CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- SCNO riders must submit the online helpers form at sporty.co.nz/scnosj with their entries to nominate what jobs they can do to assist with running the show. Please bring a plate of food suitable for officials morning/afternoon tea, leave this at the show office.
- Working Bee: Friday from 1:30pm.
- Entries Close 10 days prior to show.
- Programmes \$5. Can be paid with entries.
- Riders may compete in Introductory classes on an Introductory Membership or Casual Membership Day Start (\$15/day). All other riders must be full ESNZ members.
- Yards \$18 & <u>Stallion</u> boxes \$50 for the duration.
- Administration fee of \$15 per equine and ESNZ J/SH levy of \$5 per equine. First aid fee of \$5 per rider. Shower fee of \$5 per user/show.
- Equines not registered for ESNZ J/SH can compete up to 100cm(ponies)/110cm(horses). They cannot compete in national series/high points classes, and must pay a **\$20** Casual Jumping Levy. This levy does not apply to equines only competing in Introductory classes.
- Competitors ride at their own risk.
- Committee reserves the right to alter, amend or delete any class/prize money as it deems fit. In the event the show is cancelled, the administration fee is non-refundable.
- Payment must be made at the time of entry.
- Late entries or payment will be charged a 50% penalty. There will be no refunds given on late entries.
- Scratchings to be advised at least the night before the start of the days competition. 75% refunds given with proof of inability to compete.
- Refunds/Prize Money must be collected at show, or applied for in writing/email within 21 days of show.
- Cheques payable to SCNO Area NZEF Show Jumping.
- Equines may only compete in one Championship or Grand/Mini Prix class.
- Pony riders must carry a current RAS height certificate.
- Minimum Standard of dress required for introductory classes. Formal Standard of dress required for all
 others.
- Run under ESNZ/JNZ/SHNZ rules and regulations.

- 90cm Pony Series sponsored by Roundhill Ski Area.
- 100cm Horse Series sponsored by Jordan Dent Farrier.
- 110cm Pony Series sponsored by Crombie Lockwood.
- 120cm Horse Series sponsored by South Canterbury Saddlery.
- All SCNO Jumping series are run over 6 classes at our 3 shows. Combinations must compete in the final class at our final show.
- Series winners to receive a dress rug. Sashes 1st-6th place.

SHOW HUNTER CONDITIONS

- **Couplands Animal Food** sponsor a rug and sash for the pony combination gaining the most points in their respective High Points over our 2 double high points shows.
- Equine Veterinary Services sponsor a rug and sash for the horse combination gaining the most points in their Equitation & 1.10m High Points over our 2 double high points shows.
- Equines competing using the ESNZ Casual Jumping Levy will not be awarded HOYQ Points.
- Ponies may only enter the High Points class category appropriate to their height.
- In all non-introductory classes; placings, prize money, and points will only be awarded to scores of 66 and over.
- Practise Round Times will be confirmed on SCNO Show Hunter Facebook page prior to event. Limited to two rounds per equine at a cost of \$5 per round to be paid at the gate.
- Illegal gear = No start (also applicable to practise rounds).























HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

The SCNO Area ESNZ Jumping Committee has no employees and is a volunteer association. It is not a person conducting a business or an undertaking (PCBU) and has no duty, responsibility or liability under the Health and Safety at Work Act (HSWA), however we still have responsibilities for public safety under other legislation for which WorkSafe is not the regulator.
