### Specific conditions

- § A sport horse is defined as a horse expected to mature at 155cm or higher that is particularly suited to the FEI equestrian sports of dressage, showjumping or eventing; and related activities of hunting and pleasure riding.
- § The horse must have been born in New Zealand and be registered with a recognized breed society or the NZ Sport Horse Association Inc.
- § Colts and stallions 2 years and older must wear the red Stallion plate on their bridle/halters at all times.
- § Handlers attire is not judged and we encourage you to wear casual but comfortable clothing that allows you to run out your horse to best advantage.
- § All entries will be required to include 3 generation pedigrees and registration details which may be used in publicity for the event.
- § All entries must have official ESNZ showjumping bridle numbers which must be worn at all times. Bridle numbers will be available for sale at the event.
- § Breed Societies are invited to award special prizes to the best performed of their studbook at the show. Please contact the show convenor for further information.

## LED Classes for NZ bred Sport Horses

### Showhunter Ring – Saturday starting at approximately 4:00 pm

Judged on conformation, paces, obedience and type. Where applicable in the mare class, actual performance in competition may be taken into consideration.

Ribbons to 4 placings. All placegetters to receive an A4 certificate suitable for framing.

**501 Mare 3 years & older Most Suitable for Breeding Sport Horses**      \$25.00      \$80, 60, 40  
*Must be competing under saddle in other equestrian classes at the show (dressage, eventing, showhunters or showjumpers) or in the Performance Classes for NZ Sport Horses.*

**502 Best Presented Led Horse & Handler:**      \$25.00      \$100, 50  
judged over the Sport Horse Led Classes on overall appeal of horses grooming and ability of the handler to show the horse off to best advantage.

## RIDDEN Classes for NZ bred Sport Horses – under saddle

- § Horses judged under saddle on conformation, paces, obedience, type and jumping where applicable.
- § A horse can be entered in no more than 2 of the following classes. Entries may be accepted on the day into more than 2 classes if organizers agree.
- § Classes may be age combined where entries are insufficient.
- § Horses will be expected to jump in classes for showjumping, eventing and hunting. Requirements for dressage may include a small test to show off paces and obedience.
- § *Hunting horses* are expected to be of a heavier type than *Event horses* – so a horse can only be entered in one or the other but NOT both.

Up to 4 qualifiers from Suitability for NZ Sport Horse championships

*Champion Ridden NZ Sport Horse (\$500 & rug)  
& Reserve Champion Ridden NZ Sport Horse (\$250)*

***NZ Sport Horse Bonus*** – \$250 additional prize money if the Champion from either section was registered with the NZ Sport Horse Association Inc before the HOY Show entries closed – Feb 15, 2010.
