

Event Information

***Please...* NO TYING HORSES TO FLOATS OR TRUCKS**

All horses/ponies **MUST** be yarded. An open yard is included in your entry fee. Covered yards need to have been paid with your entries. Yards are non-allocated.

NO DOGS ON THE SHOWGROUNDS - INCLUDING IN CARS/TRUCKS

All riders must wear helmets when mounted. Helmets must meet current NZ safety standards and be tagged accordingly with a **red tag**, as per NZPCA policy.

All Beginner / Junior tests may be called. Junior riders may carry a whip, but no spurs allowed. Senior riders may ride with a whip and spurs. Whips must not exceed 100cm. Snaffle bridles only. Riders must report to judge's car with their name prior to riding their test.

Classes are based on ability rather than age and the organisers expect riders to adhere to the Fair Play charter and enter the correct level for their ability. If you are competing regularly at dressage, please do not enter at a level below what you would normally compete at. Organisers reserve the right to refuse entries or move combinations into another level if deemed necessary.

The organisers have the right to limit class numbers and split classes.

Lead-rein riders must notify the judge's car they will be competing on the lead-rein. Canter will not be performed on lead-rein. Leader must not interfere with the pony's way of going.

REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED IF WE CANNOT HOST THE EVENT DUE TO COVID-19

Junior riders intending to trot the canter movements in tests, please advise the judge when you give your name. Course errors will not be called in tests where the judges have been advised in advance, however marking will reflect the movement was not cantered.

Prize giving will be held at the conclusion of the day - riders are to be in team uniform, unmounted. Non-attendance forfeits prizes. Trophy engraving is the responsibility and at the cost of the recipient. Tests and ribbons may be posted at the discretion of the committee.

Please request this **prior to leaving the show**.

Please pick up **ALL** hay and manure from yards and put in bins provided.

Horses and ponies should only be warmed up or ridden by their entered rider. Please no lunging horses or ponies.

Protests must be lodged within 15 minutes of class closing. Judges decision is final. Riders, parents, managers etc must not approach judges to discuss markings.

Solway College accepts no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to spectators, competitors, horses, ponies or their property.

The committee and judges reserve the right to eliminate any rider or school who in their opinion, does not act or ride in a safe or sportsmanship manner.
