## CLASSES



All competitors will compete in 2 rounds of show jumping competition

#### SHOW JUMPING - ALL RINGS TO COMMENCE AT 8.30AM

\* 50-60cm competes in ring 3 only, 70cm and above competes 2 rings

#### CROSS JUMP COURSE TO COMMENCE AT <u>9 am</u>

#### AM5 (instant jump off)

This is a course of approximately 10 Jumps and a jump off. The rider MUST complete the first course in the time allowed with no faults to proceed through to the second round.

If the rider accumulates any time penalties or other faults they must stop once going through the finish flags of round one. They are not required to continue to the speed section and must leave the ring.

If the rider has gone clear they will proceed to the jump off which will be approximately 7 jumps. The fastest jump off time with the least penalties wins.

#### Table C

Faults under table C are penalised in seconds which are added to the time taken by the rider to complete the round.

Obstacles knocked down while jumping add 4 seconds.

First disobedience no time added

First disobedience with knock down and displacing of an obstacle = 6 seconds.

Third disobedience is elimination.

Adding the time round plus four seconds for each obstacle knocked down gives score.

#### Style & Optimum Time

A course plan and rules will be at Arena Three.



#### Cross-Jump

Optimum Time, Small course set of show jumps proceeding through to a small course of hunter type fences. Judged as an individual event. Not a compulsory phase, individual ribbons awarded but no points towards team.

# Team Events

#### 3 riders per team.

# Teams must be made up of 3 different riders - Cannot be a team of one rider with 3 separate mounts!

#### Jumping Teams:

(Compete in 2 show jumping rounds each)

Each rider of the team competes in 2 show Jumping Classes (of the same height). Teams do not have to have one rider competing in each height or all riders competing at same height.

#### Individuals:

You may compete in 2 show jumping classes (of the same height) per mount.

#### Cross-Jump:

(Run as a separate class)

Open to all competitors (individuals and team members) please choose a height appropriate to your riding level. Don't enter a class that is below your usual riding level as we are aiming to run a fair and fun round of competition. Individual ribbons awarded, no points towards Team Event.

School teams must be finalised when entries are submitted. School Team Names and team members must be filled out in at time of entry, these cannot be changed on the day! If in the case of a scratching prior to the event the team can be altered please let the event secretary know of any changes before the start of the event.



### Terms & Conditions

As usual we are aiming to run a fun, friendly competition which allows students to compete against other school teams. If your school cannot find enough riders for a team of 3, you can ride as an individual(s).

PLEASE KEEP ENTRANCE GATE TO GROUNDS CLOSED AT ALL TIMES! NO EXCEPTIONS!

- Competition is open to Primary, Intermediate and Secondary schools.
- Entries must be made by Parent/Guardian if under 18yrs
- At the event All Riders must have a adult present
- In the interests of good sportsmanship, please enter at the level that you would normally compete at.
- Horses and ponies will compete against each other in all phases.
- Appropriate school equestrian uniform must be worn when competing.
- More than one mount per rider is allowed however not in same team.
- Should there be excessive entries, early entries will be given priority.
- All competitors enter at their own risk.
- All events are run under ESNZ rules.
- The committee reserves the right to alter the program.
- All riders must respect the stewards and judge's decisions.
- The committee and judges reserve the right to eliminate any rider or school who: In their opinion does not ride in a safe and sportsmanship like manner.
- Ribbons for the jumping classes can be collected from office 1hour after the results are posted.
- The prize giving for the Team placings will be held approx 30 mins after the last results are posted.
- Rider's must be correctly and smartly attired for the prize giving.
- Please treat the grounds with respect always.
- Please remove hay and manure from around your Truck/Float
- Please NO DOGS allowed on the grounds.
- No motor bikes allowed to be ridden on grounds other than approved event organisers.
- All rubbish and manure must be picked up and yards are to be mucked out, there will be bins provided.
- All horses must wear horse ID tags on halters at all times
- Food and drinks will be available CASH ONLY
- Riders must wear approved safety helmets at all times when they are mounted and in yards with horses!
- Back protectors MUST be worn in the Cross-Jump event.
- NO Cross Country jumps on the grounds are to be jumped at any time.
- It is the team manager's responsibility to check that the riders can control their mounts and are capable of competing in the classes entered with safe and appropriate gear, to be checked by Team Manager/Parent.
- Medics on Scene will be in attendance
- Any riders to fall/injure themselves must be seen by Medical Personnel
