Hunter Derby Classes

Hunter Derby Classes.

Conditions for the Derby

Judged on the following elements, Jumping, Manners, Conformation & Type, and Way of Going.

1. To be judged in two phases. Phase One – Jumping, Phase Two – Flat section.
2. No restriction on gear except Bit less bridles are not permitted, and Draw reins (running reins, Market Harborough's) are forbidden. Boots may be used, but not permitted in Phase Two.
3. Whips not to exceed 75cm.
4. No gear changes between phases except boots must be removed for Phase 2.
5. The course will include a water jump. No time limit, hunting pace.
6. Phase 1 Jumping will be completed first. Any Pony/Horse eliminated will not be required for Phase 2.

No penalty is incurred if the lower pole in the same vertical plane is lowered. If a horse/pony positively stops or turns its quarters to a fence or has a complete turnabout these constitute refusals. Horses/ponies displaying continued disobedience or horses/ponies leaving the ring whether mounted or dismounted will be eliminated. Any horse/pony taking the wrong course or jumping another fence after completing the course will be eliminated.

TIE BREAKER

In the event of a tie or ties the mark MUST NOT be altered. The TOTAL MARK from PHASE 1 will take precedence, followed by the Manners mark, and then the Conformation Mark. If there is still a tie the Judge's decision is FINAL.

Terms and Conditions

Entry conditions

Online entries close Thursday, 26 March 2020 with Main-Events.com. No postal or email entries will be accepted unless special arrangements are made with the show secretary. All entries will be expected to pay at the time of entry using PoliPay direct crediting.

Scratchings and class swaps to be done online or by email to **jumpingwairarapa@gmail.com**. Instructions on the DOCUMENTS tab online at Main-Events.com for the show.

Fees and levies

1. Ground Levy \$20 per horse. Medical/Admin levy per rider \$20. Optional catalogues \$5. Compulsory ESNZ Jumping levy \$5 per horse/pony, ESNZ Casual Jumping Levy \$20 for horses and ponies not registered with ESNZ for the show - Horses may compete at 1.10m and below and Ponies 1m and below. ESNZ Casual Membership \$15 per day for riders not registered with ESNZ only able to compete in Introductory classes.
2. Stables/Covered Yards \$50 for show; Open yards \$25 for show. There are no refunds on yards after noon on Thursday, April 5th.
3. Late entries accepted with 25% late fee. Refunds less 25% including levies and stabling if notified by email to **jumpingwairarapa@gmail.com** before 5:00 pm Tuesday, April 3rd. Refunds after that less 50% at the committee's discretion.
4. **Class changes** - 25% retained and no late fee charged. Class changes and scratchings must be notified to the Secretary at least one hour prior to Class. Class changes not notified to secretary will be charged 50% penalty.
5. Payment will be required using PoliPay as you enter online using direct credit. No entries accepted without payment so please ensure you have the funds in your bank account before entering. If your bank is RABOBANK or is not supported by POLIPAY, please contact the show secretary BEFORE you do entries for instructions.
6. Dinner tickets for **ESNZ Jumping Series Grand Final Awards Evening** on Saturday will be limited in number - at \$90 per person. Will be available for purchase online and NOT available at the show. Half price tickets for 12 years and under. Tickets are to be picked up at the office by 4:00 pm Saturday. There are NO refunds on tickets ordered - so it is your responsibility to onsell the ticket.
7. **Riders MUST check with the office before they leave the show to ensure they do not owe money. Otherwise, a \$25 admin fee may be charged for followup of any outstanding fees after the show.** Note - this show will use the ESNZ Jumping Policy on Debt Collection to followup any unpaid accounts. Read more on the ESNZ website or see the policy at the show.
8. Prize money will be paid out by direct credit after the show so be sure to include your bank details with the online entry. Riders must check their placings and prize money online by April 8th, 2020. No changes in prize money will be made after that date.

General conditions

1. All classes run under ESNZ rules. All Series Final Classes run under ESNZ Jumping and Show Hunter Series Final conditions.
2. Committee reserves the right to alter the programme and prize money.
3. Ring 1 to be run in strict catalogue order. Draws posted on Main-Events.com the night before. Ring 2 and Ring 3 in blackboard order unless otherwise specified at show.
4. To be eligible for the GLISTENING WATERS STAKES Final, the horse/pony and rider combination must have completed the preliminary round on Saturday at the SAME height. Faults will be carried through.
5. Top qualifiers for final rounds of the GLISTENING WATERS STAKES will be posted and riders must confirm entry by 6:00 pm on Saturday at the office. Combinations not qualified can post enter classes 34, 35 or 36 with no entry Fee payable.
6. First round to be held on 3rd April (*Friday*). Second round to be held 5th April (*Sunday*) Top 30 competitors to return in reverse order of penalties and time in the first round. Should there be equal penalties for first place a jump off will be held.
7. Please ensure registrations and memberships are up to date. Failure to do so may result in loss of points, placings,

prize money after the show and may result in rider being fined under ESNZ Jumping conditions.

