### 2020 NZSHC SOUTH ISLAND SPECTACULAR.

### **REGULATIONS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- The Event shall be run in accordance with the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc. Competition Rules, General Rules and Special Rules pertaining to this show. A copy of the Competition Rules can be obtained from your Association Secretary or from the Show Secretary, at secretarynzshc@gmail.com. Copies will also be available from the Secretary's Office at the Show or they can be downloaded from the Council's website www.showhorsecouncilaust.com.au
- The NZSHC Inc. Committee reserves the right itself to interpret all questions and conditions and shall
  make any relevant decisions in regard to, or arising from any incident at or pertaining to this Show, without
  claim for damages or recourse of any kind. Any questions not covered in the Conditions of Entry will be
  decided by the NZSHC Inc. Committee. Its decision will be final.
- 3. Entry and Competition in the Event are voluntary. By Entry it is the Absolute Liability of all participants to agree to be bound by the decisions of the NZSHC Inc. Committee and/or Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc. and compete in accordance with all Rules applicable to the Competition.
- 4. Entry to this Event shall constitute an agreement and affirmation by the Exhibitor(s)/Owner(s), Responsible Officer (which includes Lessee(s)/Manager/Rider/Handler) to compete subject to and in accordance with the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc. Competition Rules and Conditions applicable to this Event.
- Exhibitors must choose between entry in Show Hack, Galloway or Pony Classes and Show Hunter Hack, Galloway or Pony Classes. No exhibit can be shown in both the Show and Show Hunter Classes. Once entries have been received by NZSHC they cannot be changed under any circumstances, including postponement of the show.
- 6. Copies of Council Membership cards or of receipts of Hack Association membership for the 2019-2020 membership year shall accompany all entries. Exhibitors/Competitors the S.H.C. Risk Management Policy applies to all persons competing &/or attending the Event. A Copy of the Policy will be available on the day at the Show Office or can be downloaded from the Council's webpage www.showhorsecouncilaust. com.au. Entry Fees shall accompany the Entry Form and are non-refundable after the closing date for any circumstances including postponement of the show.
- 7. Should any information or fees be omitted from the Entry, the Entry will be deemed incomplete and as such will NOT be accepted. Entries will not be processed until monies have cleared in the bank.
- 8. Numbers corresponding to the catalogue shall be worn. Breast Plate numbers on horses in Led and Saddle classes. Horse entries shall be catalogued as per Exhibitor(s) on Entry Form.
- The NZ Show Horse Council Inc. shall not be responsible for the loss of or for any damage or injury occasioned to any Exhibit or the property of any Exhibitor(s) from any cause whatsoever.
- 10. The Exhibitors and Competitors enter and compete entirely at their own risk.
- 11. Except where any ineligibility is officially determined, the Judge's decision is FINAL. A Judge's decision representing his/her individual preference cannot be protested against.
- 12. All protests shall be in writing to the Ground Jury accompanied by a fee of \$100.00 and are to be received no later than one hour after the Event, after which time no protest shall be entered.
- 13. No outside assistance is to be displayed during Competition. Penalty of Disqualification may apply to breach of this Regulation.
- 14. Drug testing may be carried out during the Show in accordance with Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc. requirements. Competition Rules on DRUGS and DRUG TESTING (Rules 7.1 7.12 in accordance with the relevant Laboratory Sample Collection Protocol. Compliance with this Rule is mandatory for all Exhibits and Persons Responsible. Drug Penalties as adopted in the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc. Competition Rules (7.8a & 7.8b) will apply. Registration papers must be produced if a horse is called up for drug testing. Drug testing guidelines can be obtained from the Show Office on the days of the event or can be downloaded from the Council's website www.showhorsecouncilaust.com.au

