All Championship classes will be run under Article 273.3.3.1, athletes invited to the second round. Article 273.2.2.2 (ii) (25% or 8 athletes) and placings according to Article 273.4.4.3. See page 55 of the National Jumping Rules for full details. Article 273.3.3.1—Competition over Two Rounds. This competition is held over two rounds. Both rounds shall be against the clock. The second course may be the same or different and/or raised within the height parameters. Athletes will be placed according to penalties and time in the first round and a minimum of 25% or 8 combinations (whichever is greater) will be invited back. If more than 8 clear rounds, then all clear rounds will be invited back. Athletes are placed according to the aggregate penalties over the 2 rounds and their time in the second round.

- 1. Closing date of entries Monday 19th October 2020

- 2. Equestrian South Australia will conduct the 2020 South Australian State Jumping Championships under the auspices of Equestrian Australia (EA) in strict accordance with FEI and EA National Show Jumping Rules (effective 1 July 2020, as amended).

- **4.** The following applies.
 - (a) Riders taking part in the Event must be financial members of EA.
 - (b) Horses competing in classes 1.05m and above must be registered with EA, have a current Jumping Competition Licence (formerly Performance Card) and be owned by a financial member of EA. Competition Licences will be requested at the event for prize money to be processed as per our conditions of entry and the EA National Rules.
- 5. Entries MUST have all horse, rider and owner details including EA registration (where applicable) and membership numbers (where applicable). All competitors are strongly encouraged to submit their entries via main-events.com and pay fees by electronic funds transfer. A Postal Entry Handling Fee of \$20 will be charged for entries and cheques sent by post to the ESA Office (fees must accompany these entry forms).
- **6. Swabbing:** Random swabbing will take place. A swabbing fee of \$10.00 per horse must be paid with entries. Please make yourself aware of prohibited substances and the relevant withdrawal period. Check the ingredients of all products you are using including herbal products with your vet. Security and access to the horse is the sole responsibility of the owner/rider.
- **7.** The Organising Committee reserves the right at its absolute discretion to alter or amend any part of the program.
- **8.** The Organising Committee reserves the right refuse entry without giving a reason and to ballot horses if necessary.
- **9.** Protests are to be submitted in writing to the show committee within 30 minutes of the incident or the announcement of placings and with a fee of \$50.00, to be refunded if protest is upheld.
- **10. Late entries** may be accepted at the discretion of the organising committee and will incur a \$10.00 fee per class.



- 11. Substitution of a nominated horse may take place only within the nominated Classes and must be notified to the Secretary at least two hours prior to the commencement of the Class.
- **12.** Jumping horses may be transferred from one class to another, without incurring a late entry fee but additional entry money if appropriate must be paid. This must be done by 8.00am on each day.
- **13.** Scratching: 75% of entry fee will be refunded **only** if Veterinary Certificate or Doctors Certificate is produced within 3 days of the competition. Once an entry is accepted, the Grounds Fee (and Post Entry Fee if applicable) is non-refundable.
- **14.** A Ground fee of \$50 per rider must be paid with entries
- **15. Juniors:** Competitors may take part in competitions for juniors until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 18.
- **16.** Horses may only compete in one of the Junior, Young Rider or Senior Championships categories.
- 17. Horses may have 2 starts in one day. The Organising Committee has the right to refuse an entry.
- **18. No** power cords are permitted to cross the <u>roadways</u>.
- **19. Prize money** will be paid directly into the competitor's nominated bank account within 10 working days of the event. **If incorrect bank details are supplied prize money will be forfeited.**
- 20. Classes 20.1, 20.2, 20.3, 21.1, 21.2, 22.1, 22.2, 23.1 & 23.2 to run Con-Currently For T&C class 20.2 see below

The top 5 qualifiers are also invited to the free weekend of coaching at Oakside Park Stud.

Thompson & Redwood Junior Series Final- Top 15 qualifiers with the most points over the 10-15 rounds will be invited to compete at the final. If a horse / rider combination cannot attend the final, the next highest ranked qualifier will be invited.

The draw for the final will be in qualifying order (example the top qualifier will be last in the draw).



Thoroughbred Sport Horse Assoc Classes TSHA –

All TSHA classes 20.3, 21.2, 22.2, 23.2 to be run concurrently with Sections .1.

To be eligible for TSHA classes your thoroughbred must be registered with the Australian Thoroughbred Stud Book. No part bred thoroughbreds will be eligible.

To compete in the thoroughbred only classes you must purchase a competition licence with the TSHA through Global Entries Online. The licence costs \$ 55 and runs for a calendar year from the date you purchased it.

How do I obtain my licence?

- The licence can be obtained by logging into <u>www.globalentriesonline.com.au</u>
- Go to the 'Manage Horses" page
- Click on the "TSHA licence" button and fill in the details
- If you don't already have an account with Global Entries it is simple to create one and then follow the instructions above.

You must provide a microchip number. If this is not possible please provide your horse's race name and/or their breeding (dam and sire). If you are having trouble finding the information please send us an email and we can help you info@thoroughbredsporthorse.com.au. Licence inquiries Nicole Poetsch 0418 683-802 and for general inquiries Krissy Harris 0459 168-782.

The licence fee is for competition purposes only and is not proof of ownership.

Any prize money will be paid to the winning rider. Connections of the horse must organise the prize money split, if any, between themselves.

Any horses and riders competing in the TSHA Thoroughbred classes 1.05m and over must also hold EA registration.
