LIVESTOCK RULES, REGULATIONS, ENTRIES & FEES

Saturday 16th February 2019 Solway Showgrounds, Judds Road, Masterton

PLEASE NOTE: Exhibitors must supervise their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created, accidents, illness or damage caused by the actions of themselves or their animals at the Solway Showgrounds. Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the Health and Safety in Employment Act 1993.

PROTESTS: Protests must be lodged in writing within 30 minutes of class being completed with a fee of \$50.00 which will be refunded only if protest is upheld.

ABUSE OF SHOW OFFICIALS WILL RESULT IN DISCIPLINARY ACTION, AS WILL PARKING IN NON-DESIGNATED AREAS.

PLEASE CHECK YOUR TROPHIES THOROUGHLY AND RETURN THOSE THAT ARE THE PROPERTY OF MASTERTON A & P SHOW IN CLEAN CONDITION AT, OR BEFORE, SHOWTIME - THANK YOU.

Cattle

MYCOPLASMA BOVIS

Mycoplasma bovis, a bacterial disease affecting cattle, is spread through close and prolonged contact between cattle; and calves drinking from infected cows.

There is no risk to the public as this disease only affects cattle and, while the risk of *Mycoplasma bovis* spreading at A&P shows, calf days, rodeo and other events where cattle are present is quite low, the risk of cross contamination still remains wherever cattle mingle.

The disease has affected various shows and events but after careful consideration, and consultation with other show organisers, exhibitors and industry groups, our Beef Section have decided they will exhibit their stock as usual at this year's show.

Our Dairy Section have also consulted with exhibitors and industry bodies and have decided not to exhibit at our 2019 show ... but be assured the Dairy Section will be back again in 2020!

The only change for the public will be some special controls put in place to ensure there is no contact between cattle from various properties.

This total separation policy will mean you will still get to see the cattle but this year it will not be as up close and personal as previous years. Please remember these separation precautions are in place for a good reason – 'to ensure there is no risk to cattle on show.....at our show'!

Animal Health Board - Requirements for all breeds

All cattle entered for showing which are 1 month of age and over must be tagged with primary and secondary National I D tags and accompanied by a correctly completed TB Declaration Card.

In special circumstances owners who do not wish to tag their show animals with primary and secondary National I D tags may be issued with an exemption from Agriquality NZ. Conditions do apply.

ALL ANIMALS MUST WEAR OFFICIAL NAIT TAGS

Testing Requirements:

Declared Movement Control Areas: Cattle 3 months of age and over which are farmed within a declared Movement Control Area, must be negative to a TB test within 60 days prior to returning home from the show.

A Movement Control Permit from Agriquality NZ is required for all cattle with an Infected Status. If your herd is infected, Agriquality NZ may require up to 30 days notification to complete the necessary tests and tagging prior to the show.

All other Areas: Cattle 12 months of age and over, farmed or grazed outside of the Declared Movement Control areas, must be negative to a TB test within 12 months prior to returning home from the show.

PROTESTS: Protests must be lodged in writing within 30 minutes of class being completed with a fee of \$50.00 which will be refunded only if protest is upheld.