- 15. It is the intention of these Regulations that all horses shall perform at the time of competition on their merits, without the aid of any Drug(s) or Prohibited Substance(s) which will affect the conduct, performance or appearance of the horse.
- 16. It is the Absolute Liability of the Owner(s)/Lessee(s) Competitor/Exhibitor(s)/Responsible Officer to ensure that any horse exhibited by them in this competition is free from any Prohibited/Banned Drug or Substance at the time of Competition. Failure to adhere to this Rule may render the Competitor/Exhibit/Owner(s) Lessee(s), /Exhibitor(s) /Responsible Officer liable to disqualification and/or disciplinary action as determined by the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc.
- 17. Results of Drug Testing may be published.
- 18. A TREATMENT FORM (available from the Show Secretary or can be downloaded from the Council's webpage www.showhorsecouncilaust.com.au) shall be completed and lodged by the Responsible Officer for ANY HORSE WHICH HAS BEEN ADMINISTERED ANY DRUG OR PROHIBITED SUBSTANCE within 30 DAYS prior to this Competition. The Treatment Form shall be accompanied by a VETERINARY CERTIFICATE containing full details of any ailment and/or injury and treatment and be forwarded to the Show Secretary within 24 hours of the initial treatment. If initial treatment occurs within 24 hours of commencement of the Show the Treatment Form must be lodged with the Show Secretary as soon as possible, but no later than 7.00am on the day of Competition. Where the horse requires continued treatment (after the form is lodged), a written report detailing the treatment shall be submitted prior to the day of competition.
- 19. The decision as to whether the horse will be permitted to start shall be made by the Ground Jury. Veterinary advice may be sought if considered necessary. The Exhibitor/Competitor shall be advised of the decision prior to the commencement time. No (a) claim shall be made against or (b) appeal made to the Ground Jury or Council if, by such decision of the Ground Jury, the Entry is not permitted to start.
- 20. The Committee reserves the right to refuse or withdraw any Entry/Entries without having to assign a reason.
- 21. All information supplied by the Exhibitor(s), Competitor (s) and/or Owner(s) and/or Lessee(s) and/or Responsible Officer, (i.e. the person in charge of the horse) shall be true and correct and represent that the horse/rider is eligible to compete. If this information is found to be false, the exhibit shall be ineligible to compete. The Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc. may discipline the Exhibitor(s), Competitor (s), Lessee and/or Owner(s) and/or Responsible Officer of the Entry.
- 22. Horse entries shall only be accepted where the name(s) and signature(s) of the current registered Owner(s) &/or Lessee(s), Responsible Officers and Exhibitors/Competitors appear on the Entry Form.
- 23. Where an Owner/Lessee of the horse shall be in charge of the horse during the Competition, then THAT Owner/Lessee is required to sign the Entry Form as the Responsible Officer.
- 24. If a person other than an Owner/Lessee shall be in charge of the horse during the Competition, then THAT person is required to sign the Entry Form as the Responsible Officer.
- 25. Where a horse is registered and/or entered in the name of a minor (under 18 years), the Entry Form shall be signed by the parent/legal guardian. That Parent/Guardian MUST be a member of an Association affiliated SHC of A. Inc.
- 26. In the event of Disciplinary Action, the person(s) considered responsible shall be the Owner(s)/Lessee(s) and/or the Responsible Officer and/or the person in charge of the horse at the time of the Offence.
- 27. The Organising Committee and/or the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc. and/or the Ground Jury, reserve the right to alter the number of Finalists, Program, Judges, Schedule or Timetable.
- 28. All exhibits must be measured prior to competing at the show.
- 29. Conflict of Classes: It is the intention of Management to avoid delays in the Competition. To avoid disruption, Competitors must advise the Show Marshal and Ringmaster of the clash prior to commencement. Should an Exhibitor or Rider competing in a Class require competing in another ring, "holding" of the horse in the ring is NOT permitted. If such a conflict occurs, under the direction of the Ringmaster, the horse shall be excused from the Judging Area to the Holding Area and shall return to the ring upon the return of the rider.
- 30. Every effort will be made to accommodate a conflict. However, in any case, a ring will not be held up. If a conflict occurs, a period not exceeding FIVE (5) minutes will be allowed to a Competitor/Exhibit in the Holding Area before incurring elimination from the Class.

- 31. All Riders are required to wear an approved helmet and riding boots at all times. Any breach of this Rule, may incur disqualification from the Competition.
- 32. Major Prize Money will be forwarded on confirmation of Swabbing Results.

