CONDITIONS

CLAUSE 1 - CLASS 38 - PONY OF THE YEAR

The following ponies will qualify for the Class 38 – Pony of the Year.

- a) The Top 18 ponies from the FMG Pony Grand Prix Series as at the 14th March 2010.
- b) The 2009 Pony of the Year winning combination if they are not included in the top 18 as per (a) above, as long as the rider is eligible because of age.
- c) The current North Island and South Island Champions
- d) A maximum of the top 7 not already qualified ponies from Class 23, Pony Championship stakes.
- e) Any overseas rider who has been invited through their National Federation

CLAUSE 2 - CLASS 37 - PREMIER STAKES

The following horses will qualify for Class 37 – Premier Stakes

- a) The top 20 horses from the Cathay Pacific 1 & 2 star Grand Prix Series as at the 14th March 2010 who have not nominated to start in Class 50, the Olympic Cup Class.
- b) Please note that horses who nominated to start in Class 50 as at the 9th March will not be eligible to compete in Class 37

CLAUSE 3 - CLASS 50 - OLYMPIC CUP

The following conditions apply to Class 50 – Olympic Cup

- a) Limited to 30 horses
- b) A nomination fee of \$500 must be paid with entries by the 14th February 2010 (Closing Date)
- c) This nomination fee becomes non-refundable as at the 9th March unless a vet certificate is produced.
- d) Acceptance fee is to be paid to the Kelt Capital Horse of the Year Office by 4pm on Saturday 20th March 2010.
- e) A cheque will be available, to each competitor starting in Class 50, from the Horse of the Year Office 30minutes after the completion of this class. Please note that, where applicable, the cheque is part payment of the prizemoney and will thus be deducted from the rider's total prizemoney. The remaining prizemoney will be paid out after the show.
- f) If more than 30 combinations enter this class, it will be up to the committee to decide who competes.
- g) Due to Quarantine conditions, the committee reserves the right to change the prize money and entry restrictions, should they deem this necessary. If less than 30 horses start, the prizemoney will be paid out as stated on the Horse of the Year Website, which is the official schedule, down to the number of horses that start.

CLAUSE 4 – CLASS 51 – INTERMEDIATE RIDER OF THE YEAR

- This class has the same age restrictions as the Young Rider Series
- b) Riders who are entering both Classes 25 & 51 must <u>not</u> ride the same horse in both classes. However the same rider may enter both classes on different horses.
- c) Junior Riders may enter this Class as well as Class 8 and 24

CLAUSE 5 — CLASS 29 - NZ PONY CLUB AREA TEAM OF THE YEAR

- a) Teams are to consist of 2 ponies and 2 horses.
- b) Teams are to be selected by New Zealand Pony Club Areas
- c) Team members must be certified Pony Club Members and the 5 rally rule applies.
- d) Individual entries for this class are <u>not</u> to be made to the Horse of the Year Office
- e) Areas are to submit entries to the NZPC Assn Executive Officer, PO Box 8626, Havelock North by 14th February 2010. No individual entries, for this class, will be accepted.
- f) If team members wish to enter other classes at the show, they must enter these other classes as normal through the Horse of the Year Office.
- g) There will be no stabling on the grounds unless full stabling fees are paid to the Horse of the Year office, as per stabling conditions.
- h) There will be no ground levy payable by team members who are not competing in any other class.
- i) Team members who are competing in other classes, as well as Class 29, must send their ground levy and stabling fees, with their normal entry forms, to the Horse of the Year Office.

CLAUSE 6 – CLASS 24 - JUNIOR RIDER OF THE YEAR

The top 17 from the Kiwispan NZ Junior Rider Series as at the 14th March 2010 and the top 5 unqualified riders from Class 8 will qualify for this Class, plus any overseas rider who has been invited through their National Federation. Class 24 is not part of the Kiwispan Junior Rider Series

CLAUSE 7 - CLASS 38, 40, 47, 54- PONY CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

- a) Ponies may only enter **one** class from Classes 38,40,47 and 54.
- b) Riders may enter as many of these classes as they wish but each entry must be on a different pony.

CLAUSE 8 - CLASSES 8, 13,14, 25, 37, 38, 41, 50, 52- SERIES CLASSES

Please note that all series classes are run under their respective series conditions. To check on these conditions please see the Showjumping Section of Equestrian Sports New Zealand Website – www.nzequestrian.org.nz.

CLAUSE 9 - CLASS 18 - SABA SAM SHIELD Annex 8 Art 32.2

- 1. There are no individual entries
- 2. The manager of each team must complete the team entry form available from the office and return it to the office, with the entry fee by 4.00pm on Wednesday 17th March
- 3. The second round is part of the Pony Championship Stakes, Class 23. A member of any one of the teams that proceeds to the second round, and is not eligible, in their own right, to compete in the Pony Championship Stakes, Class 23, may ride in this competition as a team member only.
- 4. If a competitor wishes to also enter the Pony Championship Stakes, Class 23, then they must also. pay the entry fee for this class

CLAUSE 10 - All classes

- a) All Showjumping horses must have an ESNZ approved ID tag which must be worn during the whole event at all times. Art 147.1
- b) The committee reserves the right to decide if any wild card entries will be permitted to start in their respective qualified classes

CLAUSE 11 - Dress

The Organising Committee stipulate the following standard of dress, as per Article 256 Paragraph 1.5.2. The required dress approved by SJNZ, a red or green or black jacket, a SJNZ registered hunt coat or colour of a recognised hunt, white or light fawn breeches, black or brown boots or top boots. A white tie, or choker, or a hunting stock and a white or lightly coloured shirt must be worn. If a jacket is not worn shirts must have long or short sleeves. This dress code will be required in all show jumping rings.

Article 256 Paragraphs 1.2-1.4 - 1.5.3.- &1.7 will also be enforced.
