- Overnight camping allowed on grounds, food & coffee available. **8am-6.30 Sat/Sun**

- Late entries 50% penalty and start first in Show Jumping and Show Hunter.

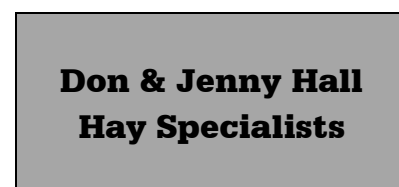
