Conditions of Entry:

- 1. All animals must belong to a clear TB herd where whole herd testing is performed in accordance with the AANZ voluntary TB scheme. Copies of current TB certificates are to be enclosed with the Entry Forms.
- 2. All Alpacas entered in Championship Classes must be registered with the IAR and carry a brass ear tag displaying its corresponding IAR number.
- 3. The exhibitor is the owner(s) listed on the Alpaca's registration certificate. In the case of a registered lease, the lessee is deemed the owner.
- 4. The age of the Alpaca is its age on the day of the Show.
- 5. All exhibitors or handlers must place their animals in the pens allocated by the Convenor.
- 6. Placement of animals in "Trade Pens" will only be done with the permission of the Chief Steward.
- 7. No animal shall be removed from the Show prior to the completion of the Grand Parade without the permission of the Chief Steward.

ENTRIES CLOSE: 18 September 2015 at 5pm Entries received after this date will be accepted but not catalogued.

Confirmation of entries will be sent to each exhibitor once their entry has been received by the Show Secretary. Tickets will be posted with your confirmation of entries and will include information regarding stalls, parking and Show maps.

Substitutions will be at the discretion of the Chief Steward.

Catalogues are COMPULSORY so please ensure you add the fee with your entries. Catalogues can be picked up on the day. Correct exhibit numbers must be worn or the exhibit will not be allowed in the ring.

Please ensure that each cattle stall is tidy and is returned to the manner it was found by completion of the Show.

Any protest must be made within 1 hour of completion of the class in writing, signed by the person making the complaint and delivered to the Show Office.

A limited amount of sawdust will be provided for bedding in the Beef section.

Additional straw/shavings can be provided at the expense of the competitor and this information will be sent to you with confirmation of your entries.

The RAS Yellow Card system applies across the whole Royal Show in relation to acceptable conduct.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR BEEF CATTLE SECTION: All cattle must be full purebred and registered with their respective Breed Society.

- 1. Entry in the Show entitles the Society to publish an Exhibitors name in result reports and distribute with Exhibitor lists.
- 2. The date of birth of all Breeding Cattle must be stated at time of entry.
- 3. As the age of Beef Cattle is determined from 1st June in each year all animals shall be deemed one year older on the 1st June. Calves at foot must be born on or after 1st June prior to the show.
- 4. All Animals entered in Pairs, Groups or All Breeds classes, including bulls, whether they be entered in Special Classes or otherwise, must also be entered in at least one other class for which they are eligible.
- 5. In all classes of female stock, Judges are to withhold awards for cattle, which in their opinion, are barren.
- 6. All bulls one year and over must be RUNG or wear a spring-loaded nose grip when parading. Rings will be inspected prior to judging and bulls must be securely tied in stalls with a good rope or stout leather halter with rope or chain attachment overnight. It is compulsory that all Beef Females (born before 31 December last) be led by a halter and nose clip. Supervisors and Chief Stewards will have the full right to report any infringements to the Protest Committee requesting disqualification of entries.
- 7. All cattle one year old and over must be entered in a recognised Herd.
- 8. If any injection or dosing is given to any animal the exhibitor must report this action to a Chief Steward of the section or to the Supervisor before under taking it.
- 9. Exhibitors leading or parading stock in judging rings and parades must wear clean, white attire, or breed uniform, and these must not carry any distinguishing words or emblems.

- 10. When an animal has been duly entered and catalogued in any class but cannot be paraded, it may be replaced provided notification is given to the Cattle Steward and providing it is the property of the Exhibitor concerned. The replacement must meet entry criteria for TB and been tested clear. Breeding data is to be displayed on the stall.
- 11. The Hawker Bay A&P Society reserves the right to amalgamate classes with insufficient entries. The decision of the Society is final. Exhibitors will be notified is classes are to be amalgamated.
- 12. The Interbreed Classes are to be judged by all the Beef Breed Judges.
- 13. No Entry will be allowed in the Judging Ring without its distinguishing catalogue number and shall be led into the show ring when required by the Stewards or Judges.
- 14. Supreme Champion: The senior male, junior male, senior female and junior female champions will parade for this award, which is an RAS Gold Medal & Sash.
- 15. To qualify for entry into the All Breeds classes on Friday, stock must be entered and shown in the appropriate age classes of their breed.
- 16. Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the Showgrounds.
- 17. Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the health and safety in employment act 1992 and any amendments thereafter.
- 18. Should any person or firm be disqualified or suspended by another Association or affiliated organisation of the Royal Agricultural Society, the suspension or disqualification may also be applied by the affiliate organisations.
- 19. All persons admitted into any premises controlled by the Hawkers Bay A&P Society shall be subject to the orders of the Committee and, in the event of misbehaviour on the part of anyone attending the Show such person may be removed by order of the Society. This applies to any person whose conduct, either personal or as proprietor of a side-show, or exhibit, is a source of annoyance.
- 20. Entries will only be accepted on the official entry form.
- 21. TB STATUS OF SHOW CATTLE

As per the current Ministry for Primary Industries legislation and requirements: All Cattle entered for showing must be from a TB Clear Herd.

