• <u>ENTRIES CLOSE TUESDAY 15 JANUARY 2019</u>. Late entries (+50% penalty on entry fees) accepted until Friday 18 January. Online entries: www.main-events.com. Payment by direct credit prior to 5 January (ANZ 06-0637-0265700-00), PoliPay during online entries - is available for Westpac, ANZ, ASB, BNZ, Kiwi bank or TSB Bank. No postal or emailed entries. No texts. Thank you.

• Late entries will be accepted but will incur a 50% penalty from closing date until 18 January 2019. ABSOLUTELY NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 18 JANUARY. ALL class changes must be completed by 5.00pm the day prior. Late entries during the show will incur a 50% penalty and changes of class a \$2 fee per change. Class scratchings less 25%. Late entries will go first in jumping classes, and the draws will be on www.mainevents.co.nz and posted on the GEC office window the evening before.

• **Ground levy**: \$5 per horse/pony; **St John's levy** \$10 per rider (maximum \$20/family), **Catalogue** \$6, are compulsory.

• Helmets: All helmets must be approved and tagged by ESNZ as meeting current safety standards. Wearing an approved helmet is compulsory for anyone competing on, working in, or schooling/riding a horse/pony for any other reason at Poverty Bay A&P Association Showgrounds Park.

• <u>STABLING FOR SHOW</u>: Covered Yards and Stallion Boxes \$40, and Yards \$15 (for Show). No horses allowed in rope or electric yards. Covered Yards and Stallion Boxes are limited. All stabling is allocated on performance basis. Once stabling has been allocated, horses scratched after Tuesday will receive no stabling refund. Excessive damage to stabling will incur a charge.

• <u>CAMPING DURING THE SHOW</u>: Power Points \$35 for the show. \$15 camping fee per truck/float for the show will apply from Thursday-Sunday for the Show. Power Points: All electrical cords plugged into the (facility) power boxes are required to be certified and have a visible tag showing. Cords will be checked and any that do not show certification tags will be removed. There is to be no tethering cords between trucks or other vehicles and the organising committee will not accept any unsafe use of these electrical sites.
