee in the case of appeal and shall constitute a contractual debt and may be recovered by the Association by due process of law as a debt due.

Equestrian Competition Classes will be held at Alexandra Park, adjacent to ASB Showgrounds except Connemara/Shetland/Miniatures & Gypsy Cob which will be held inside in the Arena, ASB Showgrounds.

Conditions & Regulations for Equestrian Section

To be read in conjunction with the General Conditions of the Auckland A&P Association at the front of this schedule and the Royal Agricultural Society Equestrian Rulebook and Guidelines.

Royal Agricultural Society Equestrian Competitors & Judges' Rule Books are available from The Secretary, PO Box 54, Woodend, North Canterbury 7641, cost \$35, cheques to be made payable to Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand.

Membership Subscriptions

Annual Individual Membership of the Auckland A&P Association is \$50 discounted to \$30.00 if paid by 30 September 2013 or upon receipt of your competition entry for the 2014 Coca-Cola Easter Show. The membership year runs from 1 April – 31 March. See application form in the back of this Schedule.

Timetable

Exhibitors must know their class numbers and times by checking the timetable included in the Catalogue in case of class time changes. They must be ready to enter the ring before their start time. A timetable will also be displayed at the Equestrian office.

Classes missed are the exhibitor's responsibility. Late exhibitors will be excluded from the class.

If the exhibitor is entered in multiple sections, the exhibitor must decide which class/section to compete in. **No class or championship judging will be held up for delayed Exhibitors.**

The 2014 Easter Show is a qualifier show for Horse of the Year 2015.

"Yellow Card" System

This Show supports the RAS "Yellow Card" system, which will operate in the Equestrian Section of all RAS affiliated Shows and will be offered for any inappropriate behavior towards Show officials, Judges, fellow competitors or any other third party connected with the Show bringing the equestrian discipline into disrepute, or cases which are of a less serious nature to the above in accordance with the Conduct of Members, Owners, Lessees, Competitors and/or Exhibitors as provided in the RAS Equestrian Competitors and Judges Rulebook and rule 13 of the RAS Constitution. Implementation of the "Yellow Card" will be in accordance of the RAS Rules that accompanied this Card, and full working of the "Yellow Card" system is available to view on the RAS website. No competitor, exhibitor or member of their family shall approach a judge with regard to a decision unless they first obtain the permission of the Show Convenor/Manager/Ring Master of Ring Steward, the most senior of whom shall carry the decision on the day.

Protective Headgear

A hard hat is generally described as a hunting cap, a bowler, protective headwear, or a safety helmet. Wearing a hard hat is compulsory for anyone competing on, working in or schooling or riding for any reason a horse at an A&P Show or in any area considered to be for whatever reason a part of the Showground. It is strongly recommended that all riders particularly those jumping horses wear protective headgear conforming to the current NZ Safety Standard or an equivalent standard and that the headgear must be secured by a retention harness. All Pony Riders under 17 years must wear protective headgear which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at three points. Such headgear must be worn with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened when in the rings, the warm up area, collecting rings or anywhere else within Alexandra Park.

Confirmation of Entries

E1. Confirmation of Entries - A receipt showing all details of your entries, subscription etc will be returned to you following data processing.

Your entry form will NOT be returned to you.

Responsibility - It will be your responsibility, the Exhibitor, to check the details on the confirmation of entries carefully and ensure that all details are correct. Any alterations to Classes must be made to the Secretary by 16 April 2014 in writing (by post, fax or email). **NO EXCEPTIONS** - except Novice upgrading changes - see E8. Competitor to supply number and holder.

E2. Age of Horses and Ponies

Age is determined from 1 August.

Yearling – born since 31 July 2012

2 year old – born since 31 July 2011

3 year old – born since 31 July 2010

4 year old – born since 31 July 2009

E3. RAS General Rule 36 – Ownership and Leases. All entries must be made in the name of the bona fide owner of the exhibit, and such exhibits must have been the property of the Exhibitor at time of entry. The Association may require evidence of the date of sale of an exhibit. A bona fide owner shall include a PARTNERSHIP or LEASE that has been registered with the Royal Agricultural Society prior to closing of entries. A Lease must be for a term of not less than 6 months and must be registered with Northern District RAS Office.

E4. The Committee reserves the right to alter conditions, or the order of events, or cancel events, at its discretion. If too many entries are received in any Class the Committee may ballot or otherwise reduce the number.

And likewise if there are insufficient entries in classes, they may be combined.

E5. Equestrian Levy – The Royal Agricultural Society of NZ has imposed a levy on each horse and pony entry at The Easter Show which is paid at time of entry.

E6. Late Entries. Late entries – refer to 'Completion of Entry Forms' at the front of this Schedule.

Refunds of Entry Fees

E7. The Council of the Auckland A&P Association reserves the right to recognise the refund of entry fees at a rate of 75% upon submission of the refund/scratching form with a) a veterinary or doctors certificate, or b) a written explanation as to the reason for the request WITHIN FIVE DAYS following the completion of the competition (no refunds will be considered after this period). The Association's decision shall be final.

