GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR SHOW

- Entries close with the secretary Anne Vallance, Main-Events, PO Box 448, Masterton 5840. Email anne@main-events.co.nz on Monday 23 March 2010. Cheques to be made payable to NZ Breeders Show. Please include a copy of the pedigree with your entries.
- 2. Late entries accepted at 25% extra and start at beginning of the class.
- Refunds less 25% no refunds after entries close without vet or medical certificate.
- 4. Please note qualifications related to all classes both showjumping and show hunters.
- 4.1. The person responsible for the horse taking part in the series must be able to produce proof of age from the breeder or a veterinarian. In the case of discrepancy, the breeder's information will be definitive.
- 4.2 The identification page of the NZIP identification papers must be completed and the breeding must be completed to 3 generations. Any exceptions to this rule will only be made in a formal application to the NF giving a full reason for the inability to find the breeding. No reasons need to be given for refusals to give permission for horses missing breeding from taking part in the series.
- Horses competing in the Young Horse 4-8 Yrs Showjumping classes must be aged between 4 years and 8 years of age and meet the pedigree and identifications requirements as above under Condition 4.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to alter the program and prize money as they see fit (Article 144.4 ESNZ General Regulations).
- 7. Any prize money won over \$500 in any one competition will attract withholding tax at 39% unless you provide a GST Invoice or an IR3 form.
- 8. Stables and Covered Yards Accommodation at Taupo Equestrian Centre (for whole show) Yards and paddocks \$15 per horse for show. Stables, covered yards and Stallion Barn \$36 per horse for show. Paddocks 3 horses to a paddock \$15 per horse for show. All yards and stables must be left clean before leaving or you will be charged for cleaning. Absolutely no taped yards allowed. If you are entitled to a NEC Lease Yard, please list the lease number with your entries.
- 9. Camping fee of \$30 without power for show and \$45 with power includes ONE truck/float and driver. All others (including riders) over 12 years of age must pay an additional \$15 each for show. Please nominate how many people will be staying on the grounds with your entries and pay the appropriate additional camping fee.
- South Island horses in age classes will have free entries from the NZYH Breeding Show and free yards from the National Equestrian Centre.
- 11. All horses competing at the show will be allocated a bridle number. The numbering system will be provided at the show. Please pick up on arrival.
- 12. There is a ground fee of \$6 per horse. These charges must be paid with the entries.
- 13. Hard hats must be worn at all times when mounted.
- 14. Dogs must be on leads while competition is in progress.
- 15. The Organising committee accepts no liability in the case of injury or damage to animals, riders, spectators or vehicles. (Article 160 ESNZ General Regulations). Enter the grounds at your own risk.
- 16. Objections, complaints and appeals refer to rulebook articles 167-171. Complaints must be lodged with the secretary within 1 hour and accompanied by a fee of \$50. The fee will be refunded if the complaint is upheld by the ground jury.
- 17. Gates to and from the showgrounds may be locked after 10:00 pm each night.

SHOWJUMPING AND SHOWHUNTER CONDITIONS

- 18. All showjumping and showhunter classes run under ESNZ rules. Horse and riders must be registered for competition with the ESNZ.
- Entry fees for age classes only one EF for all qualifying showjumping Age Series championship classes – 4 Year Old \$55; 5Yr Old \$65; 6Yr Old \$75 and 7 Yr Old \$85.
- Age Series classes, Amateur Rider and Junior Rider Classes run under SJNZ Series Conditions. Age Series classes also run under conditions in Annexe 9.
- 21. Age Group (5,6 & 7) Championships these competitions will be over three rounds one on each day of the event. These rounds will be judged under Table A (Article 238.1) over one round without a jump off. The winner will be the horse with the lowest number of penalties over the 3 rounds. If there are equal penalties for the first place, there will be a jump off. If there are further equalities of penalties then the fastest time will decide the winner. All other conditions will be as for the series competitions. A qualification standard may be applied for horses starting on the final day down to a minimum of 12. The top 6 placed horses in each age group series before this event begins will automatically be granted a place in the final regardless of the number qualifying as long as they have competed in the two previous rounds at this show.

- 22. Starting order for the 5, 6, and 7 year old championships, the first round will be in reverse order of the horses placing in the respective age group series. Those horses that have not had points in the series will be placed in a draw and will start before the horses that have obtained series points. In the second round, the horses take part in reverse order of their penalities from the first round. Those with equal placings will start in the order they were drawn for the first round. In the third round, the starting order will be in the reverse order of placings after the two previous rounds. Where there is equality of placings, these horses start in the order they were drawn in the first round.
- 23. Riders may enter in either the Amateur or Junior divisions, but not both.

- 24. Horses taking part in age group championships may not take part in any other show jumping class unless they have retired from age group classes with the exception of those competing in Junior and Amateur rider classes.
- 25. To be eligible for the style prize, horses must not be wearing any hind boots other than fetlock boots intending for preventing brushing.

SHOW HUNTER SPECIFIC CONDITIONS

- 26. Show Hunters classes are run under SHNZ rules, please refer for Junior and Amateur rulings.
- 27. A horse of any age may compete in Open, Junior and Amateur classes.
- 28. Show Hunter conditions practice rounds for both days 7:30 to 8:15 am at \$5 per round.
- 29. All classes are Horse of the Year Qualifiers for HOY 2010.
- 30. Maximum number of starts per horse per day in showhunter classes Day 1-3 open hunter classes, 1 age group and 1 junior or amateur class. Day 2-2 open hunter classes, 1 age group class and 1 junior or amateur class.
- 31. Classes may be judged back to back with the approval of the judge.

- 32. Due to insurance requirements, all handlers must be members of the ESNZ and horses must be registered with the ESNZ. Day memberships at \$5 per day and day registrations at \$5 per horse are available. Please add to your entry.
- Entry forms can be downloaded from the Main-Events Website at www.main-events.co.nz.
- 34. The AGM for members of the NZ Sport Horse Promotion Board Inc. will be held on the Saturday evening after the Led Section on the showgrounds. Time and venue to be notified.
- 35. The person taking part in the led classes must be able to prove the age of the horse and have 3 generations of pedigree documented. A registration certificate from a recognized breed society, or letter from the breeder will be accepted and must be included with entry form.
- 36. The handler is not judged on attire in the led or suitability classes we suggest you wear comfortable clothes and suitable shoes for running to show your horse off to best effect.
- 37. Stabling horses competing in the showjumping and show hunter sections will have priority for the covered yards. As there are limited stallion boxes, colts not otherwise competing in the show may not be accepted for the led classes. You will be notified and a full refund given.
- 38. Please note All colts 3 yrs and over must wear the Stallion badge on their bridle as per ESNZ Regulations.
- 39. Horses may be tested for banned substances as per ESNZ Veterinary Regulations.

SIRES AND BREEDERS LEADERBOARD AT THIS SHOW

40. The Sires and Breeders leaderboard will be based on points earned by all progeny of a stallion or breeder in competitions at this show (not including Junior, Amateur, Young Rider, Led Championships, and Led Family classes). Points will be awarded as follows – full conditions will be available at the show:

Age Series Qualifying Rounds 1 & 2 5 pts for 1st equals
Age Series Classes Final 15, 10, 7, 5, 3, 2, 1
Young Horse (4 – 8 Yrs) & Show Hunters – Day 1 5, 3, 2, 1
Young Horse (4 – 8 Yrs) & Show Hunters – Day 2 7, 5, 3, 2, 1
Led Horses (not including championships or family group) 5, 3, 2, 1