A copy of the current TB test certificate must be attached to your entry forms. The Society must be notified at the time of entry of any testing to be carried out after closing date of entries or of any TB issues that may arise after entries have been submitted. Owners entering cattle must sign the declaration printed on the entry form.

There are now two documents required under Ministry for Primary Industries regulations. TB Test Certificate:

For Cattle from declared movement controlled areas. all cattle over the age of 3 months are to be tested, and have a clear test within 60 days prior to being moved to the Show. All other animals must be from a herd that is up to date with its current routine TB testing requirements.

TB Animal Status Declaration Card.

This is a legal requirement for all animals being moved. All animals entered must be accompanied in transit by a signed and dated TB Animal Status Declaration Card showing a TB Clear status in accordance with present legislation. Animal individual numbers must be included on the TB test sheet. These cards may be inspected at the unloading area.

Drugs and Forbidden Substances means any substances capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage, conformation or conduct of an animal by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system of the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, muscoskeletal or urogenital systems.

The exhibiting of all Dairy Cattle in New Zealand is governed by the RAS Dairy Cattle Show Code of Ethics document. This document is Appendixes to the Additional Rules for Showing. Specific Sections.

Other Dairy Cattle show conditions outside of the RAS Dairy Cattle Show Code of Ethics are listed below:

- a) All groups and cows in milk in the Dairy Breeds to be judged first.
- b) All Dairy Bulls two years and over must be rung, have two leaders and under adequate supervision.
- c) All Dairy Yearling Bulls must be rung and be under adequate supervision
- d) All cows three years of age and over, that have been tested and have production records printed on the entry forms have their production records printed in the catalogues.
- e) No records are necessary for maiden three-year-olds.
- f) Points in the dairy section will be awarded as follows:

A \$5 levy is to be charged per in-milk cow per show i.e. if an in-milk cow is entered in more than one class at a show then the levy is still \$5. There is no levy on exhibiting young stock.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR DAIRY CATTLE SECTION:

- 1. Entry in the Show entitles the Consortium to publish an Exhibitors name in result reports and distribute with Exhibitor lists.
- 2. The date of birth of all Cattle must be stated at time of entry. Age of Dairy Cattle shall be computed as at 1st June unless otherwise stated.
- 3. Unless otherwise stated, all individual single entries must be named or entry will not be accepted.
- 4. The Hawkers Bay A&P Society reserves the right to amalgamate classes with insufficient entries. The decision of the Society is final. Exhibitors will be notified is classes are to be amalgamated.
- 5. Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the Showgrounds.
- 6. Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the health and safety in employment act 1992 and any amendments thereafter.
- 7. Should any person or firm be disqualified or suspended by another Association or affiliated organisation of the Royal Agricultural Society, the suspension or disqualification may also be applied by the affiliate organisations.
- 8. All persons admitted into any premises controlled by the Hawkers Bay A&P Society shall be subject to the orders of the Committee and, in the event of misbehaviour on the part of anyone attending the Show such person may be removed by order of the Society. This applies to any person whose conduct, either personal or as proprietor of a side-show, or exhibit, is a source of annoyance.
- 9. Entries will only be accepted on the official entry form.
- 10. All leaders of cattle must wear a recognised Breed Uniform or other clean tidy clothing without gumboots or they will not be permitted to enter the judging ring.
- 11. All cattle must be entered in the name of the bona fide owner except those entered in the Youth show classes.
- 12. All cows in milk in the Dairy Breeds Section to be judged in catalogue order.
- 13. All Dairy Cattle entered in Special classes must be entered in at least one age class if and for which they are eligible.
- 14. All Cattle one year old and over must be entered in a recognised Herd Book, and no bull or heifer under two years of age shall be eligible for Senior Championship.
- 15. If any injection or dosing is given to any animal the exhibitor must report this to a Chief Steward of the Section or to the Supervisor.
- 16. Any alteration of conformation of cattle as per RAS rules will be considered malpractice and disqualified from the Show.
- 17. ARRIVAL OF DAIRY CATTLE Exhibitors are advised all Cattle must be stalled not later than 8.30am on the day of showing.
- 18. No cattle to be brought to the grounds before <u>midday Monday 19 October</u> unless special arrangements have been made with the Chief Steward.

- 19. All animals entered in group classes must be entered and exhibited in their respective Breed classes.
- 20. Group entries involving animals not exhibiting in their respective breed classes will be refused entry.
- 21. All Pairs and Groups must be entered and exhibited by the bona fide owner.
- 22. All exhibitors must adhere to the current RAS Rules regarding the exhibiting of Dairy Cattle in New Zealand and this will be managed by the RAS Dairy Cattle Show Ethics Committee. The full and current Code of Ethics can be found on the RAS website.
- 23. Any animal may be tested for Drugs or Forbidden Substances at any Show under the By-Laws and Regulations adopted by the Royal Agricultural Society and the Procedures adopted by the FSJC.
- 24. TB STATUS OF SHOW CATTLE

As per the current Ministry for Primary Industries legislation and requirements:

All Cattle entered for showing must be from a TB Clear Herd.