A refund/scratching form is included in this schedule. No refunds will be available for Stables, Straw, Ground Fee or Catalogues.

All requests for scratching must be in written form i.e. email, fax or postal post. No verbal scratching requests will be accepted.

Newcomer, was Novice as at 1 August 2013

E8. Please note that a record of wins will be asked for. Horse/Pony height and performance cards must be carried. Failure to do so will result in elimination.

All wins in Novice Section within each division count and must be recorded. Should a Novice horse win an open conformation class including Ladies and Gents Classes, these wins must also be recorded. Once a horse has achieved 6 wins in either the conformation Classes or paced and mannered Classes, this horse is not eligible to return to Novice status should it change Sections at the beginning of a new Show season – excludes Lead Rein and First Ridden.

A Novice is a Horse or Pony which has not won 6 first in conformation Classes at any A&P Show, at the time of the Show. (Ladies and Gentlemen's Hack class wins count as an Open Conformation Class).

Once a Horse or Pony has had 6 wins by the day of the Show, the competitor must advise the Secretary's office and may change to an Open class (if qualified) within the Sub-Section, or if no class remains to enter, a refund will be actioned after the Show.

A Novice in Paced and Mannered Classes is a Horse or Pony which has not won 6 firsts in Paced and/or Mannered Classes at an A&P Show at the time of the Show.

Novice Champions are not eligible for Open Championships unless they have won their Open Class, nor are they eligible for Supreme Award. Championship award does not count as a win.

Novices may enter Open Classes.

Novice ponies may be ridden by riders of any age in Novice Classes only. In Open Section the stated age applies.

Substitutions

E9. Substitutions must be advised in writing by 12 noon Wednesday 16 April 2014. A substitution form is included in this schedule. The substitution must be owned by the exhibitor in accordance with Condition E3.

Electronic Devices

E10. It is an offence for any electronic or audio equipment deemed possible to provide external assistance to an exhibitor to be carried on an exhibitor in the show ring. Penalties may include forfeiting all prize money, awards and qualification and elimination from any further Classes at that Show.

Disabled Exhibitors

Those exhibitors requiring an aid for assistance during competition may apply to the Royal Agricultural Society for an Identification Card. RAS, PO Box 54, Woodend, North Canterbury 7641. Phone 03-312 4116.

Forbidden Substances Testing

E11. The use of tranquillisers, stimulants, or any substance which affects the performance of horses or ponies is forbidden.

E12. Exhibitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show. Testing of all animals will be at the owner's risk and will be carried out under FSJC procedures (Ref.10 of RAS By Laws and Regulations Section 55A).

E13. Your signature on the entry form, and/or participation in competition, denotes acceptance of these conditions. (Ref. Rule 89 of RAS Equestrian Competitors and Judges Rule Book).

Judging & Presentation of Exhibits

E14. Exhibitors must have their entries ready for judging at the times stated, or they will be liable for disqualification.

E15. No distinguishing mark of ownership or stud name, with the exception of registered brands, may be attached to the animal exhibited or the handler.

In Hand Horses & Ponies

E16. In Led Classes breeding must be shown on the entry form.

E17. Horses must be presented for judging in the required manner.

E18. For In Hand Classes all stock to be led clockwise with the attendant on the near side. Attendants are requested to be suitably attired when parading horses in the ring. No-one under 16 can lead a large animal.

Stallions

E19. Stallions when led should be controlled by a colt bit with a single lead, or a chain over the nose attached to a single lead with the exception of miniatures. Stallions are not to be tied up unattended unless appropriately confined. It is recommended that stallions be kept in stables or approved suitable yards. At the time of entry, all stallion owners must either be in possession of, or apply for at time of entry, a stallion identification badge, which must be displayed at the stable and on the horse at all times while at the Show. Official badges are available from the NZEF or temporary badges are available at time of entry from Auckland A&P Association.

Mares

E20. Mares shown in Brood Mare Classes must have a foal at foot or present a veterinary certificate of pregnancy that includes a projected foaling date. "Dry" Mare is a mare not to foal during current Show season (1 August to 31 July).

Saddle Horses & Ponies

E21. No horse or pony under 3 years of age is permitted to be shown under saddle.

E22. In no case may horses or ponies be ridden outside the designated area.

E23. No change of rider will be allowed in any horse or pony Classes after once entering the ring for that class, except in exceptional cases when consent of the judge or Chief Horse Steward must be obtained.

E24. A horse or pony being eligible for a Championship must be ridden by the same rider as in the Class or Classes in which it qualified unless the permission of the Chief Horse Steward has been obtained. In the case of a rider qualifying more than one pony, a second rider may be found.

E25. The age of the rider is taken as at November 1 2013. Riders on open ponies are to be under 17 years of age.

E26. Judges are directed to award prizes only to Horses which they consider free from hereditary unsoundness.

