- Champion and Reserve Champion for each section will be selected from 1st place getters in all classes except Unity/Turnout and Best rider. 2nd place getters to stand by.
- Plaiting is optional but recommended. Riding Jacket or pony club uniform also recommended.
- All Pleasure Classes will be run under NZ Equestrian Pleasure Society Rules (NZEPS). They are open to both NZEPS registered riders and horses/ponies as well as to un-registered riders and horses/ponies. However only riders and horses/ponies that are registered with NZEPS **prior** to 12 January 2019 can use Champion and Reserve Champion placings as Horse of the Year Show qualifiers.





* Pleasure Horse/Pony means those animals that do not fit the mould of a Show Horse/Pony. We welcome any breed (e.g. Appaloosas, Quarter Horses, Standardbreds, Clyde X) and colour. They should be an uncomplicated and genuine pleasure to ride. Whilst they do not possess the show quality conformation of a show horse, they should in their own way be a delight to ride, with impeccable manners. A “pleasure mount” is NOT an inexperienced mount with show quality conformation who is destined for the open show ring.

** A Maiden is a horse or pony that has not won a conformation or paced & mannered class at an open show or gymkhana with current or previous rider.

*** Unity Class : 50% Paces/Manners 25% Rider 25% Turnout

OPEN GYMKHANA/SHOW 2019

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All riders and spectators enter the grounds at their own risk.
2. **NO DOGS** whatsoever on the grounds **including in vehicles**. Instant elimination will apply to the competitor and their family if a dog is brought onto the grounds.
3. Ground Levy \$3 per mount and First aid and WRC (Wellington Regional Council) rider levy \$5 per rider.
4. No refunds unless the gymkhana is cancelled.
5. **All horse poo, rubbish and hay must be picked up and removed from the grounds**
6. The club reserves the right to alter the prizes based on the number of entries to any event. If less than 8 entries – no 3rd prize money and less than 5 entries no 2nd and 3rd prize money.
7. Cancellations to be posted on the Sportsground Makara Pony Club website on the day of the show.
8. ****A Maiden is a horse or pony that has not won a Maiden class at a show or gymkhana with current or previous rider.**
9. **Riders and mounts entering the beginner's jumping classes (201/202) are not eligible to enter any other jumping event. These classes are open to horses and ponies.**
10. **Riders may NOT be lead in any jumping class or poles on the ground**
11. Competitors entering the beginners jumping must not have won a 1st prize in that height jumping event at any open gymkhana or show, (eg if you have won a 1st in a 50cm jump you cannot enter that class or lower.)
12. **Riders may only enter a maximum of three (3) FEI jumping classes for the day – across ring 1 or 2.**
13. Objections must be made in writing and lodged with the show secretary accompanied by \$20.
14. All entries via Main-events. **Entries close Wednesday 9th January. Payment must be made at the time of entry and no entries will be accepted without payment.** Absolutely NO email or postal entries accepted.
15. **No Flat Class Entries will be taken on the day.**
16. **Jumping Entries on the day will be accepted with an additional 50% surcharge and will start first.**
