GENERAL CONDITIONS

All classes are to be registered with Main Events – www.main-events.com. Postal address – PO Box 448 Masterton, 5840. Closing date Monday 9 Sept 2019. Pony Club Mount and Kindergarten Events can also enter on the day without the late penalty.

- Ground Levy of \$10 per horse, PoliPay payment surcharge \$1 and St Johns Levy \$10 per rider must accompany entry fees EXCLUDING KINDERGARTEN section.
- Competitors must pay a \$3 RAS levy per horse/pony competing in the Showing Sections.
- All competitors enter the grounds at their own risk.
- NO dogs allowed.
- Pukahu Show is a qualifier for Horse of the Year Show.
- Committee reserves the right to alter the programme and prize money at their discretion.
- The committee reserves the right to amalgamate classes where insufficient entries are received.
- Yards available on the ground \$30. Camping charge of \$5 per truck or float for entire show.
- Overnight camping allowed on grounds, food & coffee available. 8am-6.30 Sat/Sun
- Late entries 50% penalty and start first in Show Jumping and Show Hunter. Late entries in other classes 25% penalty.
- Scratching refund is minus 25% if notified by Thursday 12/09/19 and will be at the Committee's discretion. Class changes - refunded 75% of class coming out of and then pay normal fee of class going into.
- Entries only accepted when accompanied by full payment.
- Entry in this show confirms that you have read and accepted the RAS and Host Association Rules & Regulations applying to all events at Pukahu Show 2019. This includes the Health & Safety At Work Act 2015 and any amendments.
- All objections or protests must be lodged in writing within an hour accompanied with a \$50.00 fee. Judicial Committee
- No classes will be held up if competitors are late, where classes clash competitors will need to choose.
- Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the Equestrian Park.
- If show is cancelled competitors will be refunded full entry fees less 10% retained for admin purposes.

SHOWING CONDITIONS

The RAS Judges & Competitors Rule book (see www.ras.org.nz) sets out all the conditions that apply to the classes and sections offered.

RAS Rulebook - GR 4. HATS and SAFETY HELMETS

- a) In all cases current WorkSafe New Zealand rules prevail.
- b) All riders, including harness drivers/with the exclusion of heavy horse (Clydesdale) working classes, competing at RAS affiliated A&P Shows/Events must wear protective headgear, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened when in the arena or ring, the practice area, collecting rings or anywhere else within a Showgrounds or the grounds of an affiliated Event.
- c) Hats/helmets must conform with one of the current approved safety standards. These standards may be subject to change but the latest list can be found at <http://www.ras.org.nz> – equestrian. RAS will advise any changes via their website and Facebook.
- d) All hats/helmets that conform as per c) must be identified by the current tag system implemented by NZPCA, ESNZ and RAS.

- All horses & ponies in the showing section must wear assigned bridle/backnumbers with the exception of Adult Riding Classes and Pleasure Horse.
- This show is a HOY Qualifier for Pony, Led Sport Horse, Pleasure, Hack and Show Hunter Sections.
- Novice Horses or Ponies not to have won more than 6 wins in A & P events.
- Adults may ride novice ponies in novice classes only
- RAS Height Certificates and Novice Performance cards must be carried at all times.
- You may only enter Show Hack/Riding pony class or Saddle Hunter horse/Saddle Hunter pony class. You may not enter both.
- All entry fees include the \$1.15 per class RAS levy.

ESNZ Registration & Membership Requirements

- All horses and ponies competing in showjumping and show hunters must pay the \$5 ESNZ Jumping Levy.
- Riders who are not current members of the ESNZ can compete at Introductory Level only at \$15 for the day (Saturday SJ Classes 209 & 211 only and/or Saturday SH Classes 300 & 301 only).
- Horses registered with ESNZ but NOT currently registered for Jumping/Show Hunter (not including introductory level) must pay the ESNZ Casual Jumping Levy of \$20 per show for all non series classes – Height restrictions apply: Horses 1.10m max, Ponies 1.00m max. Riders must have a full ESNZ membership.
- All other classes, Riders must have a full ESNZ membership, horses must be fully ESNZ registered and have an ESNZ Jumping annual start.
- All competitors must wear an ESNZ/RAS approved helmet as identified by the current tag system at all times when riding.
