- All entries must comply with the Rules & Regulations of the Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand.
- All goats entered in special classes must also be entered in its standard age class.
- All exhibits must lead & tie up.

HERD REGISTER STANDARD AGE

1500 Herd Register Doe in Milk – Under 3 years

1501 Herd Register Doe in Milk – 3 years & Under 5 Years

1502 Herd Register Doe in Milk – 5 Years & Over

Champion & Reserve Herd Register Doe

1503 Herd Register Grand Champion Doe – Open to any Doe which has obtained her Grand Champion status.

SPECIAL CLASSES

All goats must be entered in their standard age class.

- 1508 Senior Progeny** – Two daughters in milk of the same Sire but different Dams. Registration No. & Name of Sire & Names of Dams to be given on entry form.
- 1509 Herd Register Type & Production** - RAS rules to apply.
- 1510 Associated Records Type & Production** - RAS rules to apply.
- 1511 Herd Register Best Udder** – Open to all does who have borne a kid. To be judged when full & again when stripped out. Points awarded for both full & empty udder, to be totalled to determine the place getters. Does may be eased before judging & must be stripped prior to entering the ring for the empty udder judging.
- 1512 Associated Records Best Udder** – Held under the same conditions as in Class 1511.
- 1513 Junior Show Person** – For young persons of 15 years & under. To be judged on exhibitors' ability to lead, place, turn, stop & start their goat. To answer two questions. Show preparation & appearance of exhibitor & goat taken into account. Exhibitors' age to be included on entry form plus their grade, (bronze, silver, gold, advance).
- 1514 Junior Herdperson** – 15 years up to 25 years showing an adult goat. To be judged on presentation & knowledge of the anatomy of the animal, also the handling & health of the adult goat. Does not have to be owned by the exhibitor.

STANDARD AGE CLASSES FOR JUNIOR DOES

- 1515 Herd Register Maiden Doe or Goatling** – to be 12 months & under 30 months, that has never borne a kid, including maiden milers & springing Does.
- 1516 Herd Register Doe Kid** – Born on or before 31 August.
- 1517 Herd Register Doe Kid** – Born after 31 August.
- Herd Register Champion & Reserve Junior Doe**
- 1518 Associate Record (NZDGA) Maiden Doe or Goatling** - To be 12 months & less than 30 months that has never borne a kid, including maiden milkers & springing does.
- 1519 Associate Record (NZDGA) Doe Kid** - Born on or before 31 August.
- 1520 Associate Record (NZDGA) Doe Kid** - Born after 31 August.

JUNIOR SPECIAL CLASSES

- 1521 Junior Progeny** – Two daughters under 30 months that have not borne a kid of the same Sire but different Dams. Registration No. & Name & Sire & Names of Dams to be given on entry form.

BUCK CLASSES

- 1522 Buck Kid** – Under 12 months
- 1523 Buckling** – 12 months & under 2 years
- 1524 Buck** – 2 years & over
- 1525 Grand Champion** – open to any Buck which has obtained their Grand Champion status.
