#### **RULES AND CONDITIONS**

#### General Rules

- 1) Exhibitors compete at their own risk. The Anything Equestrian & Showfields disclaims any responsibility for any damage/injury to people, horses or property.
- 2) Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the grounds.
- 3) Colts and Stallions are permitted at this show on a case by case basis and if accepted the handler/rider must be over the age of 18, wear a red stallion bib and be accompanied by a support person 18 years or over. The colt/stallion must wear a red stallion tag on either side of the bridle.
- 4) Ridden horses are to be 3 years old or older.
- 5) Horses/ponies deemed by the judge or steward to be dangerous, unruly, out of control or who are disrupting the ring will be asked to leave the ring.
- 6) Any handlers/riders deemed by the judge or steward to unfairly treating their horse or causing inconvenience to other competitors may be asked to leave the ring this may include but is not limited to excessive use of the whip, abuse of horse/pony, continuously riding too close behind another horse, lack of control of their horse.
- 7) Ponies may be ridden by an adult in the Open section.
- 8) All Novice horses are to be ridden in a snaffle. No double bridles or pelhams are permitted in Novice classes.
- 9) Regulation safety helmets must be worn at all times while riding on the grounds, failure to comply will result in instant disqualification. All helmets must be tagged with the ESNZ/NZPCA red tag.
- 10) Suitable footwear must be worn while mounted.
- 11) Competitors are to supply their own number which must be clearly displayed on the rider's arm, leg or back or on the horse's chest in a number holder or on the competitor's saddle blanket. Numbers will advised by 5pm on the Thursday before the competition.
- 12) The Judge's decision is final no correspondence is to be entered into while the judge is judging.
- 13) Only the judge, steward, official photographer and competitors entered in the current class are permitted in the ring.
- 14) Protests must be lodged with the Director in writing accompanied by \$50 cash deposit within 30 minutes of the incident occurring, cash will be refunded if the protest is upheld
- 15) Abuse of horse or persons will not be tolerated and will result in elimination.
- 16) <u>NO DOGS</u> are permitted on the grounds or in vehicles. Competitors will be eliminated and asked to leave the grounds should they bring a dog onto the grounds with no refund given.
- 17) Rings and classes may be combined or split depending on entry numbers.
- 18) Entry fees are non-refundable, unless a veterinary or medical certificate is provided in which case 85% of the entry fee will be refunded. Notification of scratching must be made before 8am on competition day and veterinary/medical certificates must be received within 48 hours of scratching or the refund will be forfeited.
- 19) The inhand ring is open to any combination, combinations may compete in inhand only or can chose to do inhand and ridden.
- 20) Combinations may compete in more than one ring if eligible.
- 21) There are no Champions or Reserve Champions awarded on the day, points are recorded and Champions, Reserves and Ring Supremes are decided by the accumulation of a combination's points.
- 22) Points are per combination, if a horse is competed by two different riders then that horse will have two different points' accumulations.
- 23) Competitors must nominate to compete in either lightweight or heavyweight, Novice or Open, Filly/Mare or Gelding, A&P or non A&P sections. Combinations are only eligible to compete in one section not both.
- 24) This show will go ahead rain, hail or shine
- 25) Have fun, smile and enjoy!
