1. Entries will ONLY be accepted on the **Official KCHOY Entry Form & Eventing Section Entry Form**, both to be completed and sent to Isobel Death, as above
2. The organizing committee reserves its rights, as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Articles 629 & 610.
3. All classes will be run under all applicable ESNZ & FEI Rules and Regulations updated August 2009.
4. The Organising Committee reserves the right to ballot entries if necessary as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Article 628.2
5. All horses are required to have either FEI passports or fully completed Official ESNZ Identification papers – FEI Article 511.
6. All competitors must wear fully completed medical cards for showjumping & cross country Tests.
7. All horses entered in classes 800 & 801 must be presented for the arrival inspection prior to beginning the event.
8. All relevant information accompanied by the relevant entry fee and must be in the hands of the Secretary, Isobel Death, RD 4, Waipukurau 4284, by 14 February 2010.
9. All scratchings must be notified immediately, as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Article 629. No refunds will be paid for scratchings after the close of entries for classes 800 & 801, class 802 and 803 refunds will be made in accordance with ENZ Article 629 1.2
10. All fees listed in this schedule include GST
11. Qualifications – The qualification period ends on 24 February 2010. Qualification page must be completed for classes 800 & 801. Qualifications of classes 800 & 801 competitors and horses do not necessarily have to be acquired as a combination.

CODE OF CONDUCT

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.

"All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They are therefore strongly advised to take out a third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad and to keep the policy up to date".