8. Horses/ponies can compete under casual levy system for non-series classes and no higher than 1.10m for horses and 1.00m for ponies but riders must be fully registered. Introductory members can only compete in INTRODUCTORY level classes - Intro Classes 14, 30 & 109 for horses and Intro classes 12, 28, 37, 100, 103 & 106 for ponies.

9. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry. Committee reserves the right to evict and eliminate anyone who is acting in an unacceptable manner. Security WILL be patrolling the grounds at night.

10. Motorbikes are not to be ridden between the hours of 8pm and 6am. Motorbike riders must wear a helmet.

11. Standard of dress is FORMAL. Tidy attire must be worn whilst walking courses.

12. Dogs allowed but must be on leads at all times.

13. Competitors enter at own risk and the organisers take no responsibility for any injury to horses, riders or spectators or any damage to competitors or spectators property.

IMPORTANT NOTICE to riders about MEDIA

By entering or attending this competition, you accept that you may appear within differing media streams that are on location covering the event. Your behaviour at the event and within the competition arena is at your discretion and is your responsibility. Please note that there will be live streaming at the event therefore the camera may be on throughout the day.

Show Hunter conditions

1. All Riders must have a current ESNZ Rider Membership to compete in ANY Show Hunter Classes

2. All Equines must have a Current ESNZ Equine Registration and an Annual Jumping/Show Hunter Start to gain Horse of the Year Qualifying Points but can compete on a casual jumping levy WITHOUT earning points.

3. Horse of the Year Qualifying Show for the 2020-2021 Season.

4. Ponies can only compete in the CORRECT Category for their height.

5. Points to be awarded for placing both days excluding intro classes. Points awarded as 1st = 6; 2nd = 4; 3rd = 3; 4th = 2; 5th = 1 where 66% or higher score achieved. In the event of equals, refer to number of 1sts, 2nds and if still equal, refer to actual %.

6. Winner of each championship to receive a rug.

7. There will be 4 championship awards as follows. Champion Open Pony & Champion Open Horse to receive rug. All four divisions to receive Champion & Reserve Champion sash.

- Championship & Reserve Champion over all Open Pony classes
- Championship & Reserve Champion over all Handy Hunter Pony classes
- Championship & Reserve Champion over all Open Horse classes
- Championship & Reserve Champion over all Handy Hunter Horse classes

SPECIAL conditions for Age Horse Classes & Stakes Classes

4 Year Old Championship - Article 273 3.2 273 2 2.1 273 4.2: First round not against the clock, second round not against clock with a jump-off for those on equal penalties for first place.

1. First round to be held on 3rd April (*Friday*). Second round to be held 4th April (*Saturday*) All competitors to return in reverse order of penalties in the first round. Should there be equal penalties for first place a jump off will be held.

2. One entry fee covers all 2 days of competition.

3. Horses can enter on an ESNZ day registration and do not have to have full ESNZ registration.

4. Placings 1st – 6th

5. The Hind Boot rules will be in place for this class.

Futurity Class 5yr, 6yr & 7yr Age Horses - Article 273 3.4.2 273 2.1 273 4.4 : First round not against the clock, second round against clock with a jump-off for those on equal penalties for first place.

1. First round to be held on 3rd April (*Friday*). Second round to be held 5th April (*Sunday*) All competitors to return in reverse order of penalties in the first round. Should there be equal penalties for first place a jump off will be held.

2. Horses must be fully registered with ESNZ.

3. One entry fee covers 2 days of competition.

4. Each horse to jump in its retrospective age group.

5. Heights for each age group in line with National Series heights.

6. First round will be run on Friday and will run in order 5yr horses, 6yr horses & 7yr horses

7. All clear rounds from each Age will go through to the Sunday final.

8. If there are not 10 clear rounds from each Age then horses with the least faults in each Age are to be included to

make numbers up to 10 from each Age. Any faults gained from round 1 are to be carried through to the final competition.

9. The final competition will run on Sunday in order 5yr horses, 6yr horses & 7yr horses

10. Placings will be awarded 1st - 8th.

11. Course walk for **all** heights will be done before the class commences.

12. The Hind Boot rule will be in place for this class.

1. First round to be held on 4th April (*Saturday*).
