STRICTLY NO TYING HORSES TO FLOATS OR TRUCKS

All horses/ponies MUST be yarded. An open yard is included in your entry fee. Covered yards need to have been paid with your entries. Yards are non-allocated.

NO DOGS ON THE SHOWGROUNDS - INCLUDING IN CARS/TRUCKS

Please obey all signs regarding horse and vehicle access.

All riders must wear helmets when mounted. Helmets must meet current NZ safety standards and be tagged accordingly with a **red tag**, as per NZPCA policy.

All tests may be called. Junior riders may carry a whip, but no spurs allowed. Senior riders may ride with a whip and spurs. Whips must not exceed 100cm. Snaffle bridles only.

Riders must report to judge's car with their name prior to riding their test.

Junior lead-rein riders must notify the judge's car they will be competing on the lead-rein. Canter will not be performed on lead-rein. Leader must not interfere with the pony's way of going.

Junior riders intending to trot the canter movements in tests, please advise the judge when you give your name. Course errors will not be called in tests where the judges have been advised in advance, however marking will reflect the movement was not cantered.

Prize giving will be held at the conclusion of the day - riders to be in team uniform, unmounted. Non-attendance forfeits prizes. Trophy engraving is the responsibility and at the cost of the recipient. Tests and ribbons may be posted at the discretion of the committee. You will need to request this **prior to leaving the show.**

Please pick up ALL hay and manure from yards and put in bins provided.

Horses and ponies should only be warmed up or ridden by their entered rider. Please no lunging horses or ponies.

Protests must be lodged within 15 minutes of class closing. Judges decision is final. Riders, parents, managers etc must not approach judges to discuss markings.

Junior Riders (aged 14yrs and under)
Senior Riders (aged 15yrs and over)

- Riders ages as of 1 January 2019.
- All riders must be currently enrolled in primary or secondary education (home-schooled students welcome)
- All riders are restricted to riding in <u>either</u> the Junior <u>or</u> the Senior classes. Junior riders may ride up in senior classes but seniors may NOT ride in junior classes.
- Teams consist of four riders from the same age group. Each rider rides two tests, best six scores to count towards Team Competition. Schools are welcome to enter more than one team. Horses and ponies may compete only in two tests.
- Riders may compete on more than one mount, subject to numbers and at the discretion of the show committee. The second mount will be entered as an individual.
- Riders may compete as part of a team of four (riding in two dressage tests each, with the best six scores to count in final team placings), or if unable to form a team we welcome individual riders. Separate ribbons and prizes for individual riders are on offer.
- Individual riders wanting to ride in a team are welcome to organise and enter as a composite team, but details must be submitted with your entry.
- The Teams Presentation award is judged separately. Teams will present as one to the judge at the scheduled time. There is no entry fee for the Teams Presentation award, but we ask that teams indicate if they are entering.
- In the interests of finishing in daylight, numbers will be capped. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.
- Organisers reserve the right to split classes into divisions within each age group, in the
 interest of allowing plenty of travel time at the end of the day. If divisions are split, this will be
 a random process.
- Dressage tests may be called. NZPCA rules regarding equipment, bits, use of whips or spurs apply.
- Junior riders can opt out of canter movements but must advise the judge prior to entering the arena.
- Lead rein riders are welcomed, but judges must be advised prior to entering the arena.
 Handlers must not interfere with the pony's way of going.
