

As many of you will be aware, Equestrian Australia (EA) announced earlier this year, that they will be adopting and enforcing new helmet standards as of 1 January 2017

The Mount Gambier Showjumping Club had decided to enforce this new standard for the entirety of our event. This is to avoid any confusion as our event runs in to 2017. The new standard of **CE EN1384 VG1** (the 'VG1' is the important bit!), or any of the other acceptable standards, including **AS/NZS 3838** (current Australian Standard) or **ASTM F1163** (current US Standard) will be enforced from the start of training rounds Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> December.

All riders must bring their helmets (and guardian if under 18 years old) to the office before riding to be approved and to collect rider packs.

Juniors of ANY AGE can compete in the Unofficial classes below 105cm. MGSJC membership is sufficient.

For classes 105cm and above, a competitor is a Junior from 1<sup>st</sup> January of the year they turn 12 until 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year they turn 18. EA membership is a requirement.

#### **Rules:**

- By entering this event, competitors are agreeing to abide by the EA Code of Conduct
- 10% discount on entries for all current financial Mount Gambier Showjumping Club members (membership year 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December)
- Horses may be entered in a maximum of 2 classes per day Saturday and Sunday.
- All riders in official classes 105cm and above must be members of EA. MGSJC membership is sufficient for unofficial classes
- All events are judged under FEI rules and regulations.
- Riders may enter and ride as many horses as they wish.
- Juniors of ANY AGE can compete in the Unofficial classes below 105cm.
- A competitor is a Junior from 1<sup>st</sup> January of the year they turn 12 until 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year they turn 18.
- A competitor is a Young Rider from 1<sup>st</sup> January of the year they turn 16 until 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year they turn 21.
- Young Riders may not compete in Junior Classes.
- Eligible Juniors may compete Junior <u>OR</u> Young Rider (but not both) for each horse entered.
- Combined classes will be drawn Juniors first.
- Horses may only enter one of classes 19, 20, 21, 22.
- Protests must be lodged in writing within 20 minutes of the event and accompanied by \$30 non-refundable unless protest is upheld.
- Prizemoney will be posted within one week of the conclusion of the Show.
- Late entries will be accepted at an additional charge of \$5 per class.
- Refund Policy:
  - Administration Fee non refundable
  - o Entry and camping fees and medical levy will be refunded on scratching up until the commencement of the Show
  - Entry fees from scratchings during the Show may be applied to alternate entries during this show only (will not be carried over)
  - o Scratchings accompanied by a Vet Certificate or Medical Certificate will be refunded
