THE RULES



- An e-ticket will be emailed to each exhibitor via the Eventfinda system. The e-ticket will be scanned at livestock entrance gate. You will be issued 2 tickets for yourself and your support person.
- Entries close online on the 4th of October, for the purposes of Biosecurity there will be NO late entries or substitutes.
- All animals must be named on entry form along with the Nait number of each individual animal
- In accordance with RAS rules all entries must be registered with a RAS affiliated Society.
- Entries are submitted subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Association, copies are available from the Secretary.
- Wairarapa A&P reserve the rights to combine classes if insufficient entries are received.
- Prize money: 1-3 Entries 1st prize paid. 1-4 Entries 1st & 2nd prize paid. 5 or more entries 1st, 2nd & 3rd prize paid. 1st \$20, 2nd \$10, 3rd \$5 Unless otherwise stated
- All entry fees are GST inclusive, if a Tax Invoice/Receipt is required, please advise.
- All prize money will be paid by direct credit, please ensure your bank account number is supplied on entry form.
- All animals must be on site as discussed and agreed to on Friday 1st November with the Wairarapa A&P Beef Chairman in order to facilitate Bio-Security with wash bays once entries have been submitted you will be contacted to make arrangements.
- It is the responsibility of Exhibitors to supply and must install RCD Units. All electrical equipment to have a current electrical safety tag
- Every objection or protest must be made in writing within one hour of judging of the class, signed by the person making the objections and delivered to the Secretary along with the sum of \$50 which shall be forfeited to the Association should the objection be considered frivolous or vexatious.
- All Highlands entering <u>Beef</u> Classes or invited to enter the Meat & Wool cup must have a passport in conjunction with RAS rules.
- All trophy holders are requested to return trophies to the Society Prior to Friday 1st November. Please ensure all trophies have been cleaned.
- Trophies will be presented to exhibitors and it is the responsibility of such exhibitor to have trophies engraved at exhibitor's expense.
- Age of cattle to be calculated at 1st June 2019
 - Any bull born prior to 1 June 2018 must enter the bull 2-year-old class and over.
 - Females born prior to 1st June 2017 must enter the Senior Cow 3 year and over class.
 - Females born between 1st June 2017 and 1 June 2018 just enter the 2-year-old class.
 - Animals born between 1st June 2018 and 1 June 2019 must enter the yearling class.
 - Animals born since 1st June 2019 are only eligible to enter the calf classes
- All bull's 12 months and over must be nose rung and led by the ring and be under adequate supervision.
- All bulls two years and over must have two leaders and be under adequate supervision.

- All bulls must be securely tied in the stalls by an adequate chain around the neck or a stout leather collar with an adequate rope attached, as well as a halter.
- Please bring your own water feeders for your cattle, no troughs available.
- All cattle must be entered in the name of the bona fide owner.
- All animals must be named on entry form with individual Nait number including pairs or group classes
- Animal Cruelty is NOT acceptable in any way including but not limited to excessive handling or medical manipulation

All stock must be NAIT registered and in accordance with OSPRI and TBfree New Zealand. Regardless of age they must be

- Departing from a property that is registered with a NAIT number and TBfree NZ herd number accompanied with a copy of a valid Animal Status Declaration form.
- Fitted with a valid NAIT RFID tag and registered in the NAIT system.
- Registered in a movement to the event NAIT number (454124) from the animal's current NAIT number no later than Thursday 31st October to assist in the scanning of Nait tags on arrival.
- Registered in a return movement from the event NAIT number to their destination (receiving NAIT number) within 48 hours of departure.
- All stock over 90 days of age travelling from within a TBfree Movement Control Area must be premovement tested within 60 days of arriving at the event.
- All TBfree forms will be collected upon arrival and animals Nait tag Wanded in accordance with MPI regulations – No Nait, No Show, No exceptions
- The Hicks Family Pavilion loading ramps are off limits at all times

• ALL ANIMALS ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OWNER

Wairarapa A&P Society take Biosecurity very seriously so we require our competitors to please adhere to the following rules

- The animal wash bays must be sprayed down with the Virkon supplied before and after use
- Unless an animal is either at the wash bay, in the ring or moving between, all animals must be kept within their stalling area
- Please do not share buckets, troughs, brushes or grooming equipment with other competitors
- There will be Hand Sanitizer provided in the pavilion
- As we are going to be running not only the show classes but also a beef display, there will be no
 access to the general public in the shed until after the showing has finished. If you are requiring
 extra people to attend to set up or assist you please ensure they are fully compliant with the above
 Bio-Security rules
- In the interest of Bio-security a "keep left" and "giveaway" to the right approach will be taken for animals entering and exiting the stalls in the show and display area.
- In the showing only area animals coming from the ring must be secured in stalls before the next class comes out
- All exhibitors are responsible for keeping their stalls clean and tidy at all times, including poor removal. To assist with this each exhibitor will be given an area with which to store their gear.
- There is a NO SMOKING policy in the Cattle Pavilion it the responsibility of all to remind the general public of this.
