### HOY QUALIFIER PLEASURE RINGS RULES

1. All rules are run under the NZEPS, please refer to their website for full rule description.
2. Adults may ride ponies in Horse ring, riders under 17 on a horse must compete in horse ring.
3. Riders in pony classes must be under 17 (proof of age can be requested). Age is taken as at show date.
4. Snaffle bit only, no poll action, no bitless bridles.
5. Whips may be carried but must not exceed 76cm in length. Dressage whips not allowed.
6. Spurs are not to be worn.
7. Dropped, Grackle (crossed) nosebands, or flash straps are not permitted. Martingales, bit guards, training aids e.g. bearing, side, running or balancing reins, boots, bandages, any form of blinkers, ear plugs, hoods and shadow blinds are not permitted
8. Horses/ponies must have never placed first in an open show ring class.
9. All riders must wear a 3 point harness helmet.
10. Judges decision is final, no protests may be lodged.

*HORSE SPORT RULES*

1. Online entries close on Wednesday the 26<sup>th</sup> of February. Entries on the day incur a \$10 late fee.
2. Casual riding wear acceptable, approved footwear, **approved hard hats to be worn at all times.**
3. Judges decision is final
4. The committee has the right to adjust schedule at any time
5. All competitors compete at their own risk
6. Ponies and Horses will compete together. Adults riding ponies is allowed and kids riding horses is allowed
7. Combinations can enter as many classes as they please
8. The same horse/pony can compete in a class with different riders in the show jumping classes
9. Points accumulated from flat classes, jumping, and extravaganza events will be totalled for High points. 3 age divisions: 10 & under, Junior (11-17), & Senior (18+). High points is totalled for combination, not rider.

This class is designed for the lead rein and beginner riders to give a positive taste of what show jumping is all about. Poles on the ground, full show jumping round with instant jump off (3 'jumps' against the clock)

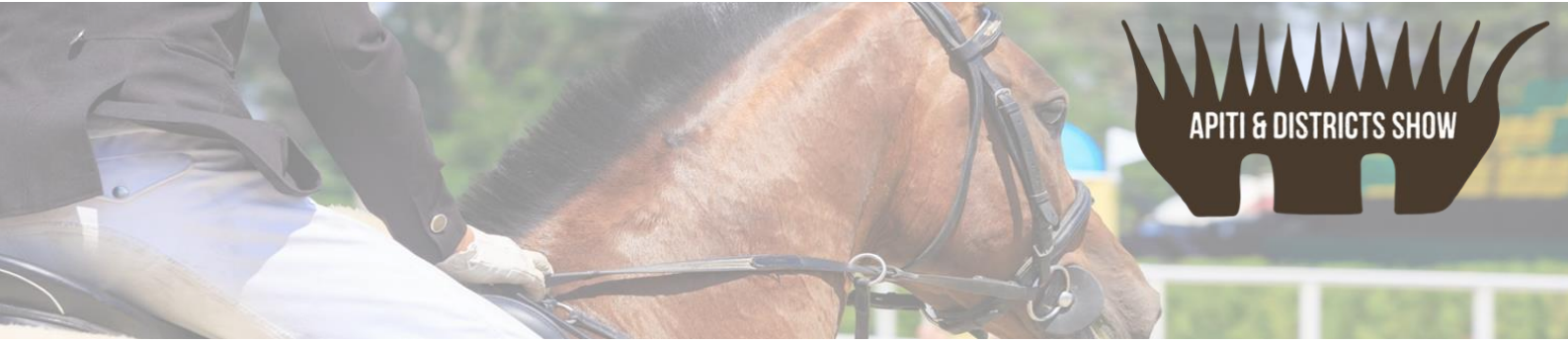