#### 33. CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES on www.main-events.com 20th Jan 2020. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

- 34. All horses competing under saddle, to be 3 years old or over as at the 1st August 2019. NO stallions allowed in ridden classes.
- 35. In the Open Show and Open Show Hunter Classes (12), Open Leading Rein Classes (2), Rider Classes (7) and Childs day classes (12) both the Champion and Runner Up are eligible to compete at the 2021 Grand Nationals, Sydney, Australia.
- 36. NZ show Horse Council uses the current Show Horse Council Australasia judging system, as follows. Each judge has a separate score sheet. They place their horses one to ten, one (1) being first choice. All other horses are given an eleven (11). The judges must sign their score sheets. On completion of judging the steward collects each Judges sheets for the scorers to tally & enter on a Final Score Sheet, the two (best) lowest scores are counted the (worst) highest score is discarded. Therefore, the lowest collective score is the winner, going up the line to tenth place which receives the highest collective score". In case of equality of scores, the preference of the nominated presiding Judge prevails. The judges will be allocated a letter (a,b,c or d) by being drawn out of a hat on the Thursday evening by the committee.
- 37. The Mount of a Rider 9yrs & Under 12yrs must not exceed 14.2hh
- 38. Shetlands All exhibits must be registered with the recognised Breed Association/Society. All Shetlands MUST NOT EXCEED 107.5cm (10.2 hands). All Shetlands must be shown in natural coat and full feather when shown as a representative of their breed.
- 39. Attention is drawn to Rule 16.2 (re Spurs) and Rule 16.2 (re whips) of the SHC Competition Rules
- 40. The policy will be enforced that during competition if first request to a Exhibitor/Competitor to comply with Rules &/or instructions of a Show Official is not followed A YELLOW warning Card will be issued, further non compliance shall incur disqualification.
- 41. Newcomer Exhibits not to have started under saddle prior to 1/8/2018 and not to have won an open champion.
- 42. Upon acceptance of Grand National qualification, all members travelling to Australia are expected to be part of the NZ team and its protocols, organised by NZSHC. Any breach of this may result in your qualification being invalid.
- 43. Prize Money paid out as follows:

Grand National Qualifying Classes - Champion \$50, Res. Champion \$30, Top Six Prize (excl Ch, Res. Ch)

Gala Classes - Champion \$200, Res. Champion \$100, Top Six Prize (excl Ch, Res. CH)

All Other Classes - Champion \$40, Res.Champion \$20, Top Five Prize (excl CH, Res.CH)

Prize money may be substituted for prizes at the discretion of the show committee. If less than 3 entries in a class, prize money may not be paid( at the discretion of the show committee.)



As the Show Horse Council measures in Hands we have our own height certificates.

Please remember to bring your existing SHC height certificate with you for remeasuring. New cards will only be issued for new measures.

Measuring of your exhibit must be completed on the Friday 24th January 2020 on site between the hours of 2pm – 5pm, or on the Saturday/Sunday morning of the show between the hours of 7.00am-8.00am (bookings required for Show Days).

Below is a conversion chart to enable you to understand your animals height category. A Saddle Horse will be over 15hh, a Galloway will be over 14hh and not exceeding 15hh, a Pony will be 14hh and under.

## GRAND NATIONAL QUALIFIERS.

Three (3) judges will judge the individual classes without any conferring between the Judges. A free workout in set time will apply to all OPEN SHOW & SHOW HUNTER classes.

Procedure: Time will commence when entering arena for individual workout, a warning bell will be rung 15 seconds prior end of time limit to allow completion of movement & leave the arena. If time is exceeded a second bell will be rung, the exhibitor must immediately leave the arena as judging will have ceased

The presiding judge will be the first named judge for that class and in event of equality of scores the presiding Judge's points will take precedence to break the tie. Only the top two, out of three scores will be counted. Complete final results of top six will be displayed in the secretary's office after the event.

Riders are allowed to ride more then one horse entry in a class, provided all horses are presented with riders on for circle work & inspection at completion by the judges. No exhibit can be shown in both the Saddle Horse and Show Hunter Classes