A copy of the current TB test certificate must be attached to your entry forms. The Society must be notified at the time of entry of any testing to be carried out after closing date of entries or of any TB issues that may arise after entries have been submitted. Owners entering cattle must sign the declaration printed on the entry form.

There are now two documents required under Ministry for Primary Industries regulations.

TB Test Certificate:

For Cattle from declared movement controlled areas. all cattle over the age of 3 months are to be tested, and have a clear test within 60 days prior to being moved to the Show. All other animals must be from a herd that is up to date with its current routine TB testing requirements.

TB Animal Status Declaration Card.

This is a legal requirement for all animals being moved. All animals entered must be accompanied in transit by a signed and dated TB Animal Status Declaration Card showing a TB Clear status in accordance with present legislation. Animal individual numbers must be included on the TB test sheet. These cards may be inspected at the unloading area.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY SHEEP AND FLEECE SECTION

- 22. ALL CLASSES ARE NATURAL CONDITION UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED. DECLARATION OF NATURAL CONDITION ON THE ENTRY FORM MUST BE SIGNED.
- 23. Run under the by laws and regulations of the R.A.S. This is a natural condition show.
- 24. Entry in the Show entitles the Society to publish an Exhibitors name in result reports and distribute with Exhibitor lists.
- 25. If any injection or dosing is given to any animal the exhibitor must report this action to a Chief Steward of the section or to the Supervisor before under taking it.
- 26. Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the Showgrounds.
- 27. Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the health and safety in employment act 1992 and any amendments thereafter.
- 28. Should any person or firm be disqualified or suspended by another Association or affiliated organisation of the Royal Agricultural Society, the suspension or disqualification may also be applied by the affiliate organisations.
- 29. All persons admitted into any premises controlled by the Hawkers Bay A&P Society shall be subject to the orders of the Committee and, in the event of misbehaviour on the part of anyone attending the Show such person may be removed by order of the Society. This applies to any person whose conduct, either personal or as proprietor of a side-show, or exhibit, is a source of annovance.
- 30. Entries will only be accepted on the official entry form.
- 31. Exhibitors must check their confirmation of entry carefully. Once entries are catalogued, changes cannot be made and cannot be penned, unless the error originates with the Administration.
- 32. Sheep must be un-shorn unless otherwise stated. Date of previous shearing must be given when entry is made. Age to be declared in every case at time of entry. The age of sheep must date from the end of the third week after lambing commences.
- 33. In all ewe & lamb classes the quality of lambs is to be taken into consideration in all judging.
- 34. Ewe and her Lamb: Exhibitors are asked to note that in Ewe and Lamb Classes, lambs must be her suckling lambs.
- 35. Imported sheep lambed in April shall be deemed to have been born on the last day of the month.
- 36. The Society reserves the right to divide existing pens for the purpose of penning exhibits, should the entries necessitate such action.
- 37. Exhibitors are to have sheep penned no later than 12.30pm on Thursday for breed classes or

- 8.30am on Friday for All Breeds.
- 38. Definition of Hogget: A sheep born after 1st July in any one year shall be considered a hogget up to and including 31 December the following year except in the case of the Dorset Horn and Poll Dorset sheep when 1 May should be substituted for 1 July.
- 39. Hoggets are eligible for Championship Judging.
- 40. Sheep must be exhibited in the class entered . no changes can be made.

Natural Condition Sheep Rules:

A declaration must be made on the entry form stating:

The actual date the sheep were shorn

That they were shorn evenly and close to the skin

That the wool has not been trimmed or locked in any way since

That the sheep have not been coloured or oiled, other than by dipping in a standard sheep dip preparation.

No dipping or bloom dipping will be allowed within one month of exhibition.

Sheep in natural condition must not be housed except in transit or covered for more than 48 hours before judging. All sheep in Natural Condition Classes will be examined by Inspectors before judging. They shall disqualify any sheep which they consider do not conform to the term natural Condition. The Inspectors decision shall be final and not subject to appeal or objection.

Bloom Dip and Artificial Colouring:

The attention of Exhibitors is drawn to the provision of the Stock Amendment Act, 1963, Clause 4, which states:

No person shall sell or offer for sale any substance or preparation to be used, or purporting to be suitable for use, in the artificial colouring, blooming, or conditioning which results in colouring, of the wool of sheep.

No person shall use any such substance or preparation on any sheep or on the wool of any sheep.

No person shall sell, or offer for sale or bring or cause to be brought onto any land or other place at which sheep are offered for sale. Or exhibition any sheep the wool of which has been treated with any substance or preparation to which sub-section of this section applies. Every person who acts in contravention of this section commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$200.

Brucellosis Testing:

All exhibitors must sign a declaration stating that rams entered for the Show are either: From a flock currently accredited brucellosis free. Or have no palpable lesion of epididymitis and have received a negative test for ovine brucellosis. Copies of the accreditation certificate or the test certificate must be forwarded with the entry form.




