Livestock exhibitors must ensure that they keep walkways clear and no dangerous equipment or chemicals are accessible to the public.

The is to be NO SMOKING in the stables or any building. Any person found smoking in these areas will be fined \$500 and expelled from the Showgrounds.

Accidents and other Health & Safety issues must be reported to your Chief Steward or the Royal Easter Show Equestrian Office.

Loose livestock: Should an animal escape; first shut gates and doors, ensure your won and public safety, advise Section Office so that PA announcement and emergency call outs can be made.

Exhibitors must only park in the areas allocated to them.

In the event that an animal may need to be disposed of, the Show this will be at the owner's expense.