In all Classes LATECOMERS will not be accepted into the Ring for judging.

Measuring

E27. There will be no measuring during the Show. All stock to be measured must be measured prior to the event and class changes notified immediately. The onus is on the exhibitor to enter the correct class.

E28. Youngstock Measures issued after 1 August are valid until 31 January of the following year. Measured issued after 1 January are valid till 31 July of the same year.

E29. Where height is a requirement of the Section exhibitors must carry an official RAS Life or Horse/Pony annual Height and Performance Card or Youngstock Certificate. Failure to do so will result in elimination.

E30. Horses and Ponies must be measured by an Official Measurer and this decision shall be final. When shod, 0.5cm thickness of shoes is allowed.

Stabling

E32. Parking is available on a daily basis for local exhibitors' trucks and cars with floats, with horses able to be tied to floats in the designated area. Note: stabling is available.

E33. Applications must be made at time of entry using stabling form in Schedule.

E34. Application must be restricted to a stable for each horse exhibited. Stables are not to be used for storing gear, feed etc. If a horse/pony is scratched, the exhibitor must notify the stabling supervisor for the stable to be reallocated.

E35. Preference for boxes is given to Stallions, Colts, Brood Mares with Foals, Young stock, and exhibitors from a distance. Stallion boxes must have sign denoting "STALLION" on outside of box.

E36. Exhibitors tying horses in alleyways of the Stabling Complex will be liable to disqualification and asked to remove their horses from Alexandra Park.

E37. The Association does not guarantee to provide horse accommodation as the number of stables is limited. Exhibitors who are not allocated a stable may obtain a refund on application to the Equestrian Show Office.

E38. Wet and dirty straw must be removed on vacating stable. It is the Exhibitor's responsibility to keep the stable and the area outside clean and tidy. Exhibitors are asked to notify the Secretary at the Equestrian Show Office if stable is not clean. **Drainage grates must not be removed.**

Stabling allocations will be posted at the stables.

There will be NO smoking in the Stabling Complex.

PUBLIC ENTER STABLES AT THEIR OWN RISK.

Unloading of Horses & Vehicle Parking

E39. Horse floats are to enter Alexandra Park through Gate E, Greenlane West to designated parking areas. Vehicles must have appropriate windscreen passes in place PRIOR to arrival or vehicles will be turned away. Parked vehicles will be policed for windscreen passes and those not displaying correct passes will be towed away without warning. Exhibitors must remove floats from unloading area beside Stabling Complex immediately after unloading is completed. Showers and toilets will be available in Stabling Complex.

Award of Championships

E40. Champion and Reserve Champion will be selected as follows: First Prize winners in all eligible Classes to be paraded before the Judge.

Once the Champion has been selected, the animal with second prize from the same class as the Champion shall parade with the others for Reserve Champion.

The Easter Show, Supreme Champion Tri-colour Sashes, Champion and Reserve Champion sashes will be awarded.

Prize Money & Sponsorships

E41. All Class and Award Sponsorships are subject to confirmation. Prize Money as stated will be paid in full but is not payable in addition to sponsorship. All prize money will be paid by cheque after the Show. Any prize money cheques not presented by the end of September 2014 will be forfeited.

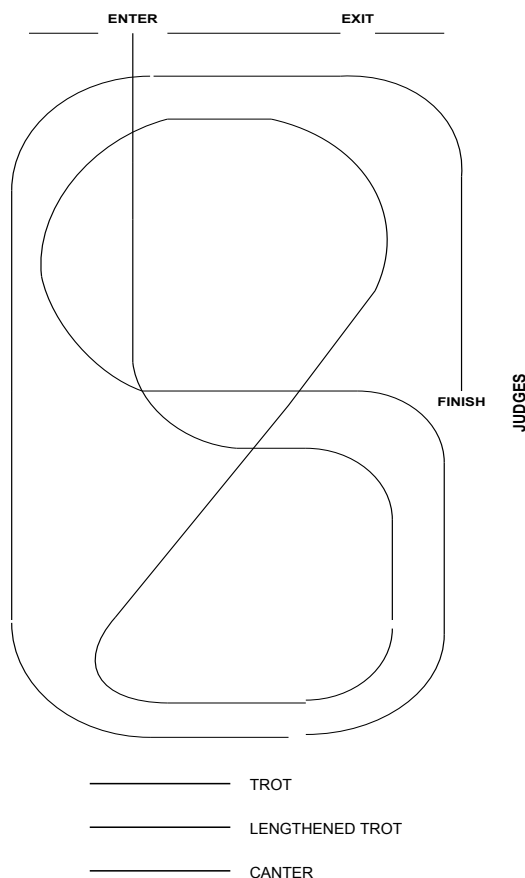

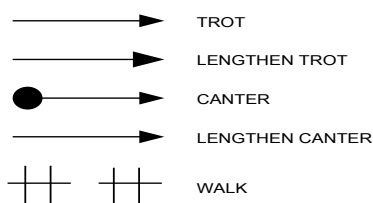
